LIC Housing sees 34% jump in net profits

Chennai, Aug 27: Mortgage lender LIC Housing Finance Ltd (LICHFL) on Monday reported a 34 per cent jump in its net profit to Rs 817.48 crore for the quarter ending June helped by lower provisioning.

The company's profit after tax stood at Rs 610.68 crore in the April-June quarter of the previous fiscal. "The rise in profit is mainly attributed to provisioning which was lower in the quarter as compared to the last time (Q1 FY20). However, we have fully provided for whatever is required," the company's managing director and CEO Siddhartha Mohanty said.

under moratorium as of June 30, 2020. Individual home loans under moratorium accounted for 16 per cent of the home loan portfolio. Nearly 77 per cent of its developer loan book is under moratorium as of June 30, 2020.

The stage 3 exposure at default as on June 30, 2020 stood at 2.83 per

cent as against 1.98 per cent as on June 30, 2019. The provisions for Expected Credit Loss (ECL) as a percentage of stage 3 exposure at default stood at 45.32 per cent as of June-end.

Total disbursements were Rs 3,560 crore in the first quarter as against Rs 10,261 crore for the corresponding period in FY2020. Out of this, disbursement in individual home loan segment was Rs 3,034 crore as against Rs 7,871 crore whereas project loans were Rs 159 crore compared with Rs 829 crore.

The total loan portfolio grew 6 per cent to Rs 2,09,817 crore as against Rs 1,97,768 crore.

Mobile banking most-preferred banking channel: SBI chairman

Chennai, Aug 27: Mobile banking may become the most-preferred banking channel, super-seeding Internet banking, in the days to come, SBI Chairman Rajnish Kumar said.

"Out of 100 transactions at SBI, only nine transactions are being made at branches. While transactions at ATMs at the time of demonetisation stood at about 55%, these are down to about 30% now. Mobile banking has risen to 55% now," Mr. Kumar said, addressing the seventh G. Ramachandran Memorial Lecture organised by the Southern India Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

According to him, transactions via digital banking had risen due to the lockdown. "During the pandemic, SBI delivered all its services without any interruption. Mobile transactions were almost

on a par with Internet banking," he said. "COVID has brought in a new paradigm. Earlier, SEBI was pushing everyone to go digital. But, now it has become easier. Mobile banking is going to be the future as it has huge potential," he said.

Padmaja Chundur, MD & CEO, Indian Bank MD & CEO, Padmaja Chundur, MD & CEO said over the next few quarters, the banking sector would face a misalignment between short-term costs and revenues due to the economic impact of COVID-19.

She also said that banks needed to review and prioritise current projects to ensure allocation of resources to the most pressing needs. Banks should also focus on investing in areas that will outlive the

pandemic. "These new digital tools will make banks more efficient and resilient to future changes. This will insure banks against such unprecedented lockdowns and perhaps better manage cost overheads," she said. In conclusion, she said
