# IITG Director attends workshop valedictory session at USTM



**Assam Rising, Guwahati, November 10:** Rural development is very critical for us. If India wants to become a 5 trillion economy, we need to solve the problems in its villages. For the first time in India, the Government, teaming up with top IITs of India has come up with "planning of villages". This was stated by Prof. TG Sitharam, Director, IIT Guwahati while addressing the valedictory session of the 2-week-long capacity building programme on "Research & Training-Learning Process for the Faculty in Social Sciences" here yesterday. The programme was organised by the Department of Rural Development, University of Science and Technology Meghalaya (USTM) with support from the Indian Council of Social Science Research. The session was also addressed by Prof. V Suresh Babu, NIRDPR-NERC; Anusua Butta Baruah, IAS, Secy., Food, Civil Supply and Consumer Affairs, Govt. of Assam, Prod GD Sharma, VC, USTM, apart from others. Addressing the partici-

pants, Prof. Sitharam said that the initiative of village planning is expected to be done in the tune of town planning or city planning which is quite different from the existing concept of development of villages. This rural planning would be short term as well as long term. The short-term plan is for 5 years and the long-term planning is for 25 years. "IIT Guwahati has selected two villages from Kamrup (Rural) District of Assam in the initial stage. We are finding out which are the prime locations or properties in the villages, how do we manage the solid waste in the villages, how do we give water supply etc.-- basically planning for development." Social entrepreneurship has to happen in a big way, he emphasised. He also said that this village planning is exactly like town planning. "This village planning process is being started for the first time in India taking only 20 villages across India as of now, which is being done by the Ministry of Panchayat Raj, all IITs and 10 schools of planning", he added. Speaking on research, he said that funding for Social Science research is limited while in science and technology research the Government provides huge funds. Therefore, he advised that the "social scientists should bring scientists, technologists and entrepreneurs into its course. That will change the complete perspective". The programme ended with distribution of certificates and mementos to all the participants of the 2-week-long capacity building programme on Research & Training-Learning Process.

## Eviction drive against encroachment of railway land at Nagaon

**Staff Reporter, Nagaon, November 10:** As per directive of Indian Railways, district administration well equipped with sufficient police as well as para military forces, led by the circle officer, Nagaon Sadar - K. Ishan Singh today carried out a massive eviction drive against encroachment of railway land at Nagaon railway station colony near Morikolung under Nagaon PS. During the drive, the administration demolished over hundred of houses of encroachers on both sides of the railway track near the railway colony. Sources claimed that the district administration issued notices to over a thousand encroachers a couple of weeks ago and urged

them to cooperate with the administration in this regard by shifting away from the railway land. Significantly, after receiving the notification from the administration, many of them abandoned their respective houses and shifted to other places for which the eviction drive that was carried out today was quite peaceful. No incidents of scuffle between the police or para military forces and encroachers was reported till the time of filing this report, sources said, adding that the administration would carry out further eviction drives against the rest of the encroachers in due course of time too. While speaking to some local media persons here, K. Ishan Singh, Nagaon Sadar circle officer said the administration will take the same measures against those encroachers who erected houses or constructed multi storey building at government land near Nagaon Morikolung and covered even to the heart of the stagnant water body of Morikolung.
