Increase in Marketing Costs

On the consumer internet side, expenses shot up for most of the major companies. Ecommerce behemoth Flipkart saw its marketing costs cross Rs 2,400 crore in FY23, up 24% from Rs 1,940 crore in FY22. The numbers pertain to the company's marketplace arm, Flipkart Internet.

"Startups require heavy investments in marketing, technology and in hiring people with specific skill sets. At the same time, they also incur heavy costs on the investments made in other endeavours that have not found the right market fit," said Rohan Lakhtayar, partner, Grant Thornton Bharat. "Therefore, the net effect results in no significant cost reduction for the entity."

Horizontal omnichannel retailers such as Nykaa, Mamaearth parent Honasa Consumer and FirstCry also saw both their operating expenses and marketing costs rise, with Nykaa seeing 23% to 55% increase in FY23. Nykaa's marketing bill rose by

23% to Rs 591 crore and employee costs by 51% to Rs 492 crore. For FirstCry, expenses on marketing came in 14% higher, at Rs 418 crore, while that on employees zoomed 65% to Rs 408 crore. Mamaearth's employee expenses doubled and its marketing spend increased 35% between FY22 and FY23.

DEFINITION OF EXPANSION
The mentality of growth at all costs went on the backburner for the overall startup ecosystem in 2023. Marketing spend increased 35% between the world starting early 2022 rendered capital scarce for growth and into cash for companies, making it imperative for them to control out-of-pocket costs.

"But for some sectors, the dynamics were different. Lack of cheap money meant that players in the leadership position were at an advantage," a Gurgaon-based unicorn founder told ET, on the condition of anonymity.

EoIs Invited in Sept Last Year

Tata Group chairman N Chandrababu Naidu said earlier this month that it will set up a chip manufacturing unit at Dholera soon.

Intel's Tower Semiconductor has a close association with SCL as it had helped the Indian government plan a 300mm wafer fab chip plant. Tower Semiconductor is also very keen to enter the commercial chip manufacturing segment in India, on a par with even in active discussions with the government while Texas Instruments has significant chip research and development operations in the country.

"Once the government decides on the exact nodes that this facility will manufacture, financial bids will be invited from these companies," said another senior government official. The firm which will be given the final mandate, may have to partner with a

technology firm that has licensing grade semiconductor technology, the official added.

The Tata Group, Tower Semiconductor and Texas Instruments did not respond to ET's queries till press time.

At present, the government-run Mohali facility produces chips of 180nm node size, which have very low demand in the country. The ministry of electronics and information technology (MeitY) officials said the goal is to bring the technology of the facility on a par with industry standards of legacy nodes of 65 and 100nm to start with, before aiming for more cutting-edge nodes.

\$10 BILION FUND FOR MODERNISATION

The government therefore earmarked \$1 billion for modernisation of the facility and invited expressions of interest from the industry in September last year. The \$1 billion fund is part of the government's \$10 billion semiconductor incentive package to set up a semiconductor chip fabrication ecosystem in the country. "We are hopeful of getting more bids, especially from domestic companies since a lot of the work is of crucial importance to us. We are evaluating the current bids including from the Tata Group. A couple of companies working in the defence space have also shown interest," said one of the officials earlier.

SCL does not need to get into the commercial production of chips, the official said, adding, "It has been doing continuous research and development (R&D) work in the past and will continue doing so."

Rise in Young Flyers

"During Covid a lot of companies facilitated the transfer of their white-collar workers by air. That led to a surge in first-time flyers," said Kumar, now president of InterGlobe Technology. "After the pandemic, the entry of new and younger air travellers," said Daniel D'Souza, president holidays at SOTC Travel. "Since the pandemic, the average age of our customers has dropped by approximately 10 years. And what is noteworthy is that our 16-20% growth in this new segment is not restricted to metros, but emerging strongly from India's tier-2 cities."

In Gujarat, one of its key markets, the company is getting tier air travellers from Bhavnagar, Jamnagar, Rajkot, Surat and Vadodra, he said, adding, "We are also targeting the UDAN scheme which has played a key role in ramping up regional connectivity and making it easier to increase. Last year, three greenfield airports were operationalised in Mopra, Coimbatore in Karnataka and Raitol in Gujarat. Five other airports were operationalised in Kourla and Udaipur in Odisha, Haldwari in Uttarakhand, Prashad, Cooch Behar in West Bengal and Jamshapur in Jharkhand.

For instance, India's busiest airport, in Delhi, handled 26 million domestic passengers in 2023, of which 3.12 million were first-time flyers. This means about 50% of the 30 million estimated by CAPA came from other air markets. A Mumbai airport executive said, "However, in case interest rates come down (given projections of lower inflation), demand will be stronger."

Trevel companies also noted this trend. For instance, travel portal Ixigo said flyers from smaller towns constitute 36% of its air bookings in 2022-23, up from 29% in 2014-15. "One of the significant shifts that we are witnessing over our 75-year history is the entry of new and younger air travellers," said Daniel D'Souza, president holidays at SOTC Travel. "Since the pandemic, the average age of our customers has dropped by approximately 10 years. And what is noteworthy is that our 16-20% growth in this new segment is not restricted to metros, but emerging strongly from India's tier-2 cities."

Fiscal Consolidation Delay Strong Fresh Bookings

"The pace of expansion remains slow and turbulent may lie ahead," said IMF's Gourinchas. The finance ministry's economic review released on Monday indicated domestic demand and the government's supply side measures — taken to provide impetus to economic activity — to predict around 7% growth this fiscal.

"It is one thing for India to grow at 8.6% when the world economy is growing at 4%, but it is another thing to grow at or above 7% when the world economy is struggling to grow at 2%," chief economic adviser V Anantha Nageswaran noted in the ministry's report released ahead of the interim budget scheduled to be tabled on Thursday.

GLOBAL PROSPECTS
IMF, in its World Economic Outlook, noted that though risks to the global economy have moderated, artificial intelligence (AI) could boost investment and productivity, renewed

geopolitical tensions could still impact growth.

"Demand parameters, as indicated by bookings and enquiries, remain healthy," said Shashank Srivastava, senior executive officer (marketing and sales) at the country's largest carmaker Maruti Suzuki.

After Musheer's 131, backed by opener Adarsh Singh's 52, powered India to a huge total of 295/8, left-arm spinner Saamy Pandey (4/19) and pacer Raju Limbani (2/77) topped New Zealand's top order to bowl them out for a mere 81 in 281 over. Limbani struck on the first and the fifth ball of New Zealand innings to ensure momentum remained with India throughout.

McCullum Hints at an Asian Attack

Bhulia Demands President Chaubey's Resignation as AIFF Sacks Secy-Gen

Bhulia demanded President Chaubey's resignation on Tuesday, saying he had "breached" his trust. "I hold the executive committee members that Kalyan Chaudhary and treasurer Kipa Ajay should also resign. Shaji Prabhakaran should not be made the only scapegoat. All three of them are equally responsible for taking decisions without the approval of the executive committee," he said. "Indian football is in a mess, there is politics in the way, and that is not the only reason for the current state of affairs. It is a mess that we will have to live with over one year of taking charge, it is not good."

Another source confirmed Bhulia's version and added that Prabhakaran asked the executive committee members to explain to him why he had constituted the "breach of trust" which led to Prabhakaran's dismissal.
