Women's access to tech: Seven NGOs win ₹1 cr in grants

Seven social sector organisations were selected out of more than 260 applicants for an award of up to Rs1 crore each in grants from Reliance Foundation to address barriers that limit women's access to technology. The United States government partnered with Reliance Foundation, helmed by Nita Ambani, to support women entrepreneurs, farmers, women-led micro enterprises and collectives, and self-help groups to provide mentoring support from experts and practitioners across India.

The winners were announced on Wednesday at an event, 'Accelerating Digital Inclusion: Bridging the Gender Digital Divide in India'. Speaking at the event, USAID Mission Director Veena Reddy said, "The US recognises the strategic importance of a connected world. USAID works towards a future where digital technology promotes inclusive growth and empowers all, including the most vulnerable."

The Foundation's CEO Jagannath Kumar said, "We are committed to working to close the gender digital divide because we believe India's digital revolution provides immense potential for women-led development. We saw this through the innovative approaches to digital inclusion that were incubated in round one of the Women-Connect Challenge India. Through its second round, the foundation and USAID aims to positively impact over 3.5 lakh women and their communities."

The winners of round two are the Goat Trust, MS Swaminathan Research Foundation, Manjari Foundation, Digital Empowerment Foundation, Seven Sisters Development Assistance, ACCESS Development Services and Yugantar.

'535 WOMEN FROM THANE STILL MISSING'

Chairperson says will take up issues faced by commuters with railways

The State Commission for Women chairperson Rupali Chakankar on Wednesday said that the rate of disappearance of girls in Maharashtra is a matter of concern. In 2022, 2,462 women were reported missing in Thane, and 1,972 were traced. However, 535 are missing. If the missing females are not traced, there is a fear they may fall prey to human trafficking. For this, there is a need to counsel the adolescent girls and their parents, she said.

She also stressed the need for setting up a women's complaint redressal committee in every government/private office in the district within three months to stop the harassment of women in the workplace.

Chakankar presided over the 'womens' commission at your doorstep' programme on Tuesday. A total of 174 complaints were received during the public hearing and action was taken by different panels set up for the purpose. Out of 174 complaints, 116 complaints were related to marital/family problems. While 18 complaints were filed regarding social problems, 9 related to property, 5 related to workplace harassment and 26 complaints related to other issues.

Speaking with the reporters Chakankar said, "A delegation of women railway passengers association met her and gave a memorandum of various demands, like increasing the number of seats and coaches for them in local trains from Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus to Kasara and Karjat.

The delegation also demanded CCTVs in women's coaches, deployment of more police personnel for their safety during travel, facilities like Hirkan Room (for lactating mothers to feed their minor kids) and toilets at all stations."

Chakankar said the commission will follow up with the suburban railway administration on the issues faced by woman commuters.

"Even though cases of child marriage are less in the district, some people quietly indulge in it by showing the wrong birth date of girls. To stop such things, a mass awareness needs to be created with the help of Anganwadi and ASHA workers," said Chakankar. Chakankar also asked various departments to work towards keeping a check on incidents of domestic violence, child marriage, superstitions, and mother and child deaths.

BIGGEST MILESTONE FOR INDIA'S LONGEST SEA BRIDGE

1st bus crossed the Mumbai Trans Harbour Link (MTHL) on Wednesday with Chief Minister Eknath Shinde flagging it off.

The work involved construction of about 22km, 6-lane bridge - 16.5km sea bridge and 5.5km viaduct on the land on either side.

The sea link will have interchanges at Sewri in Mumbai and at Shivaji Nagar and NH-4B near Chirle in Navi Mumbai.

The link will be the longest sea bridge in India. The project is scheduled to be completed in November.

524 Navi Mumbai bldgs are dangerous

It's 10 more than last year; Panvel declares 33 buildings dangerous

The Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC) has issued a list of 524 dangerous buildings after a ward-wise 2023-24 survey. The structures have been declared dangerous under section 265 of the Maharashtra Municipal Corporation Act.

Every year ahead of the monsoon, the civic body declares a list of dangerous buildings and appeals to citizens to vacate them so as to avoid loss of life and property. Last year, the civic body declared 514 buildings under the dangerous category.

The highest-risk buildings that need to be demolished immediately come under the C-1 category - both last year and this year, there were 61 of these. In addition, there are 114 structures that fall under C-2A category; that need to be repaired by vacating the premises. Similarly, 300 structures fall under the C-2B category that can be repaired without vacating the building, and the remaining 49 fall under the C-3 category that need only minor repairs. Similarly, the Panvel Municipal Corporation (PMC) has issued a list of 33 dangerous buildings this year; with 16 dangerous structures in Kalamboli, New Panvel, Kamothe and Panvel wards.

524 DANGEROUS BUILDINGS

- Declared under section 265 of Municipal Corporation Act
- Issued every year before monsoon
- 514 buildings under dangerous category last year
- PMC issued list of 33 dangerous buildings this year
- Buildings in use for over 30 years required to undergo structural audit

As per Section 265 (a) of the Maharashtra Municipal Corporation Act, buildings that have been in use for more than 30 years are required to undergo a structural audit by a construction or structural engineer registered with the civic body.

Provide safety to visitors or face action

The Thane Municipal Corporation (TMC) on Wednesday said that action will be taken against contractors if safety jackets and rules are not followed during boating at Masunda, Upavan, Ambe-Ghosale and Kharigaon lakes. To avoid any untoward accident, the civic body has made it necessary to

wear life-saving jackets and other equipment during the service. At present, the lakes remain crowded as both the young and elderly take advantage of the facility. However, the civic administration has noticed that no equipment is being provided to the riders. The service in four major lakes in the municipal area is being run by a contractor. It has been

observed that pedal boats are provided to tourists without providing any safety gear. The TMC directed the environment department to look into the matter. The chief environment officer Manisha Pradhan visited Masunda and Upvan lakes and inspection revealed that an extra number of riders are being put into the boats without any safety gear.
