Digital/online media now...

In January 2019, eight video streaming services had signed a self-regulatory code that laid down a set of guiding principles for content on these platforms. The code adopted by the OTTs prohibited five types of content, including those that deliberately and maliciously disrespect the national emblem or national flag, any visual or story line that promotes child pornography, any content that maliciously intends to outrage religious sentiments, content that deliberately and maliciously promotes or encourages terrorism etc. However, the government had refused to support this code. The government regulations will also apply to news on social media platforms such as Facebook, Twitter and Instagram.

Nitish maintains a...

The confusion is partially Nitish Kumar's own undoing; he had declared during campaigning that he is reluctant to continue as the chief minister. That in turn has triggered speculation that he may nominate BJP's Sushil Modi as his successor. The incumbent cabinet's last meeting will be held on Thursday when Nitish Kumar will recommend dissolution of the state assembly, to clear the decks for the new House. As per convention, he will also go to the Raj Bhawan to tender his resignation as Chief Minister. A section of the BJP leadership wants to see Union minister for law and justice, Ravishankar Prasad, in the saddle, thus giving a break to the JDU which has had a free run of the chief minister's office since 2005. BJP general secretary Bhupinder Yadav, while launching the BJP campaign in Bihar, had regretted that his party had its nominees as chief ministers in Himachal Pradesh and Assam but the party was playing second fiddle to the JDU in Bihar. The demand for change has come from some senior BJP leaders, too.

PM BASKS IN BJP'S...

Terming the Bihar polls results as "most special", he noted that the BJP is the only party which has seen its tally increase despite being in power in the state for three terms and added that it has performed spectacularly in states like Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat, too, despite ruling them for long. The BJP PM Modi said, is the only one which "truly has a national connect" with the people of India. "From just two MPs and two rooms, the BJP's influence today is all-pervasive, in every corner of India," he said amid slogans of "Modi hai toh mumkin hai (Anything is possible when Modi is around)". The BJP, bolstered by its dramatic success in Bihar, is now eyeing West Bengal, where it intends to mount its "final assault" on the Mamata Banerjee government.

After interim bail...

The Bench warned the High Court, asking it to exercise their jurisdiction to uphold personal liberty, noting that "we are seeing case after case where high courts are not granting bail and failing to protect personal liberty of people." The 3-page order says: "The concerned jail authorities and the Superintendent of Police, Raigad, are directed to ensure that this order - on release of Arnab Goswami on interim bail - is complied with forthwith."

Silawat, Rajput to...

Silawat and Rajput are all set to get ministerial berths. The aspirants for cabinet position in the ruling party want that they should also be sworn in with Rajput and Silawat. A four-time minister Girish Gautam said Vindhya region was under represented in the ministry. He said he wanted that Vindhya should be adequately represented in the cabinet. Among former ministers Rajendra Shukla, Sanjay Pathak, Rampal Singh, Gouri Shanker Bisen, Yashpal Singh Sisodia and Rameshwar Sharma are pulling out all the stops to get ministerial berths. Jyotiraditya Scindia may demand that his supporters should again be adjusted against the ministerial posts which have fallen vacant after the defeat of some former ministers.

Nitish should snap...

According to Singh, Rahul Gandhi is the only leader in the country who is fighting for ideology. The Congress has never compromised with Jan Sangh or BJP. The narrow politics of BJP has lowered the stature of Nitish and ended Ramvilas Paswan's legacy.

Finally, signs of...

Nonetheless, sources said both the Indian Army and the Chinese People's Liberation Army are looking at sealing the pact in the next round of Corps Commander-level talks. The ninth round of military talks are likely to take place in the next few days. Nearly 50,000 Indian Army troops are currently deployed in a high state of combat readiness in various mountainous locations in eastern Ladakh in sub-zero conditions. China has also deployed an equal number of troops, according to officials. The standoff between the two sides erupted in early May. As a first step, both sides will remove their tanks, artillery guns, armoured vehicles and large equipment from the friction points along the LAC to their rear bases within three days from linking the agreement, the sources said. Under the second step, the PLA will go back to Finger 8 areas from their current position of Finger 4 on the north bank of Pangong Lake while the Indian troops would position themselves close to the Dhan Singh Thapa post. The mountain spurs in the area are referred to as Fingers. It was also broadly agreed to withdraw around 30 per cent of the troops every day for three days. In the third step, it was agreed to complete the disengagement process in areas along the southern bank of Pangong Lake like Rezag La, Mukhpari and Magar hill. Indian troops are occupying a number of strategic heights in the Mukhpari, Rezag La and Magar hill areas around the southern bank of the lake. "These are all proposals. There is no agreement signed yet," said a high-level source, adding a bit of the scepticism to the gameplan.

SC for cracker ban, says life precious

Refuses to stay Calcutta HC order on fireworks

NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Wednesday said there cannot be anything more important than preservation of life amid the pandemic, as it declined to interfere with the Calcutta High Court order banning sale and use of firecrackers in West Bengal during Kali Puja, Diwali and other festivals. A vacation bench of Justices DY Chandrachud and Indira Banerjee said it is conscious about the importance of festivals, but amid the pandemic, everybody should come out to support a decision which im-

Take violators to task, says HC

KOLKATA: A division bench of Justices Sanjib Banerjee and Arijit Banerjee of the Calcutta HC directed the police to take steps against sale and purchase of firecrackers banned in West Bengal as directed by the same court earlier. It said if the police failed to stop the marketing and purchase of the firecrackers, the concerned district magistrate, SP and police chief will be held responsible. Advocate general Kishore Dutta assured the administration will take steps to implement the order.

proves the situation. They said the HC is much aware of the local situation and it should be allowed to do what is necessary. The SC observations came while hearing an appeal by Gautam Roy and the Burra-bazaar Fireworks Dealers Association, against the HC order, which banned use and sale of firecrackers in the upcoming festivals, including Kali Puja, Diwali and Chhath Puja, as a

measure to address air pollution. It said life itself is in danger now and people should come together to deal with the problem. The SC told the petitioner's counsel the virus has hit people in hospitals, elderly people etc. "Can anyone step out of the house in Kolkata, Delhi or any other part of the country today," it asked. Bhatnagar, appearing for a petitioner, submitted HC had no empirical data to conclude to impose a cracker ban. Nagaland bans crackers till Jan 31: The Nagaland government has banned firecrackers across the state till January 31 next year to curb pollution. And, Crackers have also been banned in Guwahati till month-end.

Now, Bengal is prime focus: Vijayvargiya

AGENCIES / KOLKATA: After clinching the Bihar assembly polls, West Bengal will be the "prime focus" for BJP where it has set a target of winning more than 200 seats in the state elections due in April-May 2021, party national general secretary Kailash Vijayvargiya said on Wednesday. The NDA has won 125 seats in the 243-member Bihar assembly, results of which were declared

on Tuesday. The BJP with its score of 74 seats has emerged as the party to have won the second highest number of seats after Lalu Prasad's RJD. The saffron party's tally is much higher than that of its ally - the JD(U) which won 43 seats. It will now shift its focus to politically crucial West Bengal, which sends 42 MPs to the Lok Sabha - two more than Bihar, Vijayvargiya, who is also BJP's in-

charge of Bengal, said. The BJP, which has made deep inroads in West Bengal by winning 18 of its 42 Lok Sabha seat - four less than ruling TMC in the 2019 general election, was waiting for the Bihar election results before mounting its "final assault" on the Mamata Banerjee government, party sources said.

Dalit man dies in custody, 4 cops booked for murder

A case of murder has been registered against four cops in Bundi district of Rajasthan after the death of a 55-year-old Dalit man in police custody. SP Shivraj Singh Meena has also shunted out all the 45-member staff of Sadar police station, including station house officer Shaikat Khan. Family members of victim Harji Kanjar, an alleged gambler, said he died in custody on Monday some time after he was forcibly taken by four policemen from his home in Ramnagar village. He was killed for not paying them for his release, they said. While the cops had been suspended after Harji's death, murder charges were pressed on them after members of the Kanjar community staged a protest outside the police station and blocked the Bundi-Bijolia road for several hours on Tuesday. The crowd later took the body for last rites.

ED points finger at CM office in gold smuggling, housing scams

The link between the chief minister's office (CMO) and gold smuggling through the diplomatic channel has come out in the open, with Swapna Suresh telling the Enforcement Directorate that former principal secretary M Sivasankar and his team in the CMO were aware of whatever was going on. It has also been confirmed that the CMO intervened to get the detained bag containing the smuggled gold released from the Customs. The explosive disclosure was made by Enforcement Directorate to the court in a sealed envelope in its plea to seek further custody of Sivasankar after the investigators questioned Swapna Suresh over the past two days in her jail.
