Retail business likely to be RIL's next growth engine

Mumbai, Oil-to-telecom giant Reliance Industries (RIL) which has largely seen its growth coming on the back of its petrochemical business over the past decades, is set to see a shift in the anchor's role with the retail business, including its e-commerce operations, to drive the company's growth.

A Goldman Sachs report noted that after growing 5x over FY16-FY20, RIL's core retail revenue growth has taken a pause in FY21 due to Covid related macro headwinds.

"However, we believe retail business (including e-commerce) is set to be the next growth engine for RIL, with potential for retail EBITDA to grow 10x over the next 10 years," it said.

During the macro downturn, RIL has focused on building strong digital capa-

growth and market share wins."

Reliance's Retail business had showcased significant pre-Covid growth, with core retail revenues growing 5x during FY16-FY20 at a 50 per cent CAGR.

While growth has taken a pause in FY21 due to Covid related lower footfalls causing a downturn in the retail industry, RIL's retail business has focused on building strong digital capabilities while continuing to expand its physical reach. It expects significant market share, alongside the post covid macro reset, to drive significant growth for RIL retail.

"We expect RIL core retail revenue to grow at a 36 per cent CAGR over the next four years to \$44 bn and e-commerce revenues to be 35 per cent of total retail revenues in FY25, at \$15 bn," it said.

"We value RIL retail business at \$88 bn in our base case with our offline business valuation similar to comps and online business valuation at the high end of the peer group given higher GMV growth. We also highlight our bull case valuation of \$120 bn based on stronger than expected macro

countries such as Myanmar and Sri Lanka," Bajaj added.

After Nepal, the plan is that Indian power exchanges start hosting buyers and sellers from countries such as Bhutan and Bangladesh. This could be followed up by bringing participants from Myanmar and Sri Lanka.

Such participation from overseas entities on Indian exchanges would not be direct but through any electricity trading licensee of India.

Sharp rise in realisation inflates steel earnings

New Delhi, For steel companies, Q1FY22 is expected to be sequentially better as higher steel prices (by Rs 4,500-8,000/t qoq) will offset lower volumes (down 7-17 per cent) due to localised lockdown amid second wave of Covid and higher raw material cost (iron ore cost to increase by Rs 1,500/t qoq).

A report by Centrum Broking said as a result, we expect EBITDA/t to be higher by Rs 3,200-5,400/t qoq with Tata and SAIL gaining the most while JSPL to be at bottom. Similarly, higher average aluminium (up 15 per cent qoq) and zinc prices (up 7 per cent qoq) is expected to improve Q1FY22 earnings sequentially for Hindalco, Hindustan Zinc and Vedanta. During Q4FY21, domestic steel producers reported robust operating performance (EBITDA rose by Rs 10-24 billion, average 31 per cent up qoq) aided by sharp increase in steel prices offsetting higher iron ore prices. The average increase in realisation was better than estimated at Rs 7,900-10,000/t qoq except for SAIL where price increase was lower at Rs 3,900/t qoq which in turn was due to lower exports and adverse product mix. The steel volumes remained nearly flat (-0.9 per cent to +5 per cent) qoq as domestic demand was subdued in Jan-Feb'21 before recovering in March 2021.

Franklin Templeton returns Rs 17,777 cr to unit holders of 6 shut schemes

Mumbai, Franklin Templeton Mutual Fund has said that the six shut debt schemes have returned Rs 17,777.59 crore to unit holders amounting to 71 per cent of the assets under management (AUM) as on April 23, 2020.

In a statement, the fund house said that the cash available for distribution stands at Rs 580 crore as on June 15, 2021.

The Trustee of Franklin Templeton decided to wind up six of our debt schemes in April 2020. The difficult decision was taken because the markets had become illiquid due to the severe impact of Covid-19. The sole objective of this decision was to safeguard value for our investors, the company said.

The six schemes under winding up include Franklin India Ultra Short Bond Fund, Franklin India Low Duration Fund, Short Term Income Plan, Income Opportunities Fund, Credit Risk Fund and Dynamic Accrual Fund. During the week starting June 7, the unit holders of the six shut schemes of the Franklin Templeton Mutual Fund will get Rs 3,205.25 crore.

Karnataka HC judgement seems to have missed an opportunity

New Delhi, The Karnataka High Court judgement seems to have missed established legal principles laid down by the Supreme in an opportunity to settle and explicate the law in cases involving parallel investigations or similar issues, and its handling of these issues may have left the door open to protracted litigation, S&R Associates, said in a note.

The Karnataka High Court has, on June 11, 2021, dismissed the writ petitions filed by Amazon Seller Services Private Limited and Flipkart Internet Private Limited challenging well-established legal principles laid down by the Supreme the Competition Commission of India's (CCI) order issued under Section 26(1) of the Competition Act, 2002 (the "Competition Act") on January 13, 2020, directing the Director General to investigate certain alleged anti-competitive practices.

"While the Karnataka High Court's judgment appears to follow well-established legal principles laid down by the Supreme Court of India, a closer examination reveals that the judgment gives only a cursory consideration to some of the key arguments raised by Amazon and Flipkart (together, the "E-Commerce Platforms"). It said the CCI Order seems to represent a shift in the approach from that adopted in the CCI's AIOVA Order.

Yogi assures Samsung of all help in UP

Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath has assured a Samsung delegation all help in carrying out business activities in the state.

A delegatierged as the biggest mobile manufacturing and exporon of Samsung led by CEO Ken Kang (India and South-West Asia) met the Chief Minister on Sunday evening and apprised him of the company's business activities in the state.

Yogi Adityanath said investors and companies of the country and from abroad were enthusiastic about setting up industries in the state.

An official release by the state government said, "The delegation told Yogi Adityanath that its Noida-based unit had emerged as the biggest mobile manufacturing and exporting unit in the country due to the Centre's production-linked incentive policy."

It may be perged as the biggest mobile manufacturing and exporinted out that Samsung has relocated its display manufacturing unit from China to India after the Covid-19 pandemic. The unit has been relocated to Noida. The Samsung delegation appreciated the state government's decision to allow business activity even during the corona curfew period.

The delegates also appreciated the state government's efforts to fight the second wave of the pandemic.

Samsung had donated one million US dollars to the state government during the pandemic along with oxygen concentrators, oxygen cylinders and syringes.

Zupee steps up to improve employability skills

Overseas participants on Indian power exchanges to rise soon

New Delhi, Indian power exchanges may soon host a larger number of buyers and sellers from neighbouring countries with the operationalisation of cross-border sale and purchase of electricity for which regulations have already been issued by the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (CERC) and Central Electricity Authority (CEA) has notified the procedures.

At present, the country's largest power exchange Indian Energy Exchange (IEX) has begun trading of electricity hosting participants from Nepal on its platform.

IEX head of business development, Rohit Bajaj told IANS that potential for cross border power trading was immense and soon its platform could host participants from Bangladesh and Bhutan with whom India already has a power transmission line. "We started this

market on April 17 and already we have traded 150 million units electricity. The potential is good for buy deals from electricity deficient countries such as Nepal and Bangladesh while sell options could come from Bhutan. We expect more overseas participants to join the exchange platform for trading given the competitive price discovery that it allows."

"This is one step forward towards the development of regional markets. With better connectivity in coming years, the cross border trading could also include
