Home Minister asks police leadership to ensure timely justice, constitutional rights of citizens

NEW DELHI, AUG 26 /-/- Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Friday urged the police leadership to provide timely justice to citizens and ensure a system that would guarantee the constitutional rights of the people.



Addressing the concluding session of the National Security Strategies Conference here, Shah also asked police to work for a criminal justice system based on new technologies like Artificial Intelligence (AI) and the use of forensic science among others. The home minister urged the top police leadership to transform their approach to dealing with the country's internal security problems, according to an official

statement. Shah laid emphasis on the use of modern technology in policing and suggested the implementation from lower police ranks of constabulary to the higher formations. Quoting the recently

introduced bills in Parliament to replace the IPC, CrPC and Indian Evidence Act, Shah laid down a vision for revamping the entire criminal justice system.

The Union minister told the police officers that when the new laws are passed by Parliament, they should be ready to implement these at the grassroots level to revamp the criminal justice system. Shah underscored the significance of the use of digital technology in the entire process of investigation and prosecution. He advocated for new initiatives for ushering in technology-led policing to meet the future demands of a revamped

criminal justice system. The Home Minister flagged the emergence of technological advancement in Artificial Intelligence and termed it as a threat as much as an opportunity. He urged police to learn to use AI to its advantage while preparing to deal with its adverse effects.

Shah exhorted the participants to work hard in the next 25 years to achieve the vision of Prime Minister Narendra Modi to make India a leading nation by 2047. While suggesting the importance of learning from other countries, he impressed upon the participants to set an example in the next 25 years so that people from other countries learn from the Indian example. BSF's efforts in Sairang rescue operation



AIZAWL, AUG 26 /-/- As many as 22 workers died and three sustained serious injuries in the morning of August 23 as an under construction railway bridge collapsed near Sairang, in Aizawl. On getting information, rescue team of 38 Battalion, Border Security Force (BSF), Sakawrtiuhun (Aizawl)

reacted promptly and reached the spot with a medical team and tracker dogs to exhibit example of humanity and extended helping hands for rescue operation to NDRF, State Administration and Police to evacuate and to find dead bodies in debris. 38 Battalion of the BSF provided their vehicle and

nursing staffs for evacuation and retrieval of dead bodies from the spot/ debris. Tracker dogs of BSF also searched and located dead bodies buried under debris. 18 dead bodies were recovered and three injured workers were admitted in Civil Hospital, Aizawl. With the co-ordination of civil administration, BSF troops

and canine conducted second day rescue and evacuation operation for searching and retrieval of remaining dead bodies.

The BSF is dedicated to the security of borders of the country as well as to extend helping hands to the citizens of India as its guiding principle and ethos. (DIPR)

Surat resident claims he was 'designer' of Chandrayaan-3's lander, police launch probe

SURAT, AUG 26 /-/- Surat Police in Gujarat are probing a city resident's claims that he was a scientist working with the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) and designed the lander module of the Chandrayaan-3 moon mission, an official has said. City Police Commissioner Ajay Tomar has directed the crime branch to conduct investigation to verify the claims which were prima facie false, Deputy Commissioner of Police (special branch) Hetal Patel said on Friday.

Mitul Trivedi, who has been giving interviews to the local media since the Vikram lander successfully landed on the moon on Thursday, failed to produce any documentary proof to support his claim of being an ISRO scientist, said DCP Patel. Trivedi, who claims

to hold a Ph.D, on Thursday told several media outlets and news channels that he had designed the lander of Chandrayaan-3. As he was part of the Chandrayaan-2 project, ISRO invited him to work on the latest moon mission too, and he made several changes in the original design of the lander which was the reason it landed successfully, he claimed.

But some local newspapers published reports questioning the veracity of his claims on Friday. He was asked to visit her office on Friday with documents to prove his claims, she said. "But he did not produce any document or proof to

establish that he is associated with ISRO. Our probe found that he is a B.Com. degree holder. When asked about his claims of being a scientist, he said he was a freelancer who had worked on Chandrayaan-3's design at ISRO's Bengaluru office. He even claims to be working

with NASA," said the official. "As per our preliminary probe, he is not an ISRO scientist. Further probe will be carried out by the crime branch and a First Information Report will be registered against him if he is found to be lying," she added. (PTI)

Cultural heritage both pillar of past and pathway to future: Reddy at G20 ministerial meeting

VARANASI, AUG 26 /-/- Each of the four priorities for culture, articulated under India's G20 presidency, are a "piece of a larger puzzle" that forms a picture in which cultural heritage is both a pillar of the past and a pathway to the future, Union Minister G Kishan Reddy said on Saturday.

Addressing ministers and other delegates at the G20 Culture Ministers' Meeting in Varanasi, he also said that the discussions and deliberations that have taken place as a part of the Culture Working Group meeting and the Global Thematic Webinars have been "remarkable and inspiring". The Culture Ministers' Meeting aims to catalyse collective actions for accelerating progress on the four priority areas for culture. These are protection and restitution of cultural property, harnessing living heritage for a sustainable future, promotion of cultural and creative industries and creative economy, and leveraging digital technologies for the protection and promotion of culture. "Each of these priorities are a piece of a larger puzzle, one that forms a picture where cultural heritage is both a pillar of the past and a pathway to the future," Reddy said in his address. The Union minister holds the portfolios of Culture, Tourism and Development of the North-East Region (DoNER). "We've progressed from identifying and deliberating the four priorities to advance towards the action-oriented outcomes that would be a significant step in placing culture at the heart of global policymaking," he said. The meeting comes ahead of the G20 Summit, scheduled to be held on September 9 and 10 in Delhi. The Culture Working Group's (CWG) first meeting was held in Khajuraho in Madhya Pradesh, followed by two more in Odisha's Bhubaneswar and Hampi in Karnataka. The fourth and the last meeting of the CWG was held from August 24-25, which culminated with the ministerial meeting here on Saturday. "I am filled with immense pride as I address the Culture Ministers' Meeting under India's G20 presidency here in this beautiful city of Varanasi. As one of the world's oldest continuously living cities, Varanasi stands as a testament to India's rich cultural heritage," the Union Culture Minister said.

Varanasi is a symbol of India's rich cultural heritage, dating back to several thousands of years, he said and welcomed delegates. "As the eternal city by the Ganges, Varanasi captures the confluence of culture, arts, and traditions, making it a fitting backdrop for this meeting," Reddy said. The Union minister said in a world rich with diversity, "our shared cultural heritage is the thread that binds us all" and "allows us to acknowledge and respect our differences, while celebrating humanity". Reddy said culture is much more than a geographic or social differentiator. "It is the unique and vibrant expression of our experiences, comprising the customs, values, languages, and arts that define us," he said. This journey of the G20 Culture Working Group has been "inclusive and collaborative" and has brought "us to this pivotal moment in our timeline the Culture Ministers' Meeting", Reddy said. In 2020, under Saudi Arabia's presidency, the G20 recognised culture's integral role, especially when the Covid pandemic revealed the sector's weakness. The following year, Italy championed the cause, leading to the historic 'Rome Declaration' at the inaugural G20 Culture Ministers' Meeting, the Union minister said.

Emphasising culture's crucial role in sustainable development and climate change solutions, Indonesia took this agenda forward in 2022 with the 'Bali Leaders Declaration', which "reaffirmed the significance of culture as an enabler and driver of sustainable development", he said. "Today, we commit to nurturing and expanding this vision, recognising the transformative power of culture," Reddy emphasised and praised the "invaluable contributions" made by G20 members. The Union minister said the useful insights, comments, and feedback offered by members have greatly enriched the shared dialogue.

In drafting the Culture Minister's Declaration, the CWG carefully considered the "insights and feedback from members, building on what we achieved in the Rome and Bali Declarations," he added. Under India's presidency, "we have tried to capture not just the letter but, most importantly, the spirit of our collective vision," the minister asserted. (PTI)
