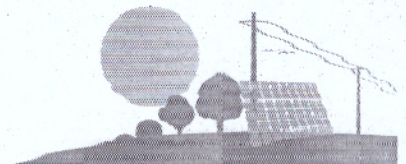

Scheduled international passenger services have been suspended in India since March 23, 2020, due to the coronavirus pandemic.
