NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to Section 110 read with Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 (“**the Act**”) and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Act and Rule 20 and Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (“**Rules**”), Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“**SEBI Listing Regulations**”) and the Secretarial Standard on General Meetings issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India (“**SS-2**”), as amended from time to time, read with the General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020, 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020, 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020, 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021, 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021, 02/2022 dated May 5, 2022, 11/2022 dated December 28, 2022 and General Circular No. 9/2023 dated 25th September, 2023 issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (“**MCA**”) (hereinafter collectively referred to as “**MCA Circulars**”), for the approval of the Members of **Wonder Electricals Limited Formerly known as Wonder Fibromats Limited (“Company”)** through Postal Ballot by voting through electronic means (“remote e-voting”) on the Special Resolutions set out hereinafter.

[Pursuant to Sections 102 and 110 of the Companies Act, 2013]

The following Statement sets out all material facts relating to the businesses mentioned under Item Nos. 1 of the accompanying Notice:

Item No. 1:

Mr. Yogesh Sahni, a promoter director, has been on the Board of the Company since June 07, 2013. As per the provisions of Sections 196, 197, 198 and 203 read with Schedule V of the Companies Act, 2013 and Article of Association of the Company, Mr. Yogesh Sahni is eligible to be designated as Managing Director of the Company.

As per the provision of 17(6)(e) of SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulation, 2015, the remuneration payable to Mr. Yogesh Sahni, Managing Director may exceed 5 per cent of the net profits of the Company in any year during the tenure of his appointment and the approval accorded herein shall also be deemed to be the approval as contemplated under Regulation 17(6)(e) of the Listing Regulations which specifies limits on promoter executive Directors’ remuneration.

Based on the recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee and keeping in view of his vast experience in different industries (packaging, stationery, construction) over the last 4 decades and exposure in the field of Manufacturing of component & materials used in the manufacturing of electric ceiling & exhaust Fans, the Board of Directors of the Company at its meeting held on 04th March 2024, has designate and approve the appointment of Mr. Yogesh Sahni (DIN 00811667), as Managing Director of the company for a period of 5 years w.e.f. 04th March, 2024 to 03rd March, 2029 (both days inclusive), subject to the approval of members, on such terms and conditions set out herein below.

1. The Managing Director shall perform their duties the supervision and control of the Board, be entrusted with substantial powers of Management
2. Period of Appointment: For the period of 5 years w.e.f. March 04, 2024

3. Remuneration Proposed:

The Remuneration payable to Mr. Yogesh Sahni will be as follows:

- I. Salary: Not Exceeding Rs. 32,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty-two Lakhs only) per annum.
 - II. Allowance, Perquisites and other benefits: As per Company's policies or as approved by the Board and/or Nomination and Remuneration Committee of the company from time to time.
 - III. The aggregate of Salary, together with perquisites, allowance and other benefits payable to Mr. Yogesh Sahni in any financial year shall not exceed Rs. 32,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty-Two lakhs only) per annum.
4. In addition to above, he shall be entitled for Company's contribution to Provident Fund, leave encashment and payment of gratuity as per the Companies Policy;
 5. The perquisites shall be valued in terms of actual expenditure incurred by the Company and shall be evaluated wherever applicable as per Income Tax Act, 1961 or rules made thereunder and any modification thereof.
 6. In case the Company has no profits or its profits are inadequate in any financial year during his tenure, the Company will pay remuneration by way of salary, benefits, perquisites and allowances as mentioned in point 3 above as minimum remuneration, subject to further approvals as required under Schedule V of the Act, or any modification(s) thereto.
 7. The limits specified above are the maximum limits and the Nomination and Remuneration Committee / Board may in its absolute discretion pay to the above-mentioned Director lower remuneration and revise the same from time to time subject to the maximum limits stipulated above.
 8. The Managing Director is appointed by virtue of his employment in the Company and his appointment is subject to the provisions of Section 167 of the Companies Act, 2013 while at the same time Managing Directors are liable to retire by rotation. The appointment is terminable by giving three months' notice in writing on either side.

The above may be treated as a written memorandum setting out the terms of appointment of Mr. Yogesh Sahni under Section 190 of the Act. Other details of Mr. Sahni as required under the provisions of Regulation 36(3) of the SEBI Listing Regulations, 2015, para 1.2.5 of SS-2 and other applicable provisions are provided in **Annexure – I** to this Notice.

Mr. Sahni is not debarred from holding the office of the director by virtue of any SEBI order or any other such authority. Accordingly, the Board of Directors recommends resolution as set out in item No. 1 for approval of the Shareholders of the Company by way of passing a **Special Resolution**.

Except Mr. Yogesh Sahni (Appointee), Mr. Siddhant Sahni and their relatives to the extent of their shareholding, if any, in the Company, none of other Directors or Key Managerial personnel of the Company and/or their relatives is concerned or interested, financially or otherwise, in the aforesaid Resolution.
