BMC unveils rabies vax campaign

The BMC will initiate a mass rabies vaccination campaign across the city starting September 28. The initiative forms a part of the broader National Action Plan for Rabies Elimination, which targets making India rabies-free by 2030.

The campaign, which is part of the Mumbai Rabies Eradication Project, initially launched in 2022, is being conducted in association with 'Worldwide Veterinary Services-Mission Rabies'. The focus of the drive is not only on vaccinating stray dogs but also on raising public awareness about rabies and animal welfare.

In tandem with the vaccination drive, the BMC has been conducting a series of awareness programmes targeting schools, colleges, cooperative housing societies and other public institutions.

DOUBLE WHAMMY | Advocate hired to fight case cheats client

Lawyer booked for ₹2.3cr fraud, fake court order

Azad Maidan police recently filed an FIR against a lawyer for cheating and forgery. Vinay Kumar Khattu allegedly provided the complainant, 74-year-old Urmila Talyarkhan, with a fake Bombay High Court order bearing the names of Judge Sandeep K Shinde and Judge Madhav J Jamdar, and defrauded her of Rs2.3 crore.

According to the FIR, Talyarkhan, a Delhi-based businesswoman, purchased an acre (42.3 gunthas) of land in Alibaug from one Kailas Agarwal in 1998 for Rs20 lakh. In 2003, Tukaram Patil, descendant of the land's original owner, Draupati Patil, filed a petition in the District and Sessions Court of Raigad,

claiming that the deal between Draupati Patil and Agarwal was illegal. As the names of Patil family members appeared in the land records, the local court gave a verdict in favour of Patil in 2012.

Talyarkhan appealed against the verdict in the Raigad court. However, her lawyer failed to appear for the hearings, and the case was removed from the hearing list in 2018. Talyarkhan remained unaware of the situation until 2022.

The businesswoman then decided to approach the Bombay High Court. She contacted Khattu and entrusted him with the Alibaug case, along with five other property and cheating cases. Khattu agreed to take on the cases. Talyarkhan transferred Rs2.3 crore from her friend's Indian

Overseas Bank account to various accounts provided by Khattu.

In 2022, Talyarkhan filed a petition in the Bombay High Court challenging the Raigad Sessions Court's verdict through lawyer Khattu. A few months later, Khattu informed her that the High Court had ruled in her favor and requested an additional Rs.30 lakhs for the order copy. She transferred the amount, and Khattu provided her with what he claimed was the High

Court order copy. Khattu further mentioned that Judge Jamdar had delivered the verdict in her favor and handed her the corresponding order documents.

In April 2024, when Talyarkhan consulted another lawyer for advice, she showed him the order documents. The lawyer informed her that the documents were fake. Talyarkhan discovered that the fake order copies bore the names of Judge Sandeep K Shinde and Judge Madhav J Jamdar. She also checked the HC website, which revealed that her case was still pending.

Talyarkhan filed a complaint against Khattu with the Azad Maidan police, leading them to lodge a case under various sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Now, scammers come home to cheat victims

Until now, scammers had been operating from behind the scenes in order to dupe people, but in a recent case, the scammer posing as a bank official not only visited the victim's residence, but also convinced him to hand over his credit card and then carried out fraudulent transactions.

A 35-year-old businessman fell prey to scammers who first contacted him on the pretext of getting his credit card facilities upgraded. A fraudster visited the victim's residence to initiate the process and managed to get details of his old credit card, which was later used to carry out transactions.

According to the police, the victim hails from Jalna and is a businessman. A year ago, he received an SBI credit card in an offer. Since last fortnight, the victim had been receiving

phone calls from a woman claiming to be from SBI Mumbai office. The woman told the victim that he could get his credit limit doubled and annual fee waived.

On August 17, around 10am, the victim again received a call from the same woman who told him that she would be sending a bank executive to his place. The executive would make him fill a form, after which the old card would become non-operational and a new card would be issued.

After some time an unknown woman visited the victim's residence and told him that she was sent by the

bank. She took out the form and filled the victim's Aadhaar card and PAN card details in it. After that she took the victim's mobile phone and after handling the phone for a while she told the victim that his old card had been closed and that the new card would be delivered by courier in two to three days. She then left with the old credit card.

The next day the victim received messages on his phone informing that Rs1 lakh had been spent using the old card. The victim contacted the bank, informed them about the fraudulent transactions and told them to block the card.

A case has been registered under sections 318 (cheating) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and sections 66C (identity theft), 66D (cheating by personation by using computer resource) of the Information Technology Act in the matter.

Boy revives garden to mark 16th b'day

A 16-year-old has transformed a neglected half-acre garden in Malad into a flourishing green space by cleaning the plastic and planting saplings. Zidaan Castellino, who took the initiative as part of his birthday celebration, was helped by more than 200 volunteers from various organisations and the area's housing federation. Volunteers, aged between two and 80 years, toiled to clear mud and all the plastic waste from the garden.

The teenage environmentalist has planted around 5,000 trees in the Past two



years apart from reviving another green space earlier in Malad. Castellino, who is known for such urban plantation efforts, also holds the

distinction of being the youngest person to suggest changes in the BMC's open space policy.

To celebrate his 16th birth-

day, he decided to infuse life into a public garden and a traffic island near the Ganesh temple in Jankalyan Nagar. The area had turned into a waste dumping site due to negligence. On August 24, Castellino was joined by around 220 people, who planted saplings and shrubs at the neglected spot. Green Nagar Project, Jankalyan Nagar Housing Federation, WeNaturalists, TCET Green Club and Eco Cell Orlem extended a helping hand.

"Apart from being an environmentalist, I have a personal connection with this garden as I was born and brought up in this locality. When I was a kid, my

mother would read in this garden and locals came for a stroll. However, plastic waste and wild grass encroached upon the plot due to neglect spanning years," said Castellino.

He recalled how several initiatives launched in the past to revive the garden failed. This inspired him to accomplish the feat on his birthday. "We have been living in a concrete jungle and I strongly feel that suburban Mumbai lacks an eco-conscious mindset. Seeing such a beautiful park being neglected, I thought Jankalyan Nagar needed a green change and that is the reason I decided to take up the cause," said Castellino.

Fake salesman from Jindal cheats Birla Group company

The Chief Executive of Zenith Dye Intermediates Ltd (Birla Group), Manish Malani, has filed an FIR at Marine Drive police station against an unknown person who posed as a salesperson from Jindal Steel and Power Ltd and defrauded him of Rs9.11 lakh.

According to the FIR, the expansion of Birla Public Hospital in Rajasthan required steel for construction. Junior Assistant Pradeep Garva, in search of suppliers, found a company named TMT Sariya Supplier online and contacted it. A person named 'Sharma', claiming to be a

salesperson from Jindal Steel and Power Ltd, responded.

On August 22, Garva placed an order for six tonnes of steel, worth Rs 3.33 lakh and Sharma issued an invoice in the name of Jindal Steel and Power and instructed Garva to transfer the payment to Punjab National Bank, Raipur Branch.

Later, after the payment was made, Sharma contacted Garva and claimed that the company would only accept an order for 15 tonnes of steel. In response to this emergency request, Garva placed an order for 15 tonnes and transferred another Rs5.78 lakh to the same account.

When Garva requested

delivery of the steel, Sharma demanded an additional Rs2.51 lakh for vendor registration. Finding this suspicious, Garva asked to cancel the order and requested a refund. Additionally, when an employee checked the account details at Punjab National Bank, it was found to be in the name of one Sam Shaw, which led them to realise they had been duped.

A police official said: "This is cyber fraud, where an unknown person posed as a fake employee of Jindal Steel and Power Ltd. We have registered an FIR in this case."

The case has been registered under Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and IT Act 2000.
