# 'Biden-Harris will make US a socialist utopia'

**Washington:** Top Republicans, including Indian-American Nikki Haley, have warned Americans that Democratic presidential candidate Joe Biden and his running mate Kamala Harris' victory in the elections will convert the US into a "socialist utopia" and a "fundamentally different" country.

Urging the voters to re-elect Donald Trump for another term, senior party leaders in their prime-time address on Monday at the Republican National Convention presented the President as a statesman, a friend to Black Americans and a shield against an assault on American values.

They said that the future of America was in danger if the November 3 polls resulted in the defeat of incumbent President Trump.

The four-day mostly-virtual RNC the party jamboree will formally nominate 74-year-old Trump as the party's

candidate for the US presidential election. Trump and Vice President Mike Pence will be challenged by former vice president Biden and his Indian-American running mate Senator Harris.

Former US ambassador to the UN, Haley in her address said, "their vision for America is socialism. And we know that socialism has failed everywhere."

"Joe Biden and the socialist left would be a disaster for our economy. But President Trump is leading a new era of opportunity," Haley, the two-time governor of South Carolina, said.

Haley also sought to demonstrate President Trump's leadership around the world, saying he has been tough against North Korea, Iran and China.

She praised Trump for passing sanctions on North Korea and said he "ripped up the Iran nuclear deal."

"Joe Biden and the

Democrats are still blaming America first. Donald Trump has always put America first," she said.

Haley also criticised the Democratic Party for "turning a blind eye toward riots and rage."

"The American people know we can do better, and of course we value and respect every Black life. The Black cops who have been shot in the line of duty, they matter. The Black small business owners who have watched their lives work go up in flames, they matter."

The Black kids who have been gunned down on the playground, their lives matter too. And their lives are being ruined and stolen by the violence on our streets. It doesn't have to be like this," Haley said.

She said that with Trump as president, "we will build on the progress of our past and unlock the promise of our future." **PTI**

# Afghan officials: Taliban truck bomb, other attacks kill 17

**Kabul:** A wave of attacks across Afghanistan on Tuesday left at least 17 people dead and scores more wounded, officials said, including a Taliban truck bombing in the country's north that targeted a commando base for Afghan forces.

The violence comes as expectations had been rising that negotiations could soon get underway between the Afghan government and the insurgents as part of a February agreement between the US and the Taliban.

The truck suicide bomber struck in northern Balkh province, killing three people, including two Afghan commandos and a civilian, according to Munir Ahmad Farhad, the spokesman for the provincial governor.

According to Hanif Rezaie, the spokesman for the Afghan army corps in the north, initial military report said at least six commandos and around 35 civilians were wounded in that explosion, which also destroyed

or damaged dozens of nearby civilians houses. "Most of the wounded civilians are women and children," said Rezaie.

Taliban spokesman Zabiullah Mujahid claimed responsibility for the Balkh attack in a tweet, claiming that "tens" of military personnel were killed. The Taliban often exaggerate their battlefield claims. Afghan President Ashraf Ghani strongly condemned the attack in Balkh and said the Taliban have increased their attacks on major Afghan cities despite the February agreement.

"The Taliban's insistence on continuing war and violence is challenging peace opportunities," he said in a statement.

Ghani's statement said the Taliban must stop fighting and killing Afghans, accept a ceasefire and start direct talks with the Afghan government. "By committing crimes and violence, they can achieve nothing but hatred and disgust of the people," he said. **AP**

# Floyd's death sparks new activism among communities of colour

**Washington:** When Washington, DC's NFL team dropped the offensive reference to Native Americans from its name last month after decades of resistance, activist Frances Danger knew why: the Black Lives Matter movement.

Danger said the change would never have happened without the massive marches to protest the death of an African American man under the knee of a white police officer in Minneapolis.

"Unfortunately, George Floyd had to lose his life for this to happen," Danger said.

"That is too big a price, but I will forever be thankful to him because my grandkids are going to wake up in a world and maybe never hear the word 'redskin' in their life."

The climate of racial reckoning that has emerged in the United States since Floyd's death has reinvigorated Native Americans, Asian Americans, Latinos and other people of color to fight back against the racism and discrimination they also have experienced for

decades. On Friday, allies of the BLM movement will have an opportunity to hear directly from organisers of The Movement for Black Lives, a coalition of more than 150 Black-led organizations, during its virtual Black National Convention.

"I feel like the conversation has been more accepted," said Jessica Rodriguez, 38, a Chicana who lives in Southern California. **AP**

**Kenosha:** The father of a Black man who was shot, apparently in the back, by police in Kenosha, Wisconsin, says his son was left paralysed from the waist down.

Jacob Blake's father told the Chicago Sun-Times that he was told his son was shot eight times during the Sunday evening confrontation with police, which was captured on cellphone video and led to two nights of unrest in the city between Milwaukee and Chicago. The father, who is also named Jacob Blake and who was driving from Charlotte, North Carolina, to Kenosha to be with his son, told the news-

# France says Russian opp leader victim of 'criminal act'

France on Tuesday said that Russian opposition leader Alexei Navalny, in hospital in Germany after allegedly being poisoned in Siberia, had been the victim of a "criminal act" and urged Moscow to carry out a swift investigation.

"France expresses its profound concern over this criminal act perpetrated against a major figure in Russian political life," the foreign ministry said in a statement.

It called on Russia to "carry out a swift and transparent investigation which will enable the circumstances in which this act was committed to be established. Those responsible for this act must be identified

and brought to justice," the statement added.

The 44-year-old Navalny, who is one of the fiercest critics of President Vladimir Putin, is being treated at Berlin's Charite hospital after falling ill on a flight in Siberia last Thursday.

His supporters claim Navalny was poisoned by something in his cup of tea at a Siberian airport before taking a flight to Moscow, and point the finger at Putin.

The German clinic said Monday that clinical tests "indicate poisoning with a substance from the group of cholinesterase inhibitors," substances that are used in nerve agents as well as some medicines and insecticides.

# 'Cyprus papers reveal secret migration of China's rich led by Asia's richest woman'

**Beijing:** More than 500 Chinese, including Asia's richest woman linked to a politically influential family, have obtained European Union citizenship in Cyprus between 2017 and 2019, leaked documents obtained by Al Jazeera's Investigative Unit have revealed.

The documents, which are said to contain information on 2,500 immigrants to the island nation during that time frame, appear to shed light on the secretive migration plans of China's elite, Hong Kong-based South China Morning Post reported.

Al Jazeera did not disclose the full list of immigrants who were granted citizenship in Cyprus under the so-called golden passports programme, as the disclosure focuses on people with track records that could violate rules for obtaining

the European Union citizenship.

Among the more than 500 approved Chinese applicants, the Qatari broadcaster provided eight names, led by Yang Huiyan, a principal owner of Chinese property developer Country Garden.

Yang was named by Forbes as the sixth-richest woman in the world in 2020 with a fortune of USD 20.3 billion.

It is legal for the Chinese citizens to apply for permanent residency or citizenship in foreign countries. However, China does not recognise dual nationality.

Among the eight Chinese applicants named by Al Jazeera, five, including Yang, were disclosed because they could be viewed as "politically exposed persons" for their own membership or their family's membership in the Chinese legislature and political consultative

committees, the Post report said.

Yang's wealth came mainly from her father, Yeung Kwok Keung who is a member of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference (CPPCC), the top political consultative body to Beijing.

The leaked documents showed that Yang was granted Cypriot citizenship on October 23, 2018.

The second Chinese "politically exposed person" is Lu Wenbin, a delegate to the Chengdu People's Congress.

According to the documents provided by Al Jazeera, Lu obtained a Cypriot passport in July 2019.

Lu is the chairman of Sichuan Troy Information Technology, a computer-networking firm based in the city. **PTI**

# US Consulate employee attacked in Hong Kong: Police

**Hong Kong:** A staff member of the US Consulate General in Hong Kong was attacked by a man outside his workplace on Tuesday afternoon, police and a US official said.

The financial hub's police said they received a report on an attack in the afternoon which a consulate employee suffered a bloody injury to his head after a man struck him and fled.

A spokesperson of the consulate confirmed a staff member had been "assaulted by an unknown individual."

"The employee did not sustain life-threatening injuries. We cannot speculate on the assailant's motives at this time," the consulate official added.

Once a beacon of stability, Hong Kong has been left bitterly divided and polarised after last year's huge and sometimes violent pro-democracy protests. **AFP**

# Oli, Prachanda hold talks

**Kathmandu:** Prime Minister KP Sharma Oli and ruling Nepal Communist Party's executive chairman Pushpakamal Dahal "Prachanda" held talks on Tuesday, days after a six-member panel submitted its report suggesting ways to resolve the ongoing intra-party rift.

Though the details of the meeting of the top leaders of the NCP, were not disclosed yet, the two leaders agreed to convene the meeting of the party's powerful Central Secretariat on Friday, said the party's Standing Committee member Ganesh Shah.

The nine-member body will discuss the report submitted by the task force formed by

the two top leaders.

The panel in its report on August 23 suggested that Prime Minister Oli should complete his five-year tenure, while executive chairman Prachanda be allowed to exercise full executive power over party affairs.

The task force, formed by Oli and Prachanda on August 15 and later endorsed by the Central Secretariat on August 17, was led by the party's General Secretary Bishnu Poudyal. When Oli became prime minister two-and-a-half years ago in 2018, he and Prachanda had reached a tacit understanding to share the prime minister's position turn-by-turn. **PTI**

# World's first confirmed coronavirus re-infection reported in Hong Kong

**Hong Kong:** A man caught the coronavirus after recovering from an initial bout in April in what scientists said was the first case showing that reinfection may occur within a few months.

The 33-year-old's second SARS-CoV-2 infection was detected via airport screening on his return to Hong Kong from Europe this month. Researchers at the University of Hong Kong used genomic sequence analysis to prove that he was infected by two different strains. The information technology worker didn't develop any symptoms from his second

infection, which might indicate "subsequent infections may be milder," the researchers said.

"Our findings suggest that SARS-CoV-2 may persist in humans," Kwok-Yung Yuen and colleagues said Monday in a paper accepted for publication in the journal Clinical Infectious Diseases. The findings also suggest SARS-CoV-2 is reminiscent of the coronaviruses that cause the common cold, and may continue to circulate "even if patients have acquired immunity via natural infection or via vaccination," they said. **AGENCY**
