## Farmers' kites...

Farmers from several places in Punjab reached the Shambhu border to participate in the 'Delhi Chalo' march and a large number of tractor-trolleys could be seen parked along the national highway on the Punjab side. The Haryana security personnel lobbed a few tear gas shells on Wednesday morning after some farmers gathered near the barricades at the Shambhu border. Thereafter, the tear gas shells were fired whenever the protesters attempted to move towards barricades. On Tuesday, the first day of the 'Delhi Chalo' agitation, several protesters and policemen were injured in clashes at Shambhu and Data Singhwala-Khanauri borders. Farmer leader Jagjit Singh Dallewal said they are ready for holding talks with the Centre over their demands, including a legal guarantee to MSP.

## Man falls prey...

Guntu then told Bhuraria that his MDMA case was being probed by an IPS officer Bal Singh Rajput. Later, Rajput too joined the video call and asked Bhuraria to send Aadhar card details to him. He then sent a copy of a forged FIR to Bhuraria, and asked him to submit his banking details, as well as bank statements of the last six months. Rajput asked Bhuraria to submit 49% of the amount lying in his bank account to his bank account by January 31, which would be refunded to him after probe.

On January 31, Bhuraria deposited Rs 68 lakh in Rajput's bank account in three installments. Post this, Rajput and the other callers broke all contacts and became unreachable. Realising that he had fallen victim to a fraud, Bhuraria reported the case to Koh-e-fiza police, which roped in the cyber cell on Wednesday to trace and identify the accused.

## For RS polls...

Nath was also close to former chief minister Digvijaya Singh during the Congress rule. Because of his influence among the SC community, Nath is being sent to the RS. Narolia comes from the Jat community, and Banishilal is a Gurjar. The BJP is sending them to the RS to woo the people of both the communities, keeping in mind the Lok Sabha election. Murugan, a minister of state in the Central Government, comes from Tamil Nadu. He was previously sent to the RS from MP. He has again been given ticket for the RS from the state.

According to reports, the candidates themselves did not know that they would be sent to the RS.

## Tribal stripped, thrashed...

The victim, a resident of Baspani, was brought to Betul by one of the accused on some pretext. "I was hung upside down in a room and beaten with a belt, slippers and sticks," the victim told the police. An FIR was subsequently registered against three persons, a police official said. He also added that one accused had been arrested and two others were at large. The victim told reporters on Tuesday that he was afraid of the culprits due to their 'criminal background' and hence dithered on reporting the matter to the police.

## PM inaugurates Abu...

Earlier, Modi met people from different faiths who contributed to the construction of the first Hindu stone temple here.

The prime minister also offered water in the virtual Ganga and Yamuna rivers at the temple before proceeding to inaugurate the temple built on a 27-acre site in Abu Mreikah, near Al Rahba off the Dubai-Abu Dhabi Sheikh Zayed Highway, at a cost of around Rs 700 crore.

According to the temple authorities, the grand temple has been built as per an ancient style of construction and creation mentioned in the Shilpa and Sthapathya Shastras, Hindu scriptures which describe the art for mandir design and construction.

"The architectural methods have been clubbed with scientific techniques here. Over 300 high-tech sensors have been installed at every level of the temple to measure temperature, pressure and movement (seismic activity). The sensors will provide live data for research. If there is any earthquake in the region, the temple will detect it, and we will be able to study," Swami Brahmaviharidas, head of international relations for BAPS, told PTI.

## Congress attitude lacklustre...

Vijayvargiya's strategy to deal with Harda tragedy came handy for the government. He kept the tragedy away from the discussion in the House through an adjournment motion on it. It happened for the first time that such a tragedy occurred a day before the beginning of the assembly session, and that the opposition failed to corner the government. Apart from the Harda fire-cracker factory blast, the opposition failed to raise the issues like a tribal youth being made naked and beaten up, government's failure to declare the results of the Patwari recruitment examination, the pulling down of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel's statue by a tractor-trolley, court's comments on nursing colleges and the damaging of crops. These were the issues that the Congress could have forcefully raised in the House. The opposition legislators could not even silence the government with reasons and data. Besides vote-on-account and interim budget, the Governor's speech was discussed in the House, but not a single member from the opposition bench displayed any courage to take the ruling party to task. Many Congress legislators still look disappointed for the party's failure to form a government in the state. Such people have barely shown any interest in the functioning of the House. In the session, it was clear that if the Congress continues to behave in this way, the ruling party will not have to think about running the House smoothly.

## Sonia files RS...

The Congress is comfortably placed to win one of the three Rajya Sabha seats from Rajasthan for which elections will be held. The seat will fall vacant after former prime minister Manmohan Singh completes his six-year tenure in April. It will be Sonia Gandhi's first term in the Upper House after serving five terms as a Lok Sabha MP.

The 77-year-old, who represented Rae Bareilly in Lok Sabha, will not contest the next general elections. She was first elected as an MP in 1999 after taking over as the Congress president. In a post on X earlier in the day, Gehlot said, "We heartily welcome the announcement of respected Smt. Sonia Gandhi ji as the Rajya Sabha candidate from the Congress Party, who renounced the post of Prime Minister." "Today her announcement as Rajya Sabha candidate from Rajasthan is a matter of happiness for the entire state and with this announcement all the old memories have been refreshed," he added. A total of 56 members of Rajya Sabha from 15 states are retiring in April and the election to the seats will be held on February 27. The last date for filing nominations is February 15.

## Justice Paul seeks...

The Collegium accepted his request. "By a communication dated 12 February 2024, Mr Justice Sujoy Paul has sought a transfer on the ground that his son is practicing in the High Court of Madhya Pradesh. The Collegium accedes to the request and resolves to recommend that Mr Justice Sujoy Paul be transferred, in the interests of the better administration of justice, to the High Court for the State of Telangana," the resolution reads. Justice Paul is currently serving at Jabalpur bench of MP High Court. Previously, he was at Indore bench.

## WE SURVIVED ONLY BECAUSE OF OUR DEFENCE TRAINING

## Says Navy veteran released from Qatar

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM

Ragesh Gopakumar, one of the 8 ex-Indian Navy personnel released by the Qatar government, said on Wednesday that they survived the prison days only due to their defence training.

Expressing joy and gratitude over returning home and being reunited with his family after spending months in captivity in the tiny gulf nation, he also thanked Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the Indian government for their release.

"We are just happy to be alive... happy to be home," a relieved Gopakumar said.

"Prison and confinement is something terrible," he said, adding he and his colleagues survived only because of the training they underwent as Defence forces.

He along with seven other former Navy personnel returned on Monday, nearly three-and-a-half months after a Qatari court handed them death sentence that was subsequently commuted to varying jail terms.

Gopakumar, who served as a Petty Officer in the Navy, said he had retired in 2017 and later joined the Oman Defence training company as a communications instructor.

He resides in Balaramapuram, a suburb located over 16 km away from Kerala's capital city.

Whenever someone enquired what the plight of his family had been when he was in prison, he would ask them to imagine a situation where a husband who used to speak to his wife at least five times a day suddenly stopped calling her.

The former Navy veteran

attributed his release to his family's prayers and the efforts of the Union government.

Lavishing praises on Prime Minister Modi, he said it was only because of his personal intervention that their release was made possible.

Gopakumar said all of them were hopeful that they would step out of the prison "if Modi intervened" but had no idea how long it would take.

He also expressed gratitude to the central government for having made arrangements to bring the families of the jailed ex-Naval officers to Qatar.

## Deoband will not welcome any political leaders

## UNTIL LS POLLS

SAHARANPUR (UP)

Darul Uloom, an Islamic educational institution located in Deoband, announced on Wednesday that its 'Ulemas' will not meet with leaders of political parties or click photographs with them until the Lok Sabha elections.

Ashraf Usmani, a spokesman of Darul Uloom Deoband, described the step as being taken under the direction of the institution's 'Mohtamim' (head) Abul Qasim Noman.

Usmani said that crores of people in the country follow the decisions of Deoband Darul Uloom. At the time of elections, many political leaders often turn to Darul Uloom, take photos with the

Ulemas and share them on social media to woo voters. According to him, Noman said that Darul Uloom would not support any political party during the elections because every citizen has the right to vote and every citizen should vote according to their own beliefs in the interest of the country. "Darul Uloom does not want to take any step that might influence voters of any particular religion," Noman said.

"On normal days, when leaders come to Darul Uloom, they are welcomed, but in view of the elections ahead, the Ulemas of Darul Uloom will not welcome or meet with any representative or leader of any political party," the spokesperson added.

## ED formally arrests Hurriyat leader, two others in money laundering case

SRINAGAR: The Enforcement Directorate has formally arrested three people, including a Hurriyat leader, in a money laundering case for their alleged involvement in selling MBBS seats in Pakistan and funding terror activities in Jammu and Kashmir, an official said on Wednesday.

Hurriyat leader Mohammad Akbar Bhat and Fatima Shah of Srinagar and Sabzar Ahmad Sheikh of Anantnag are already in jail after their arrest more than five years ago by the Jammu and Kashmir Police's State Investigation Agency (SIA) in a terror funding case.

Bhat, Shah and Sheikh were arrested on Tuesday under Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) provisions for their involvement in terror financing and being hand in glove with Pakistani handlers Manzoor Ahmad Shah and Altaf Ahmad Bhat, who arranged admissions in MBBS and other courses in colleges in Pakistan for students from Jammu and Kashmir, a spokesperson of the Enforcement Directorate (ED) said.

The official said the accused have been remanded to the ED's custody till February 20 by the court of Special Judge Anti-Corruption Bureau (CBI-Cases), Kashmir, Srinagar.

In May 2022, the special NIA court in Srinagar had framed charges against Bhat, who is the chairman of the Hurriyat conference 'Salvation Movement', and seven others for selling Pakistani MBBS seats to fund terror activities.

"The ED had initiated the money laundering investigation on the basis of the FIR registered by the J-K Police for offences under various sections of the Unlawful Activity (Prevention) Act (UAPA) and the Indian Penal Code (IPC) against Bhat, Shah, Sheikh, Qazi Yasir, Syed Khalid Geelani alias 'Khalid Andrabi' and others involved in terrorist activity in Jammu and Kashmir," the spokesperson said.

## BJP MLA Gaikwad, 4 others sent to judicial custody

THANE: BJP legislator Ganpat Gaikwad and four accomplices, arrested for an assassination attempt on a Shiv Sena leader within a police station, have been remanded to a 14-day judicial custody by a local court on Wednesday. Besides Gaikwad, Harshad Kene, Sandeep Sarvankar, Divyesh alias Vicky Ganatra, and driver Ranjit Yadav, were presented before the court on Wednesday at the conclusion of their police custody amidst tight security measures surrounding the court premises.

## Embassy staffer honeytrapped: ATS

MEERUT: An employee of Indian embassy in Moscow, arrested recently in Uttar Pradesh for allegedly spying for Pakistan's ISI, was honeytrapped by a woman who befriended him on social media, the UP Anti-Terrorist Squad said.

Satendra Siwal, a resident of Shahmahiuddinpur village in Hapur, shared secret documents

related to weapon systems of the Indian Air Force and Indian Navy including warplanes and submarines, said Rajeev Tyagi, ATS inspector in Meerut.

Siwal is currently in 10-day ATS remand till February 16.

"Siwal came in touch with the woman last year who had made an online profile in the name of Poo-

ja Mehra. She honeytrapped him and enticed him to share secret documents with her for money," said Tyagi.

"Siwal has claimed that the documents he shared with the woman are still in his phone.

"The forensic examination of his phone and other gadgets used by him is being done," the ATS inspector added.
