Biden will bring poverty: Trump Don't believe Trump, he is a liar, says Obama

Washington, Oct. 22: Sounding a note of caution, External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar on Wednesday told Americans that he will deliver optimism, opportunity and hope. Biden will deliver pessimism, poverty and decline.

Washington, Oct. 22: Seeking his reelection, US President Donald Trump on Wednesday told Americans that he will deliver optimism, opportunity and hope while his Democratic rival Joe Biden will bring in "pessimism, poverty and decline".

With less than a fortnight left for the November 3 presidential elections, Trump described it as a vote on "47 years of Biden versus his 47 months as the US President".

"For the last 47 years, Joe Biden has been outsourcing your job,

opening your borders," he alleged.

"I will deliver optimism, opportunity, and hope. Biden will deliver pessimism, poverty, and decline," Trump told thousands of his supporters in Gastonia city of the battleground state of North Carolina.

"Normal life will fully resume and next year will be the greatest economic year in the history of our country. That's where we are headed. This election is a choice between a Trump super recovery or a Biden steep depression and that's what you're going to

Trump at his 'showman' best in desperate last minute dash

Tueson, Oct 22: He adjusts his coat. He gazes out at the crowd. And then he goes for it.

President Donald Trump, a man who is famously particular about his appearance, is fully embracing tonight a dad dance to the Village People's YMCA as the finale to his rallies in the campaign's closing stretch.

He starts with the arms, clenched fists pumping back and forth sometimes to the beat as though he's on an elliptical trainer. He claps. He waves. And then he starts to bob his head and move his knees. On some nights, he sticks mostly to pointing and clapping. But on others, he lurches from side to side and jerks his body as the crowd cheers.

Backstage, top staff and campaign aides often join in with the more traditional take, using their bodies to spell out Y-M-C-A to the strains of the cheesy '70s anthem.

Trump's rally dance has become a rare moment of levity in an otherwise miserable campaign year marked by a deadly pandemic, an economic recession and racial turmoil. And while Trump has largely been stunned by pop culture, the dances he spawned a viral TikTok video challenge (even though he's threatened to ban the site in the U.S.) and a parody on The Late Show with Stephen Colbert.

Do you want to shake your groove thing but don't know the steps? Then order 'Dancing with the Don'

and let President Trump teach you all the hottest moves!" Colbert's show advertised in a parody infomercial.

Trump's campaign staff and family members have also been promoting clips and copycats as the president rallies in most national polls and in many battleground states just two weeks out from Election Day.

Love it the president's daughter and senior adviser, Ivanka Trump, wrote as she retweeted a video posted by a young woman replicating the president's moves.

When a reporter tweeted a video showing some of Trump's campaign aides dancing along but not Ivanka Trump's husband, Jared Kushner, a top White House adviser, Ivanka tweeted back: Party Foul!" Added Trump senior advisor Steve Cortes: President Beast Mode can boogie... The efforts to make the dance a thing come as the president has been trying to demonstrate his vigor after returning to the campaign trail following his infection with the coronavirus, which put him in the hospital for three nights.

It has drawn a scowl from others, including CNN's Don Lemon, who criticized Trump for dancing in the song during a pandemic that has killed so many.

UN needs immediate reforms to face global challenges: India

New Delhi, Oct. 22: The minister said it is time to reform the United Nations and move beyond speeches and commitments.

The UN reform process is in serious danger and it would be in the interest of the global community to reform the United Nations, actually, we are going to make the UN less credible, less relevant, and I don't think the world wants that," he said.

He said this during a panel discussion on the occasion of the release of book 'Portraits of Power: Half a Century of Being at Ring Side' written by former bureaucrat and current Finance Commission Chairman N.K. Singh.

The minister said it is time to reform the United Nations and move beyond speeches and commitments.

In the past 15 years, the UN reform process is a bit like the Groundhog Day, he said, adding that negotiation means you take it from point A to point B and then you pick up at point B to point C," he said.

"If this is to be serious, it has to be a negotiation. Negotiation means text, and record. Negotiation means you take it from point A to point B and then you pick up at point B to point C," he said.

Last month, Prime Minister Narendra Modi also said the UN faces a "crisis of confidence" without comprehensive reforms. "We cannot fight today's challenges with outdated structures. Without comprehensive reforms, the UN faces a crisis of confidence," the minister added.

Observing that multilateralism is in serious danger today, Jaishankar said that after the Second World War, international politics produced genuine multilateralism but today, "we are seeing more and more balance of interests, the bigger countries even more so really being very much focused on their own interests".

"Our democracy is not gonna work if the people who are supposed to be our leaders lie every day and just make things up," Obama said.

Referring to a recent news report that Trump maintains a bank account in China, the former US president said, "He's got a secret Chinese bank account. How is that possible? Can you imagine if I had had a secret Chinese bank account when I was running for re-election. You think Fox News might have been a little curious about that. They would have called me Beijing Barry".

'BJP-JD(U) partnership in Bihar is like Sachin-Sehwag combo'

Khalgaon, Oct 22: Addressing a rally here in Bhagalpur district ahead of assembly polls beginning October 28, Singh said, "The alliance of the BJP and the JD(U) is as superhit as the opening pair of Sachin and Sehwag of the Indian cricket team." He said the alliance government has provided basic facilities of electricity, road and water, which Bihar lacked for decades.

"People have seen the 15-year rule of 'lalten' (BJD's poll symbol lantern) and they have also seen the development of Bihar during the BJP-JD(U) alliance government. The performance of these two governments cannot be compared. The state has got transformed under the NDA government," Singh said.

Praising Nitish Kumar and his deputy chief minister Sasmit Modi of BJP, Singh said there are no charges of corruption against them.

"I am not making this claim that Nitish Kumar has done everything for Bihar. It could be debated whether he has done enough work or less work or more was required to be done, but there can be no debate on their integrity," Singh said.

IIT-Kharagpur COVID-19 testing kit results in one hour

New Delhi, Oct. 22: The Indian Institute of Technology (IIT)-Kharagpur has developed a low-cost portable COVID-19 testing device that can deliver results within one hour and it also received certification from the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR).

According to IIT-Kharagpur officials, 'COVIRAP' is a cuboid-shaped portable testing device that can deliver results in an hour, making it an effective tool to scale up coronavirus screening in peripheral and rural areas.

"This innovation has made high-quality and accurate COVID testing affordable for the common people with a testing cost of around Rs 500 which can further be reduced through government intervention. This machine can be developed at a cost of

extremely low levels of viral loads that any other method based on similar principles of testing, even those from the most celebrated research groups across the world, could not come up with so far.

"This means that very early stages of infection can be detected thereby isolating the patient and arresting the uncontrolled spread of infection in the community via asymptomatic patients," she said.

According to the research team, the number of tests per one-hour batch in a single machine unit can be further increased to much higher limits, for the purpose of testing on a mass scale.

Spain hits 1 million mark

Spain became the first country in western Europe to accumulate more than 1 million confirmed COVID-19 infections on Wednesday as the nation of 47 million struggles to contain a resurgence of the virus. The health ministry said that its accumulative case load since the start of the pandemic reached 1,005,295 after reporting 16,973 more cases in the past 24 hours.

The ministry attributes 34,366 deaths to COVID-19. Experts say the real numbers of infections and deaths are probably much higher because insufficient testing, asymptomatic cases and other issues impede authorities from capturing the true scale of the outbreak. As the numbers rise, authorities in charge of health policy in Spain's regions are tightening restrictions. They want to stem the surge that has been building in recent months while avoiding a second total lockdown of home confinements that stemmed the first wave of the virus but left the economy reeling.

App on COVID norms

A public-interest foundation is testing a smartphone app that could make it easier for international airline passengers to securely show they've complied with COVID-19 testing requirements. It's an attempt to help get people back to flying after the pandemic sent global air travel down by 92 per cent.

The Switzerland-based Commons Project Foundation was conducting a test of its CommonPass digital health pass on United Airlines Flight 15 from London's Heathrow to Newark Liberty International Airport, using volunteers carrying the app on their smartphones. Officials from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Customs and Border Protection were observing the test. The system looks forward to the day when travel may be determined not only by testing but by the need to show vaccination records. The World Health Organization says vaccines may start becoming available by mid-2021.

More cities in lockdown

South Yorkshire in northern England has become the latest region to be added to the highest level of coronavirus lockdown restrictions as it was included in Tier 3 on Wednesday, amid ongoing clashes between the UK Prime Minister Boris Johnson led government and local authorities over the issue.

Addressing his weekly questions session in the House of Commons, Johnson revived the row with Greater Manchester authorities from earlier this week as he accused the region's Opposition Labour Mayor, Andy Burnham, of turning down a generous 60 million pounds financial aid package for being placed in Tier 3, or the very high alert category which involves a complete shutdown of most businesses. On Tuesday the Mayor of Greater Manchester was offered a further 60 million pounds which he turned down I can tell the House today that that cash will be distributed to the boroughs of Greater Manchester, said Johnson.

US stays off wrestling

The United States won't send a team to the world wrestling championships because of health and safety concerns caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. The executive committee of USA Wrestling, the national governing body for wrestling, unanimously approved the proposal not to send a team to Belgrade for the December 12-20 event.

"My heart breaks for our athletes, as nobody is more affected by this decision than they are. In the same breath, abstaining from the 2020 World Championships is the right decision. I am proud that the athletes' voices were solicited and considered in every step of this process. In choosing to make this decision now, versus delaying it, the athletes have time to recover and refocus on what is most important: the 2021 Olympic Games," said Veronica Carlson, executive committee member and chair of the USA Wrestling Athlete Advisory Committee.
