

### The Forks

The Forks, located at the junction of the Red and Assiniboine Rivers near Winnipeg's downtown core, is the place to be in summer and equally fun in winter. The Forks Market and the Johnston Terminal Building are restored historical buildings housing a lovely market area with interesting shops, restaurants, and casual food stalls. Some restaurants feature outdoor patios overlooking the Riverwalk that runs along the river. In winter, the outdoor skating rink is particularly popular with families.

### Tinkertown Family Fun Park


Tinkertown Family Fun Park is an amusement and fun park owned by a family situated on Murdock Road, Springfield, Manitoba. It is a place of great fun and pleasure for the kids and families in the summer. The park includes 20 fun rides and various amazing attractions to please the visitors. Adults can enjoy while playing 18 hole mini-golf in the park. After enjoying the whole summer day with different rides and attractions, visitors can cool themselves in water wars.

### Grand Beach

Grand Beach is one of the best beaches in North America, which is situated on the eastern coast of Winnipeg Lake besides historical Verendrye trail. Its smooth white sand and grass dunes with good sunlight in summer that attracts thousands of tourists from all over the world. ### Polar Bears of Churchill

Churchill, popularly known as the "Polar Bear Capital of the World," lies on the harsh, rocky coast of Hudson Bay. Tours in tundra buggies - giant large-wheeled vehicles with caged windows - allow visitors close up encounters with the bears.



### Whiteshell Provincial Park

About a 1.5-hour drive east of Winnipeg is the Whiteshell Provincial Park, a popular summer destination for Winnipeggers looking to get away from the heat of the city and spend some time by the lake. The landscape is typical of the Canadian Shield, with hills, lakes, valleys, forests, and rivers. Moose, deer, black bear, and other wildlife inhabit the park. Cottages dot the shorelines of many of the lakes, but much of the wilderness area is undisturbed.

## Girl develops anti-bullying app

Shillong, Feb. 12: Distraught over repeated bullying at school, a nine-year-old girl in Shillong has developed a mobile application which would enable a person to anonymously report such incidents to the authorities. Meidaibahun Majaw, a Class 4 student, said she had taken it upon herself to find a solution to the menace, after it started taking a toll on her well-being.

"I experienced bullying in school since nursery. It affected me. I hated it so much that I was always on the lookout for a solution. No other child should have to go through the same," Majaw told PTI.

The app, which would soon be available on Google Play, allows victims, who did not want to reveal identities, to report their bullies to teachers, guardians, and friends.

"Users can provide details of the incidents, including the name of the bully, and send the messages to individuals concerned. This allows the authorities

to take necessary actions," Majaw explained.

Her efforts have been appreciated by State Education Minister Lakmen Rymbui, who said that that the girl would grow up to be a responsible citizen.


A 2017 survey conducted by The Teacher Foundation, in association with Wipro Applying Thought in Schools (WATIS), found that 42 per cent kids in India are bullied in schools.

Recounting her experiences, the nine-year-old said that a group of students had once ganged up against her and asked other classmates to boycott her.

"One of them had stamped my feet," she said, insisting that some of her friends, too, had faced similar predicaments at one point or the other. Dasumarlin Majaw, her mother, said that the girl had enrolled in an app-development course in September last year, and learned the skills within a few months.

"She would attend classes for an hour every day.

## India's first underwater train!



London and Paris. It is estimated that the train, while underwater, will be travelling at a depth that can be compared to a 10-storey tall building! The underwater stretch for the metro train will comprise of twin tunnels, which are made of 1.4 m wide concrete rings. They have been further fitted with hydrophilic


gaskets to prevent water from entering the tunnels. A staggering INR 8500 crores has been the estimated project cost as yet.

The project has been hailed by the Kolkata Metro Rail Corporation (KMRC) as signalling many of the "firsts" in the country. The metro train will be inaugurated by Railway Minister Piyush Goel on February 13, also marking it as the second metro line in the city.
