SC rejects plea seeking to terminate over-25-week pregnancy

New Delhi, May 29

THE SUPREME COURT has rejected a plea filed by a woman seeking permission to terminate her over-25-week pregnancy, but refrained from making public the reasons for its decision to protect her privacy. A vacation bench of justices

Abhay S Oka and Satish Chandra Sharma perused a report filed by the AIIMS, Delhi which was asked by the apex court last week to ascertain the physical condition of the woman and her foetus. "We have perused the report dated May 24, 2024 submitted by All India Institute of Medical Sciences. We are not

quoting what is mentioned in the report for protecting the privacy of the petitioner." "But in the light of the report, we cannot permit termination of pregnancy in the facts of the case. The report shall remain on record in sealed envelope. The writ petition is rejected," the bench said in its order passed on

May 27. While hearing the plea on May 21, the top court had asked the AIIMS to submit a report before it by May 24 regarding the physical health of the petitioner as well as of the foetus and its impact on the former's unwanted pregnancy. It had passed the order on a plea of the woman who claimed she

came to know about her pregnancy only on May 17. "She has come all the way from Dubai and is currently staying in a hotel here. She is not that financially strong," her counsel had told the apex court on May 21 and urged the bench to allow her to terminate her pregnancy. **PTI**

Delhi sizzles at 80-yr high, ₹2,000 fine for wasting water

THE MUNGESHPUR WEATHER station in Delhi recorded a maximum temperature of 52.9 degree Celsius on Wednesday, an all-time record for any location in India, prompting the Met office to rush its scientists to check the authenticity of the reading. The same station had recorded 49.9 degree Celsius on Tuesday, an all-time high for Delhi.

The Safdarjung weather observatory, which serves as the marker for the entire city, registered a maximum temperature of 46.8 degree Celsius on Wednesday, the highest in 80 years.

It was six degrees higher than the normal expected at this time of the year, and the highest that the station has recorded since 1944. But it was substantially lower than the temperature at Mungeshpur,

located on the northern outskirts of Delhi, bordering Haryana.

"The maximum temperature over Delhi NCR varied from 45.2 degree Celsius to 49.1 degree Celsius in different parts of the city. Mungeshpur reported 52.9 degree Celsius as an outlier compared to other stations. It could be due to an error in the sensor of local factors. IMD is examining the data and sensors," the India Meteorological Department said in a statement.

IMD runs 20 weather stations in Delhi, 15 of which are automatic weather stations, or AWS. The closest to Mungeshpur is the Narela station, about a 16 km away, which recorded a maximum of 48.4 degree Celsius. Incidentally, the Narela station had recorded the same temperature as Mungeshpur on Tuesday, 49.9 degree Celsius.

Najafgarh station recorded 49.1 degree Celsius as the maximum temperature, the highest for any Delhi observatory on Wednesday, while Pusa Road recorded 49 degrees.

Unlike Mungeshpur, Safdarjung is a manual observatory, where observations are taken manually every three hours. Automatic weather stations (AWS) such as Mungeshpur record and transmit weather parameters without any human intervention. AWS are not uncommon. In fact, they form the bulk of the IMD network. More than 800 AWS are installed all over the country.

Amid the heatwave conditions and a water crisis in the city, the Delhi government on Wednesday announced a ₹2,000 fine for wasting water by washing vehicles with a hose or letting the water tank overflow. This came a day after Delhi water minister Atishi appealed to the people to conserve water amid the high temperatures and the crisis in water supply.

Additional SP, Gonda, Radhey Shyam Rai said they are recording the driver's statement to understand the sequence of events. Rai refused to share any further details. According to another police officer, a preliminary inquiry has revealed that on Wednesday morning, Karan Singh's convoy, comprising four vehicles, was passing through Karnal ganj. While three vehicles had crossed the railway crossing, the fourth vehicle, which was involved, stayed back as a train was passing. After the train passed, the driver of the fourth vehicle allegedly sped up in an attempt to catch up with the other vehicles. The SUV collided with a motorcycle coming from the opposite direction.

Two knocked dead in UP by SUV in convoy of Brij Bhushan's son

TWO MEN, AGED 19 and 24, died when an SUV that was allegedly part of the convoy of BJP candidate Karan Bhushan Singh — son of incumbent MP Brij Bhushan Singh — allegedly hit their motorcycle in Karnal ganj police station area of Gonda district. Police identified the dead as Shehzad Khan (24) and Rehan Khan (19), both local residents, police said. The police have seized the SUV and arrested its driver, Lavkush Srivastava. Kaiserganj, the constituency where Karan is contesting, voted on May 20 in the fifth phase of the Lok Sabha polls.

Govt begins granting citizenship under CAA in three states

Govt begins granting citizenship under CAA in three states

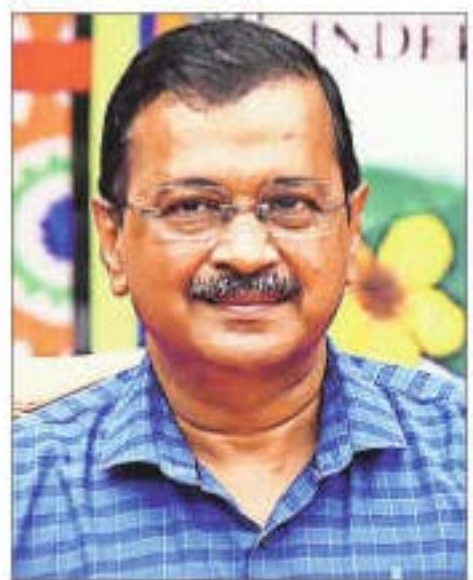

THE CENTRE ON Wednesday started granting citizenship under the CAA in West Bengal, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh, the home ministry said. The applicants in the three states were granted citizenship on Wednesday by the respective State Empowered Committee, the ministry said in a statement. The first set of citizenship certificates after the notification of the Citizenship (Amendment) Rules, 2024, granted by the Empowered Committee, Delhi, were handed over to the applicants in New Delhi by the Union Home Secretary on May 15.

SC Registry declines Kejriwal plea for hearing interim bail extension

CALLING IT "MISCONCEIVED", the Supreme Court Registry has declined to accept Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal's request for an urgent hearing of his application seeking a week's extension of his interim bail to allow him to undergo medical tests. Arrested by the Enforcement Directorate on March 21 in the Delhi excise policy case, Kejriwal is required to surrender on June 2 at the end of the interim bail granted on May 10 for election campaigning.

him it would refer the request to the Chief Justice of India for appropriate orders. The Registry, in an order dated May 28, said that Order XV Rule 5 of Supreme Court Rules, 2013 enables the Registrar to refuse receiving a petition if it discloses no reasonable cause or is frivolous or contains scandalous matter.

It pointed out that the SC, while reserving its order on his petition challenging his arrest

by the ED in the Delhi excise policy case, had said that Kejriwal may, if advised, file an application for grant of bail, without prejudice to his rights and contentions, notwithstanding the fact that the court had reserved the judgment. "Once the main appeal is reserved for judgment upon conclusion of arguments and liberty is granted to the Applicant by this Hon'ble Court, the question of the Applicant again approaching this Hon'ble Court for the above said relief is misconceived. The relief sought for in the present application is directly in conflict with and contrary to the Order dated 17.05.2024 passed by this Hon'ble Court," the Registry said. In his plea, Kejriwal sought to surrender on June 9. Saying that he lost 6-7 kg during the period of his arrest, he said that the sudden and unexplained weight loss, coupled with high ketone levels, could be indicative of kidney damage, serious cardiac ailments and even cancer.
