● HOMESTAYS BOOMING IN TEMPLE TOWN

In Ayodhya, it's homecoming for pilgrims as well

New Delhi, January 10

JUST 800 METRES from Ram Janmabhoomi, where the Ram Temple is set to be inaugurated on January 22, is Paarijat, one amongst the about 600 homestays that have come up in Ayodhya as the temple town warms up to welcome lakhs of pilgrims.

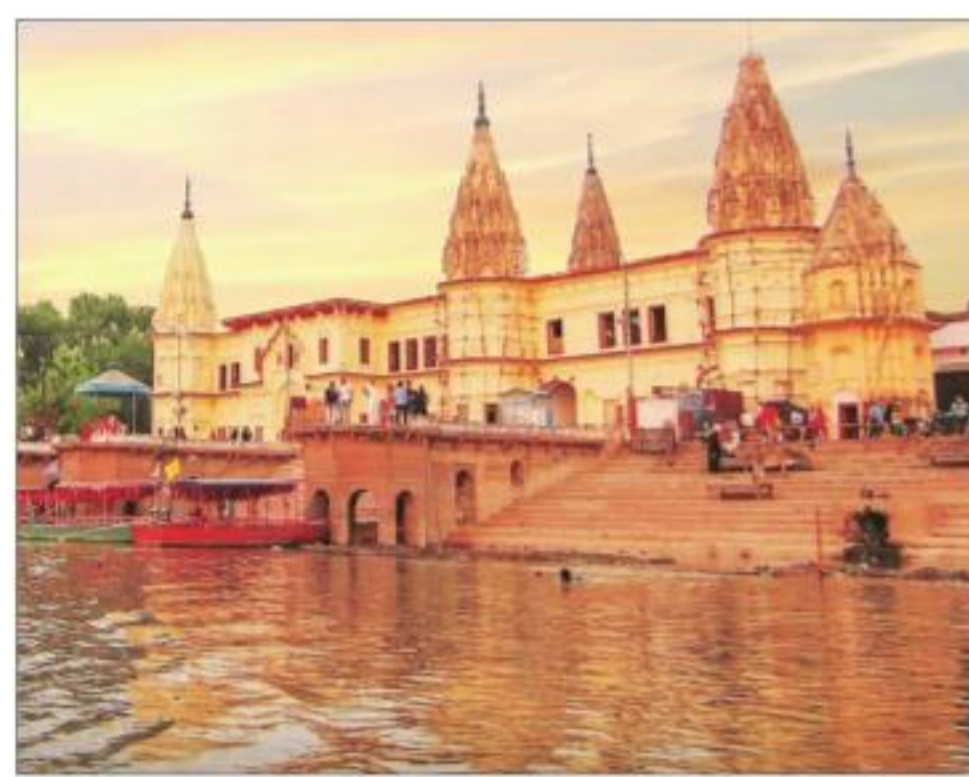
"I read in the newspaper that the local administration is inviting those with extra rooms in their houses to convert them into homestays. I liked the idea, and started Paarijat in July last year. So far I have hosted several guests, from Indians from different parts of the country to foreigners and even celebrities," said 47-year-old owner Vandana Tripathi.

Lacking enough hotels and other accommodation, it was a challenge for the local administration to figure out living arrangements for the large number of pilgrims expected during the temple inauguration.

"The hotels that are upcoming will take time to be ready. That is when we thought why not focus on homestays. The work began six months ago, and about 600 homestays have already been onboarded," said Satyendra Singh, secretary, Ayodhya Development Authority (ADA).

Homestays not only offer additional rooms, but are economically feasible too.

"Most pilgrims coming to Ayodhya belong to middle and lower middle-class strata," said Singh, highlighting that homestays are affordable for them. "Pilgrims get a home-like atmosphere,



besides a people-to-people connect, and for locals it is an economic opportunity," he said, explaining why the administration gave special focus to this model.

Earlier this month, the ADA also launched the Holy Ayodhya app to help tourists book affordable homestays, which are largely priced between ₹1,500 and ₹2,500 per night.

"Homestays are booming here. I converted the upper portion of my house into a homestay, and I earn about ₹1 lakh a month after paying commission to online booking sites and taxes," Tripathi shared.

While locals have the first-mover advantage, an increasing number of hospitality players are also looking at Ayodhya as it is poised to become a spiritual tourism spot.

"IHCL has signed management contracts for two new properties in Ayodhya — a 100-room hotel under the Vivanta brand and a 120-room Ginger hotel — which

are expected to be operational in 36 months," said Deepika Rao, executive vice-president, Indian Hotels Company Limited (IHCL), which also runs amā Stays & Trails, a premium branded homestay offering. Other hospitality chains that have signed hotels include Sarovar Hotels & Resorts and Wyndham Hotels & Resort.

Park Inn by Radisson has recently opened in the city.

While hospitality players remain bullish, the local administration is also eyeing other avenues. "We have built a Tent City here, and are also exploring newer options such as rural/village stays.

"But that would begin only after January 22," said Singh, according to whom, while hotels work well in metros and bigger cities, "here people are keener to explore something new." He added that the administration is also working on the idea of an eco-resort near Samda Lake in the city.

WHEN INDIA BROUGHT Rohit Sharma and Virat Kohli back into the fold for the Afghanistan series, there was this inevitable question as to where they would bat. With Kohli unavailable for Thursday's T20I because of personal reasons, India are set to open with Rohit and Yashasvi Jaiswal.

But going forward, India head coach hasn't ruled out the possibility of Rohit and Kohli partnering at the top, a move that totally deviates from the blueprint they have followed for the past 14 months. It also puts a question mark over the place of Yashasvi Jaiswal in the XI, who has by far been their best opening batsman in T20s.

Speaking ahead of the first T20I against Afghanistan in Mohali, Dravid revealed where India stood in terms of the openers, especially when Kohli joins the team in Indore. "Nothing is closed (Kohli opening with Rohit). We have no doubt that the kind of ability and skill sets players like Rohit and Kohli possess, they will be able to find answers against different kinds of bowling," said Dravid.

If India do put this plan to work, they will once again be without enough ammunition at the top. Sans an X-factor batsman in the top three, the batting powerplay was one of the problematic areas for India in successive T20 World Cups. It is with this aspect in mind that India, post the last T20 World Cup debacle in Australia, adopted a more aggressive, bolder approach by employing Jaiswal at the top.

It is a move that has not just worked but has also put less pressure on the middle-order. Now, if India partner Rohit and Kohli at the top, they may have to compromise on this aspect. In the coming days, India have a huge decision to make as to who among



Rohit, Kohli and Shubman Gill misses out if they are keen on playing Jaiswal.

So on Thursday, the stakes are high for Jaiswal, who will get another opportunity to remind India what he is capable of. Unlike Rohit and Gill, Jaiswal has better returns in the powerplay and is single-handedly responsible for putting the opposition under pressure from the word go in recent times. Sample these numbers: In 13 innings, Gill's strike rate in the powerplays is only 114.61. In 109 innings, Rohit's strike rate in the first six overs is 134.24, and Kohli's is 116.75.

But in 14 innings, Jaiswal has scored 292 runs in the powerplay at a strike-rate of 158.69. And India has never

lost in eight games, where he has crossed the 20-run mark. Out of those eight matches, India has scored 50 or more six times in the powerplay, with Jaiswal himself scoring a fifty once.

When a top-order batsman gives such a start in the powerplay, nearly half the battle is won with the bat, and it only allows the middle-order to play with much more freedom without worrying about run-rate. The brand of T20 cricket that the Indian team has been aspiring to master for the past couple of years comes naturally to Jaiswal who is capable of providing the knockout punch in the first six overs.

Why Jaiswal should be in the playing XI?

One significant change that came with India's aggressive approach was believed 200-plus totals should be the norm when batting first.

For such module to work, it is essential for India to bat in the top gear from first over till the last as against pressing the accelerator only in the last five overs.

The same holds true when they are chasing big totals as well. For India to go all the way in T20 World Cup, they cannot afford to have any weak links.

However, should they go in with Rohit, Gill and Kohli -- who are anchor material in T20s -- as their top three, they will be short on firepower and will be without a left-hander

How to accommodate Jaiswal at the top

at the top. Apart from making the most out of the fielding restrictions, Jaiswal has also shown he can also manipulate the field easily and find the gaps once the powerplay is over.

In the last T20I they played against South Africa, despite losing Gill and Tilak Varma cheaply, Jaiswal ensured India ended up with 62/2 in the powerplay. In the first T20I against Australia that was played just after the ODI World Cup, chasing 209, India got home with one ball to spare. Although it was Ishan Kishan, Suryakumar Yadav and then Rinku Singh in the backend who played a pivotal role in India's win, the kick-start was given by Jaiswal with his blazing 8-ball 21 at the top.

In the second match of the same series, while batting first, Jaiswal scored fifty (53 runs in 25 balls), with India scoring 77 for 1 inside the powerplay.

Since the next T20 World Cup will be played in the Caribbean and the USA, let's go back to India's tour of the West Indies in July. Playing only his second match, Jaiswal smoked an unbeaten 84 off 51 balls as India chased down the target of 179 runs in 17 overs.

In IPL 2023, Jaiswal scored 625 runs in 14 innings. It was the most by an uncapped Indian player in an IPL season, bettering Ishan Kishan's 516 runs in 2020. Jaiswal's tally is also the most for uncapped batsmen overall, as he pipped Shaun Marsh's 616 runs in the inaugural edition. During the season, he scored one century and five fifties, including one where he took only 13 balls, the fastest in the history of the IPL.

The sample of Jaiswal's batting must be significantly less when one compares it with the likes of Rohit and Kohli, but Jaiswal certainly has that impact that the Indian cricket team has been lacking at the top order since the retirement of Virender Sehwag.

Chhattisgarh govt approves free train travel scheme for Ayodhya darshan

Raipur, January 10

THE BJP GOVERNMENT in Chhattisgarh on Wednesday approved an annual free train travel scheme for people who want to take darshan of Lord Ram at Ayodhya temple.

This decision was taken at a meeting of the state Cabinet chaired by Chief Minister Vishnu Deo Sai, an official said. "Fulfilling yet another guarantee of Prime Minister Narendra Modi promised during the 2023 assembly elections," an official release said.

It said 20,000 people would be taken to Ayodhya on annual pilgrimage by train. Those in the age group of 18 years to 75 years who are medically fit would be eligible under this scheme. In the first leg, the selection of persons above 55 years of age would be done.

A committee would be set



up under the collector in each district to select pilgrims.

"The scheme would be implemented by the Chhattisgarh Tourism Board and a necessary budget would be provided by the state tourism department," the release said.

An MoU would be inked with the Indian Railways Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC) to implement the scheme and a weekly special train would be arranged.

"People can board the special train from Raipur, Durg,

Raigarh, and Ambikapur stations. The main destination of the 900-km tour would be Ayodhya," as per the release.

During the tour, pilgrims will make a night halt in Varanasi where they will be taken to Kashi Vishwanath temple and participate in the Ganga Aarti.

'Future of Indian classical music' falls silent at 55

EVERY TIME USTAD Rashid Khan sat down to perform anywhere in the world, those present had one demand — *Yaad piya ki aaye, ye dukh saha na jaaye, haaye ram* (The memories of my beloved haunt me, Alas, I cannot bear this grief) — the famed thumri by Kasur-Patiala gharana Doyen Ustad Bade Ghulam Ali Khan that remains the leitmotif to his mention.

For years, many vocalists attempted to sing the lament that was created after Bade Ghulam Ali lost his wife. But if anyone managed to enter the vicinity of the pain and yearning in that iconic rendition and then executing it with a sense of ownership, it was perhaps only Ustad Rashid Khan, the torchbearer of Rampur Sehaswan gharana.

Everytime, he sang this love song, one felt that he'd surrendered himself to the intrinsic sorrow of the piece the moment he began to unfurl it; colouring it with his own flourishes often, finding notes that one sometimes didn't think could even stick, merging gharanas and astounding people with a brilliance that is the stuff of lore. Somewhat like Pt Bhimsen Joshi, who had called him "an assurance for the future of Indian classical music", one of the only young musicians Joshi acknowledged and lauded in public.

On Tuesday afternoon, Ustad Rashid Khan, perhaps the finest Hindustani classical vocalist of our times and a compelling reminder of his brilliance and brightness of an age-old musical era lost to us, passed away in a Kolkata hospital after a prolonged battle with prostate cancer and a cerebral attack that had put him on a ventilator and oxygen support for the past couple of weeks. He was 55 and is sur-

vived by his wife Joyeeta, daughters Suha and Shaona and son Armaan.

Born in UP's Badayun, in an illustrious musical family, Rashid was the great grandson of Ustad Inayat Hussain Khan, the founder of Rampur Sehaswan gharana and a disciple of Bahadur Hussain Khan, a direct descendent of Mian Tansen. For a young Rashid, who lost his mother early, any assertion of his musical pedigree was of no interest as he was fond of cricket and kabaddi. As for music, it was all about film songs of the time, especially songs by Mohammad Rafi. His father, fearing that Rashid may not take up the art form, took the six-year-old to Ustad Nissar Hussain Khan, a guru with an iron hand and once the court musician for Maharaj Sayajirao Gaekwad III.

In 1977, when Rashid was 10, Nissar Hussain moved to

ITC Sangeet Research Academy in Kolkata on the invitation from its founder Pt Vijay Kichlu. Rashid's father sent him to Kolkata to continue his training, which Rashid did not enjoy for years, even after he made his debut at 11 and got a scholarship to join the academy when he was 14. He also learned under the tutelage of his uncle Ustad Ghulam Mustafa Khan, where he met another student, singer Hariharan, and two became close friends.

It was much later, after learning for years and when he could play around amid the musical framework that he had been taught, that Rashid began to enjoy classical music. Soon, he was opening for greats like Pt Ravi Shankar, Ustad Vilayat Khan, Ustad Ali Akbar Khan, Girija Devi and Pt Nikhil Banerjee among others at national music conferences and finding accolades as a prodigy.

From Kolkata *basti* to Dallas rugby club

"THE FIRST TIME I saw a rugby ball, as a 10-year-old, I was so excited because I thought it looked like a dinosaur's egg. I couldn't stop laughing," says Akash Balmiki.

Balmiki, a member of India's national rugby team, has just completed a magical personal arc — on Monday, the 26-year-old from a *basti* in Kolkata joined American rugby club Dallas Harlequins. Previously, players have mostly joined clubs while studying in the US.

Dallas Harlequins is a part of the organised Rugby League in the US, where the sport is big in colleges.

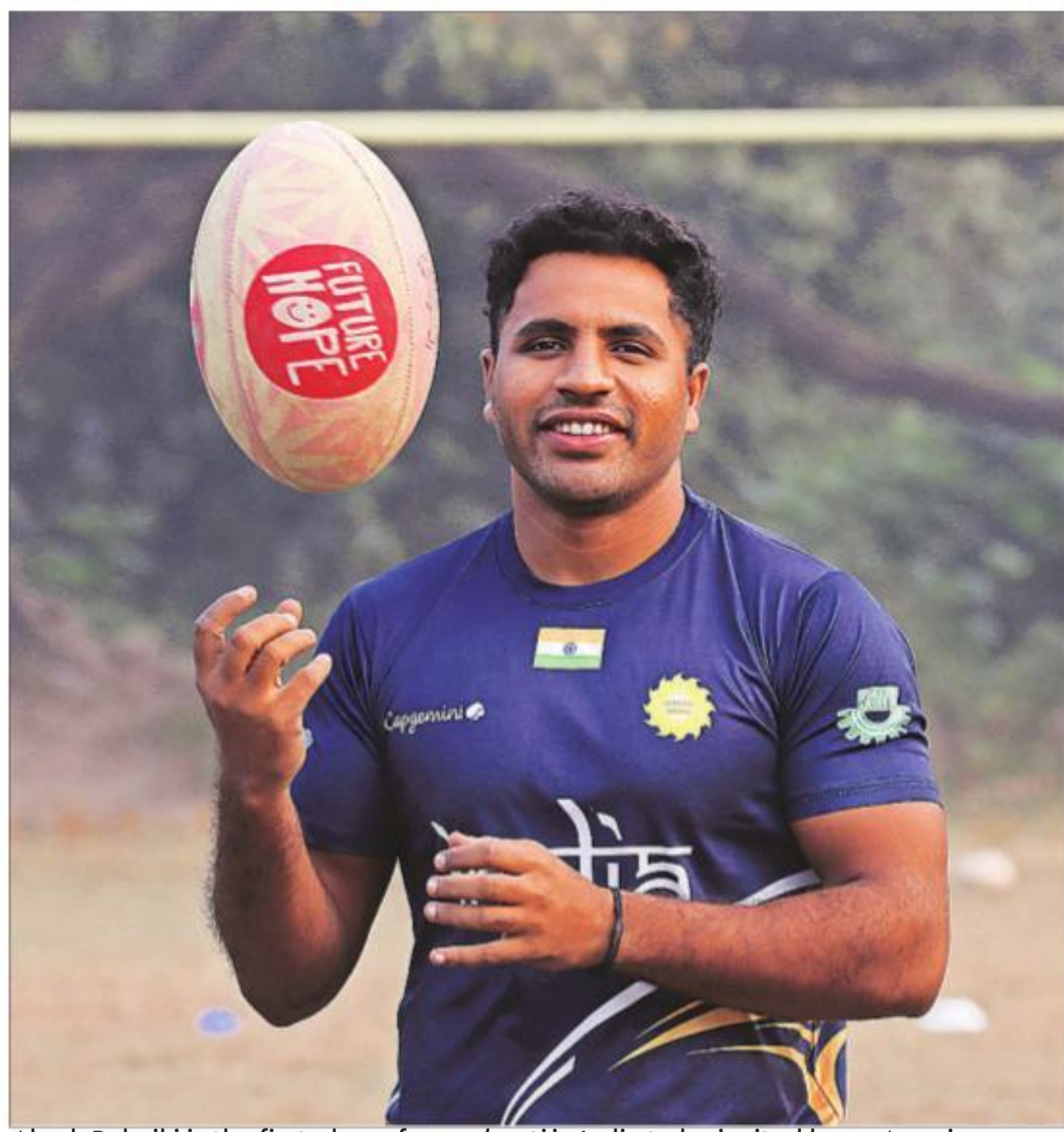
Balmiki was selected after the club watched videos of his games, where his position is as a fly-half or one of the main attacking players who links the forwards (made up of the bigger and stronger players who chase and claim the ball) and backs (the smaller and swifter players).

He will be with the club for three months.

On the first weekend of the new year, Balmiki celebrated on the dry Maidan field, under the winter sun, throwing, running and passing with boys and girls of various ages — all of them from marginalised areas of Kolkata or brought from small villages surrounding the tea gardens of Saraswatipur in north Bengal.

"It was always my dream to play in a club in another country. It will be a great exposure for me and I will bring that experience here to share with the youngsters and give them an opportunity to learn more about the game," he says.

Balmiki's success turns the floodlights on sports intervention in marginalised areas. He was born in a workers' community in Kolkata's Bhawanipur, where he still stays with his parents and

brothers. His father used to work as a sweeper and his mother is a homemaker.

"Many of the older people (from his community) were alcoholic and, when I was 10, a lot of my friends had started drinking. My mother and father were scared to send me out," he says. Balmiki had his first experience of harsh reality when a close family member turned alcoholic and plunged the house into turmoil.

Balmiki attended Hindi Vidyalaya High School but was more interested in sports than studies. In 2007, his friend came home with a rugby ball and told him about an initiative that taught rugby to underprivileged children

for free. "In a *basti*, you can run anywhere. I was lucky to have a field near my house, so I was already fit," he says.

He began to skip school to attend morning practice, and his parents didn't know this for two years.

The sessions were part of Khelo Rugby, an initiative that began with Paul Walsh, a Welshman who came to Kolkata in 2002 as the Deputy Head of Mission at the British High Commission.

"I saw some underprivileged children enthusiastically practising rugby at an NGO called Future Hope. "It really inspired me because they were from very different and difficult backgrounds, and playing rugby," he said.

In 2004, Walsh and a few of his friends founded a club in Kolkata, called Jungle Crows, to play rugby.

Over the years, he expanded the club with the

idea of "taking a rugby ball into an underserved community", a commitment that saw him taking a sabbatical from his job.

He hasn't gone back to being a diplomat. Walsh spends his time with rugby and communities, getting children admitted to schools, paying their tuition fees, listening to them and encouraging them to play sports, besides raising funds.

At present, Khelo Rugby works with 30 communities. "The magic of the rugby ball then takes over, with children mesmerised by the odd shape and funny bounce.

"With a commitment of regular fun rugby sessions we begin to build the trust of the children and their communities. Then we can begin to explore other areas, led by the children when our coaches discuss their lives and ambitions," says Walsh.

Khelo Rugby children are coached by seniors such as Balmiki, who have honed their skills at its camps. Balmiki's family still eats meat only twice a week and he invests his earnings in buying bananas and other fruit. "I try to stay in good shape," he says. He is good at kicking and passing, and has worked on "being mentally tough" and confident.

"I have become better at not overthinking," he says.

At 19, he played the first tournament for India against Pakistan at the junior level. The team beat Afghanistan, then Iran and lost by a small margin to Pakistan in 2013.

"After a year, I played at a senior level and, again, we went to Pakistan, and this time we beat the country to win," he says.

"A greater victory was that a lot of children in my community are interested in rugby. I also don't see so many people drinking. It makes me happy to see the young players, it is like I see myself," he says.
