Video of spat between Datasra and party MLA surfaces on social media

A HEATED argument broke out between Rajasthan Congress chief Govind Singh Datasra and Congress MLA Rajendra Pareek at a review meeting of developmental projects in Sikar district on Monday.

The meeting was convened by the minister in-charge of the district Shaktantala Rawat at the Sikar collectorate auditorium. Both Datasra and Pareek are MLAs from the district. A video clip of the incident was widely shared on social media.

The argument started during a discussion on the issue of drainage and a flyover project when the Pradesh Congress Committee chief asked Pareek not to side with officials.

There was a heated argument between the two when Datasra told Pareek, "You don't have the contract of what is and what is not to be done in Sikar... you are a leader like me... stay within limits." Pareek shot back at Datasra saying he should be "ashamed". Rawat intervened and tried to pacify both leaders.

After the meeting, Datasra told reporters that discussions on various development projects were held in the meeting.

On the spat, he said on issues of public interest, Congress representatives do that but there are no differences among the leaders.

Man gets life in jail for raping 16-year-old girl

A SPECIAL court in Kota on Monday convicted a young man of raping a 16-year-old girl last year and sentenced him to life imprisonment.

The court held the man guilty under relevant sections of the IPC and the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act and also imposed a penalty of Rs 45,000 on him, POCSO court-3 public prosecutor Lalit Sharma said.

The minor survivor had on April 25, 2022 lodged a report with the police accusing the convict of barging into her home on April 14 and raping and threatening her while her parents were away, he added.

The police had booked the convict under sections of the IPC and the POCSO Act, and arrested him after initial investigations, Sharma said.

He added the convict had told police that one of his aides, who was a minor, guarded the gate during the crime, following which the police incorporated the charge of gang rape, detained the minor and filed a charge sheet in the matter.

The case against the minor is under trial at a juvenile justice board.

'Naughty boy fully tamed': ISRO launches first of five second-gen navigation satellite

THE INDIAN Space Research Organisation (ISRO) on Monday successfully launched the first of the five second-generation satellites for the Navigation by Indian Constellation (NavIC), with the organisation's chairperson stating that the agency will make the constellation "fully operational".

The constellation is plagued by failing atomic clocks and satellites nearing the end of their mission life.

"We are going to make this NavIC system fully functional and operational for the benefit of the nation. There is a huge amount of opportunity waiting for us," ISRO chairperson S

Somanath said after the launch.

The satellite took off from the second launch pad at 10.42 am aboard GSLV-F12 and was inserted just over 18 minutes later into a geosynchronous transfer orbit of 173 km x 40,700 km that will be circularised over the next couple of days to bring the satellite to its final position. The solar panels have already been deployed.

"This is a very good orbit and will give better life to the satellite," mission director N P Giri said after the launch.

The satellite has a mission life of more than 12 years, longer than the 10-year mission life of the first-generation satellites in the constellation.

Christened NVS-01, the satellite launched on Monday will be one of the five second-

generation satellites to be launched for the constellation, Somanath said.

The Indian Express had earlier reported that only four of the existing satellites in the constellation continue to provide

location data.

The satellite also carried on board the indigenously developed rubidium atomic clock and the first magnetic levitation reaction wheel (reaction wheels are used to control the orientation of spacecraft precisely). The satellite will provide signals in L1 frequency — along with the L5 and S band frequencies used by its predecessors — making it more inter-operable with GPS that commonly uses the signal to provide civilian navigation, positioning, and time data.

"I do believe that the naughty boy has been fully tamed," satellite director K V S Bhaskar said, referring to the epithet given to the launch vehicle owing to its unreliability during initial launches.

Nearly five — four failures

and one partial failure — of 15 launches with the vehicle have failed, compared to three of 57 launches by ISRO's workhorse, PSLV. Monday's was the first launch using the vehicle since its failure in August 2021 and changes were made based on recommendations by a failure analysis committee.

The 2021 launch had failed when a malfunctioning valve led to insufficient pressure in the liquid hydrogen tank in the cryogenic upper stage. Somanath said, "I am very happy that the corrections and modifications in the cryogenic stage that we have done — as well as the lessons out of it — (have made) our cryogenic stage more reliable and we are seeing success in our LVM3 mission as well."

While new Parliament was being inaugurated, women faced police action, says Anand Sharma

CONGRESS LEADER Anand Sharma on Monday attacked the central government saying while the country celebrated inauguration of the new Parliament, women wrestlers were beaten on road by police.

The country saw two pictures on Sunday — one of the inauguration of the new parliament building and the other depicting misbehaviour with women wrestlers who had been agitating at Jantar Mantar, he said.

As he made the remark, the former Union minister demanded action against Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) chief Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh, who has been accused of sexual harassment by women wrestlers. Singh was earlier booked in two FIRs

by the Delhi Police, one of them for allegedly sexually harassing a minor girl.

"In the last nine years, what should have happened was

not done and what should not have been done was done by the Modi government," Sharma said at a press conference at PCC office in Jaipur.

Commenting on the performance of the central government in the last nine years, Sharma said that Modi and his government should give answers to what happened to the promises the BJP had made during elections, including that of 2 crore new jobs.

He said the unemployment rate in the country is highest under the Modi rule and there is an atmosphere of fear in the country.

The Congress leader said all reasons given for 2016 demonetisation were proven wrong with many small units shut forever and unorganised sector labourers getting the roughest end of the deal.

He also said that there was no answer from the government as to why the currency note of Rs 2000 was withdrawn from circulation — a decision made on May 19 this year.

PM Modi should talk about the achievements of the former governments too, Sharma advised the government.

The politician also expressed his view on situation in violence-hit Manipur, saying some serious tension was brewing in the northeastern state.

Asked about the ongoing tussle between Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot and his former deputy Sachin Pilot, Sharma refused to comment on the matter saying it is the jurisdiction of the party president Mallikarjun Kharge.

Praising the work of the Gehlot government, he said, "There is a strong government in Rajasthan and Ashok Gehlot is the chief minister. The manner in which works have been done in the state, we (party) are assured that what happened in Himachal Pradesh and Karnataka will happen in Rajasthan too."
