22 Member Football Squads for Olympics

Olympic soccer rosters will be expanded from 18 players to 22 for the Tokyo Olympics, a person with knowledge of the change told the Associated Press on Wednesday. Teams can include 22 players on squads, but must stay with 18 on team sheets for individual matches, said the person, who spoke on the condition of anonymity because the change had not been formally announced by the International Olympic Committee. The change was considered because of the challenges teams face as a result of the pandemic.

Semenya Fails to Qualify for Olympic in 5K

Caster Semenya failed in her bid to achieve the qualifying time for the 5,000 meters at the Tokyo Olympics during a meet in Belgium. Semenya was taking part in a race at Leuven, which was held after an Olympic qualifying deadline of June 29 had already expired. The South African athlete finished in fourth place with a time of 15 minutes, 50.12 seconds. Meeting organizers said, falling short of her target of 15:10.00 on Wednesday, the two-time Olympic champion has been barred from defending her 800-meter title and from running in events from 400 meters to one mile at top track meets under World Athletics' testosterone rules.

Langer has Addressed Coaching Concerns

Justin Langer has addressed players' concerns about his coaching style ahead of his full backing of the Australia team, international captain Aaron Finch said on Thursday. Reports of dressing-room unrest surfaced after Australia were beaten 2-1 at home by an injury-ravaged India in January. The players took part in an end-of-season review with leadership consultant Tim Ford and Finch said Langer had cleared the air before flying with the team to West Indies.

Djokovic and Federer in Olympic List

World number one Novak Djokovic and 20-time Grand Slam champion Roger Federer were both named on the list of players for the Tokyo Olympics on Thursday — a boost for a tournament hit by high-profile withdrawals. Women's world number one Ash Barty and Japan's Naomi Osaka head the field in the women's singles. A first-time Olympic singles winner is assured in the women's singles with Puerto Rico's defending champion Monica Puig unable to compete because of injury.

Calling the Shots from Midfield

Pedri indispensable as Spain bid to beat Switzerland and make it to the semi-finals

Spain is on the charge at a major football tournament with a creative and technically gifted Barcelona player calling the shots from central midfield. Only 20, Pedri already seems indispensable for the national team. He's been given the keys to a midfield that was once the domain of two modern-day greats in Xavi Hernandez and Andres Iniesta.



The comparisons are inevitable — and may be justified — and will only become more widespread if Pedri leads Spain to the European Championship title in the coming days, just as Xavi and Iniesta did in 2008 and 2012 amid a golden era for the country.

Certainly Switzerland needs to be on top of Spain's new midfield evolution in the first quarter-final match at Euro 2020 in St. Petersburg on Friday.

That's easier said than done. Pedri, who plays on the left side of Spain's ball-hogging central midfield three, is playing in his first major tournament. He only made his senior international debut in March — and is tied for first place with most chances created (10) and has more passes in the opposition half (222) than any other player.

The youngest Spaniard to play at a European Championship, Pedri also became the youngest player in a knockout stage game in the tournament — at 18 years, 203 days — against Croatia in the round of 16.

Perhaps most impressively, he is one of only two outfield players in Spain's squad to have played every minute of their team's games at Euro 2020. "Pedri is a unique player," Spain coach Luis Enrique said last week.

Another European Championship record he holds comes with less distinction. After 20 minutes of the 5-3 extra-time win over Croatia, Pedri sent a back pass from the halfway line to Spain goalkeeper Unai Simon, who failed to control

the ball and only succeeded in deflecting it into the goal. It is the longest ever goal in the tournament's history. Yet Pedri shrugged off that misfortune to produce a dominant performance against a highly regarded Croatia midfield led by veteran Luka Modric.

Pedri's technique, vision and ability to maneuver himself into space and find teammates with his acute passing is astonishing given his age. He is coming off his first year at Barcelona, which he joined from Las Palmas in the offseason, and he has already played six games for his club and his country this season.

He has also been picked to play for Spain at the football tournament at the Tokyo Olympics.

White-Collar Job Scene Sees Big Recovery in June

Mumbai: June saw encouraging signs for job seekers as India's white-collar market registered a recovery with 370,000 active vacancies after a slump during the second wave of the Covid pandemic.

resumption of commercial activities boosted hiring by 92% in June from the previous month as the white-collar market added over 65,000 new jobs in 30 days, according to data from official company job pages on LinkedIn and direct postings on top job boards put together by staffing firm Xpheno. The job vacancy numbers for June, which emerged the strongest month for the year, is more than twice that of a year ago.

Economists and job experts said that the numbers are indicative of a revival in sentiment in white-collar employment as the count of Covid infections has receded, vaccinations have picked up pace and consumer demand has gone back up. "The speed and scale of recovery shows enterprise confidence and an overall positivity in the job market," said Xpheno cofounder Kamal Karanth. "June 2021 could well be the

starting point of a buoyancy expected for the rest of the year." The top five metros—Bangalore, Mumbai, Delhi, Chennai, Hyderabad—posted the highest-ever job count since the onset of the pandemic, with 125,000 openings in June. "The white-collar market is more positive now than it was last year, and things appear to be on a path to normal," said Care Ratings chief economist Madan Sabarwal.

Overseas Crypto Platforms with Indian Buyers to Face 18% GST

The platforms would have to register under Indian GST law and pay necessary tax

Mumbai: Cryptocurrency exchanges that are based outside India but have Indian customers are set to face additional taxes in the form of goods and services tax (GST). The indirect tax department has initiated an inquiry into these exchanges and whether they are required to pay GST in India when they provide certain "data" services that fall under the definition of Indian law, said people aware of the development.

GST regulations provide for tax on almost every transaction where goods and services are consumed by Indians. The taxpayer would categorise the services provided by these exchanges—allowing Indians to trade on their platform—as an Online Information Database Access and Retrieval services, or OIDAR services, say tax experts.

"The overseas crypto platforms with Indian buyers and sellers would be having a significant exposure towards GST under OIAR provisions. As these users of such platforms are mostly individuals who would be unregistered under GST under OIAR provisions, the platform would have to take registration under the Indian GST law and initiate an inquiry into these exchanges and whether they are required to pay GST in India when they provide certain 'data' services that fall under the definition of Indian law, said people aware of the development.
