I, Mitesh Kasliwal, Practicing Company Secretary, appointed as the Scrutinizer by the board of directors of the UNIVERSAL AUTOFOUNDRY LIMITED pursuant to section 108 of the companies Act 2013 and Rule 20 of the companies (Management and Administration) Rules 2014 for the purpose of scrutinizing the remote e-voting in respect of the below stated resolution as proposed in the Notice dated March 21, 2024, and I submit my report as under.

1. Management Responsibility

The management is responsible for ensuring compliance under the provisions of Section 108 and 110 and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended (the "Act"), read together with the Rule 20 Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended (the "Management Rules"), General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April, 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 2012020 dated May 5, 2020, 2212020 dated June 15, 2020, 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020, 3912020 dated December 31, 2020, 1012021 dated June 23, 2021, 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021 and 3/2022 dated May 5, 2022 and 11/2022 dated December 28, 2022 issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India (the "MCA Circulars"), Secretarial Standards on General Meetings issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India and any other applicable law, rules and regulations (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) for the time being in force in respect of remote e-voting for the resolutions contained in the Postal Ballot dated 21st March, 2024.

2. Scrutinizer's Responsibility

My responsibility as the Scrutinizer of the voting process, is restricted to scrutinize the e-voting process, in a fair and transparent manner and to prepare a Scrutinizer's Report of the votes cast in favor and against the resolution stated in the Notice, based on the reports generated from the E-voting system provided by National Securities Depository Limited ("NSDL") the service provider.

The Company had availed the e-voting facility offered by NSDL for conducting e-voting by electronic means.

3. Cut-off Date

The shareholders of the Company holding shares as on the cut-off date of Friday, May 03, 2024, were entitled to vote on the resolution as contained in notice.

4. Postal ballot Process

In accordance with the postal ballot notice and the advertisement published pursuant to rule 22(3) of the companies (Management and administration) rules 2014, the postal ballot through e-voting commenced at Friday, May 10, 2024 [9.00 a.m. (IST)] and ended on Sunday, June 09, 2024 [5.00 p.m. (IST)] and the e-voting module was blocked by NSDL thereafter.

The Votes cast under e-voting were thereafter unblocked and downloaded on Sunday 10 June, 2024. from the portal of NSDL, and was witnessed by two witnesses, Ms. Yogita Wadhwani and Ms. Vipra Gupta, who are not in the employment of the Company and mine or the NSDL.
