Final dividend is subject to approval of shareholders.
- On 29 July 2022, the Board of Directors of the Company has approved the acquisition of AAC blocks business of Fastbuild Blocks Private Limited at a purchase consideration of INR 3702.61 lacs, through a slump sale on a going concern basis. The acquisition was completed on 17 August 2022 with compliance to the conditions specified in the agreement by the respective parties. The fair value of assets and liabilities acquired have been determined in accordance with Ind AS 103 "Business Combinations". Consequent to the acquisition, the said business has been reported under the Building Solutions segment of the Company.

India knocked out of Sudirman Cup

Star shuttlers Kidambi Srikanth and PV Sindhu couldn't produce the goods as it was all over for India in the prestigious tournament. While Srikanth was too erratic in men's singles contest, Sindhu showed great fight-back in the decider after squandering an opening game advantage only to go down in the end to world No. 30 Goh Jin Wei.

An error-prone Srikanth then couldn't get India's campaign back on track, going down 16-21, 11-21 to world No. 8 Lee Zi Jia. World No. 12 Sindhu then erased a 2-11 deficit in the third game but couldn't go the distance, losing 21-14, 10-21, 20-22 to Goh in the women's singles as India conceded a 0-3 lead to Malaysia in the 5-match tie.

ARSENAL BUCKLE, CITY INCH CLOSER

3 points away from Premier League title

Manchester City is one win away from a third straight Premier League title and a fifth in six seasons under Pep Guardiola.

English soccer's dominant force was tested by a new rival in the form of Arsenal, but Mikel Arteta's team has buckled under the pressure of trying to keep pace with Guardiola's relentless trophy-winning machine. While the race is not over yet, it would take a remarkable collapse for City to throw it away now.

"We have to apologize to our people, especially for the second half," Arteta said after his team's 3-0 loss to Brighton at Emirates Stadium on Sunday.

It was the fifth time in seven games that Arsenal has dropped points in the closing weeks of the season.

By comparison, City's 3-0 win against Everton earlier in the day extended its unbeaten run to 21 games in all competitions, including 11 straight wins in the league.

Arsenal's challenge has melted in the heat of the battle, with Brighton's second-half goals from Julio Enciso, Deniz Undav and Pervis Estupinan all but ending the Gunners' hopes of a first title in 19 years.

"We fought really hard to be in the position that we are in and today we were in a critical moment to keeping hoping and digging for that dream," Arteta said. "When you have to play in these moments you cannot do what we did in the second half."

"Then we have to look. If a team is capable of doing that when it comes to the biggest stage, there's a lot of things to analyze and think about because it cannot happen."

The truth is that Arsenal's slump began long before Sunday's painful defeat. Having led the table for most of the season, it was eight points clear of City at the start of April, having played a game more.

But in the space of six weeks, there has been a 12-point swing in Guardiola's favour, helped by City's 4-1 rout of Arsenal at Etihad Stadium last month.

It is a measure of the extent to



which Arsenal's form has slumped that it could even afford to lose twice in head-to-heads against City and still have the title in its own hands. Instead, the true damage was done in back-to-back draws against Liverpool and West Ham when Arteta's team let two-goal leads slip on both occasions.

Then came another draw at home to last-place Southampton all in the lead-up to that showdown at City when the

superiority of Guardiola's team on the night only confirmed how well Arsenal had done to run the race so close.

Arsenal has 81 points - four behind City's 85. And while its progress this season has been outstanding, having ended last year in fifth place on 69 points, Arteta may look back on a missed opportunity given his side's flying start to the campaign and City's inconsistency early on.

FA Cup goes Chelsea's way

A world record crowd of 77,390 watched Chelsea beat Manchester United 1-0 in the Women's FA Cup final in Wembley. Sam Kerr's 68th-minute strike proved decisive as Chelsea won the trophy for the third straight year to remain in contention for a league and cup double.

Barcelona champions

Barcelona's risky bet to mortgage the club's future paid off, when a team led by newcomer Robert Lewandowski clinched its first Spanish league title in four years. Barcelona won its 27th league title, second to Real Madrid's 35, with four rounds remaining after a 4-2 win at Espanyol with a pair of goals by Lewandowski. Now the club can finally start a new chapter after winning its first major title since the painful exit of Messi two years ago.

Payyade SC emerge champions

Payyade Sports Club emerged champions defeating MIG Cricket Club by a convincing five wickets in the final of the John Bright CC organised 2nd MCA Rathod Trophy Under-25 Invitation T20 cricket tournament. MIG CC batting first found the going tough and could only muster to pile up a total of 130 all out. In reply, Payyade after an early setback came back strongly with Suved Parkar leading the way with a cracking knock of 70 and steer the team to a total of 133-5 in 18.2 overs and clinch the Rathod Trophy. Parkar was later declared the Player of the Final.

Mumbai Police march on

Maintaining their impressive winning momentum Mumbai Police City Riders marched to their fourth successive victory by recording an authoritative seven-wicket win against Ghatkopar Jets in a seventh round match of the Mumbai Cricket Club (MCC) and Jwala Sports Foundation (JSF) organised MitsuiShoji T20 Cricket League (Season 9), played at the Police Gymkhana ground, Marine Drive. Opting to field, Mumbai Police bowled and fielded well to contain the Ghatkopar batters who managed to put up a modest total of 147-8. In reply, Mumbai Police cantered past the target 16 overs, 149-3. Leading Mumbai Police charge was Tanmay Mayekar who smashed an unbeaten 52 runs all-rounder Sujit Nayak also scored an unbeaten 43 and Sagar Mishra contributed 20 runs. In the second match, Shivaji Park Warriors continued with their all-win record as they handed Thane Marathas a five-wicket defeat. Batting first, Thane Marathas amassed a challenging total of

163-9, but Shivaji Park Warriors who are in terrific all-round form easily crossed the finish line reach 165-5 in 18 Overs. Shivaji Park Warrior continue to stay in the lead with 14 points followed by Mumbai Police with eight points and Ghatkopar Jets in third place also with eight points. Thane Marathas with four points are in the fourth spot and Bandra Heroes with two points are at the bottom.

Host CCI off to a flier

Hosts CCI Kids Academy registered a thrilling win over Achivers Cricket Academy in the inaugural league match of the Madhav Apte Cup under 15 girls cricket tournament organised by CCI at Brabourne Stadium. In another match Home Ground Academy also defeated Dilip Vengsarkar Foundation team by 17 runs. While batting first hosts CCI Kids Academy were restricted to 75-9 in the allotted 20 overs by Achivers Cricket Academy. Vidisha Naik (2-7) and Priyadarshini Singh (3-11) were the thick of bowlers. While chasing this small total Achivers lost their wickets at regular interval but Gauri Dharmetar fought the lone battle. She made 26 and was run out in the 18th over when they were needing three more runs for a win.
