OVERHEARD

Department of first love

Principal Secretary (PS) who has been in a department since the days of the BJP rule does not want to get out of it. Whenever there are talks about his transfer from the department he gives it the old college try to stop his shifting from there. The PS may have been recently shifted to another place, but he has been appreciated with the charge of the department of his first love. The PS may have been given the responsibility of another department, but nobody dared shift him from the one where he has been posted since the days of the BJP rule. During the BJP regime, he was shifted from the department, yet he had pulled out all the stops to get his transfer cancelled. The reasons for the PS's special interest in the department are mysterious, though. Yet, people in the corridors of power say the PS has some personal interests in some of the projects of the department. Besides, he is working on some new projects. Perhaps, this is the reason why he wants to remain in the department.

Bossy ACS

Many officers in an important unit are fed up with the Additional Chief Secretary (ACS). After becoming the ACS, he has begun to dominate the officers in every meeting. Officers are less than able to persuade him of any issue. The ACS only says he is acquainted with everything. The officer remains present in every important meeting and interferes in every affair. The ACS thinks too much of himself and makes such mistakes as may cause trouble to the government in coming days. The ACS is not on good terms with the minister of the department, but since the government has yet to find an alternative to him, he cannot be transferred to another place. Many officers want to go to the Centre on deputation so some officials are eagerly waiting for his departure from the state. The officials of the department also want that, there should be someone in place of the ACS. Nevertheless, barely any officer is keen to join the department. The name of an ACS for posting to this department was doing the rounds, but as he was transferred to an important unit, his name is no more discussed for the post.

Out of harm's way

An additional chief secretary-level officer recently came to Bhopal from Delhi on an official tour to lobby for himself. An inquiry into a case, in which the ACS is enmeshed, is on. There are many proofs against him in connection with the case, but his links with the higher-ups have so far saved him. He is sparing no effort to remain out of harm's way. During his stay in Bhopal, the ACS spoke to some people through an IPS officer that there may not be any action against him. There are reports that the officer has also spoken to a powerful person about the case. Many of the colleagues of the ACS, however, said he was not involved in any scam. The ACS is also issuing warning that, if any action is taken against him he will go to court. But the officer who is known for his sound temperament is looking scared. The ACS fears that a senior officer may take action against him. So he is worried about it.

Passing time!

A female additional chief secretary is hardly seen in any function of the department she heads. The department recently held some big events, but she did not attend any of them. Many a time she skips the meetings. Though the ACS approves the files that reach her table, she barely takes interest in any other matter. The minister of the department is very powerful, but he, too, has understood her attitude so he hardly pays any heed to her absences from the meetings. The ACS has barely had any interest in her work, and she is simply passing time. She has kept away from taking charge of any important department. She went on leave when she was shifted to an important unit. The lacklustre attitude of the ACS has made the employees in the department very happy. Since the ACS rarely objects to giving her nod to any file things are moving the way they want.

Good posting ahead

Two female IAS officers are all set to get important departments. One of them posted to a federation in the state capital may be appointed as collector of any district in coming days. During the BJP rule, this female officer was shifted from a district after she had picked a fight with a leader of the then ruling party. So she was deprived of any field posting after that incident. Now, the government plans to give her a field posting. Similarly, a female collector may be given the charge of a big district. It is not easy for a woman to manage the district where she has been posted now, but she is efficiently running the administration there. The government is searching for an important district where she may be posted. Both of them are efficient. So the higher-ups want to post them to some places where the government can get some important work done through them.

High hope

The return of an Additional Chief Secretary-level officer to an important department has raised hope among those officers who have been relegated to insignificance. After the Congress took over the reins of power in the state, the ACS was given an unimportant department. As he had been on good terms with the leaders of the Sangh and those of the BJP, it was expected that he would never return to the mainstream of administration. So his getting an important post surprised many of his colleagues. A senior IAS officer and some Congress leaders threw in their lot with the ACS in his attempt to get an important posting. After the ACS's return, another officer pushed into the depths of insignificance has begun to search for links to get a key position. He hopes he may get a critical post in coming days. Besides him, another officer is trying hard to please his superiors to get a coveted post.

Bid to put up fence at Parsi Library, DEO stops work

Large scale erection work of the boundary fencing to cover about one and a half acres of defence land around the Parsi library in Mhow cantonment was going on since Saturday night. The work continued even on Sunday at full swing but as soon as the Defence Estates Officer (DEO) Neha Gupta came to know about it, she reached the place and ordered to stop the work immediately on Sunday evening. She also asked her staff to demolish the fencing and said that rest of the

demolition will be carried out on Monday.

DEO is the custodian of land belonging to Ministry of Defence and had put a signboard outside the British time library building just to prevent any illegal encroachment on the land last year after the issue of illegal encroachment of Parsi library surfaced in Mhow. The board displays the ownership of the land and a warning regarding legal action to be taken in case anybody is found encroaching on it.

As per the sources, P. Agrawal reached the library

premises and started arguing with DEO Neha Gupta about the ownership of the said land. His plea was that he had purchased the land but when Gupta asked her to show the papers, he was left unanswered. On the contrary, Gupta warned him of lodging an FIR against him for illegally purchasing the defence land.

Iran: Smog forces closure of schools

AGENCIES/ Tehran

Air pollution forced schools to close on Sunday in parts of Iran including Tehran, state media reported, as the capital lay under a thick cloud of smog.

The pollution level in the capital was "unhealthy for sensitive groups" and officials warned the young, elderly and people with respiratory illnesses to stay indoors, with sporting activities suspended. The decision to shut schools in the capital

was announced late Saturday by deputy governor Mohammad Taghizadeh, after a meeting of an emergency committee on air pollution.

"All of (Tehran) province's schools except for Firuzkuh and Davamand counties are closed for Sunday," he said, quoted by state news agency IRNA. Schools in the capital may stay closed on Monday, the third day of the Iranian working week, he added.

An "odd-even" traffic scheme based on vehicles'

registration numbers was imposed to restrict traffic in the capital, IRNA reported.

Trucks were banned outright in Tehran province.

Taghizadeh added that all activities at Tehran province's numerous sand quarries would also be halted. A grey cloud hung over Tehran on Sunday, obstructing the view of the mountains overlooking the city to the north. Average airborne concentration of the finest and most hazardous particles (PM2.5) was at 145 microgrammes per cubic metre for the 24 hours until Sunday noon, according to government website airteliran.ir. That is close to six times the World Health Organization's recommended maximum of 25 microgrammes per m3. Schools were also closed in the northern province of Alborz and in the central cities of Qom and Arak, IRNA reported.
