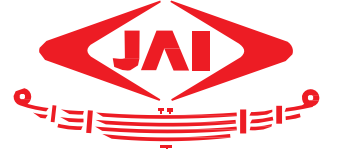

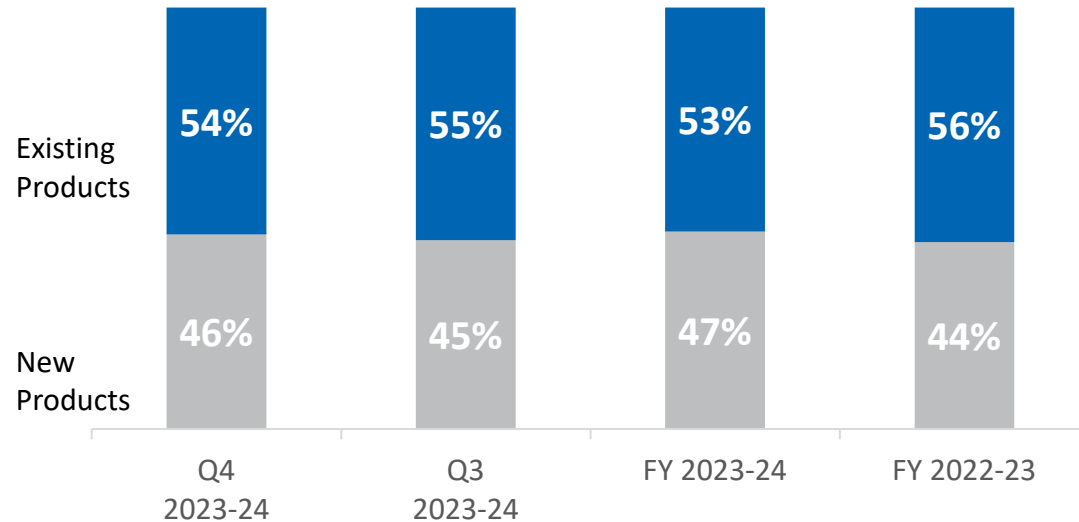

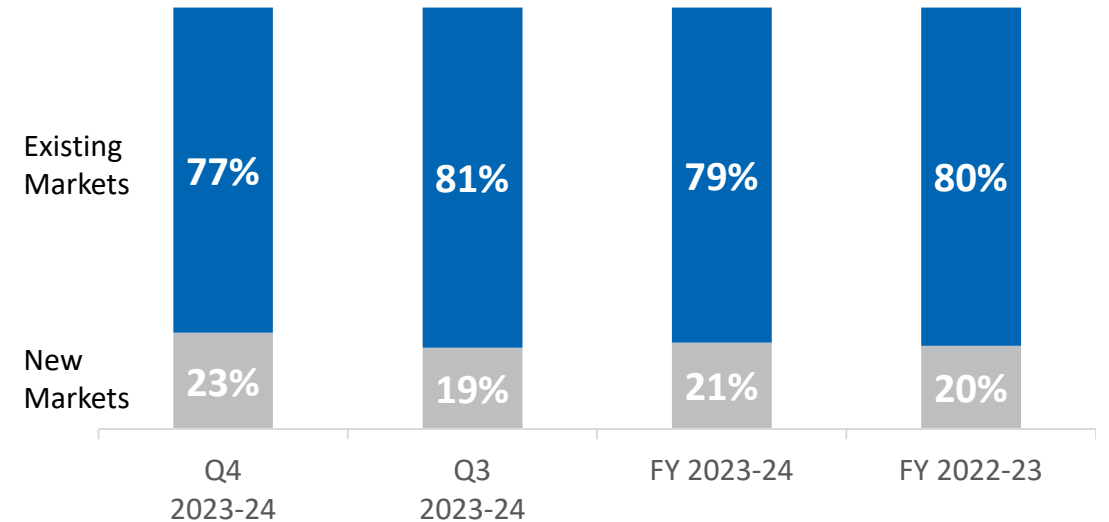


## Product Mix

- The Company is putting up a plant in Indore for leaf and parabolic springs.

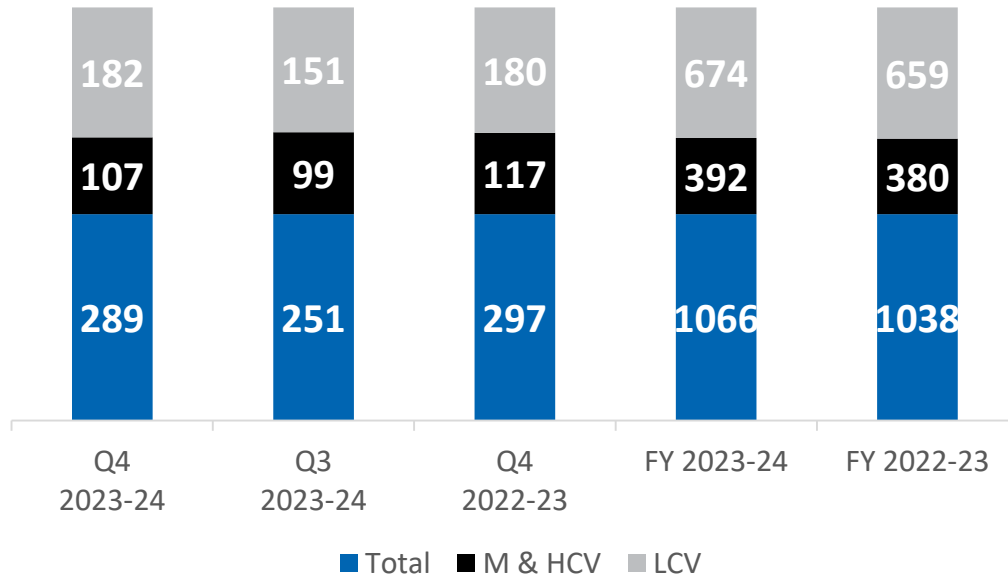

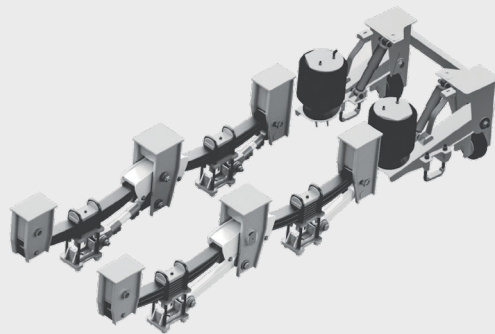

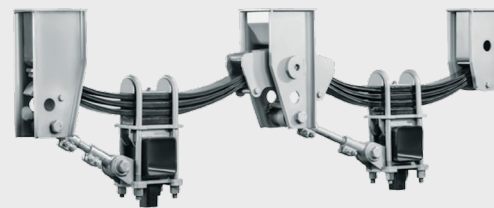

## Environment

## Education

- 6 Anganwadi centers in Yamuna Nagar have been transformed into play schools through the renovation of buildings and fullfill all requirements requested by DC Office YNR.
- Renovated stages, constructed rooms and surrounded wall, repairing of roof and floor and installed 8 water coolers in Govt. Schools –YNR and JSR.
- Distributed dental kit amongst 2100 school students & sensitized on dental hygiene in JSR, Pant Nagar & YNR.
- Total 309 females got certificates in sewing course from Jamna Sewing Training Centers and 46 females got certificates in beauty culture therapy from Jamna Beautician Training center in YNR.
- Distributed 178 sewing machines passed out needy women to start their own business in YNR.
- Provided a multi-food processing machine & 02 days training including juice/gel/soap/shampoo making training to 40 inmates in District Prison, Panipat.
- Developed 3 Mini Science lab with technical partner stem learning in Govt. schools of YNR & JSR.



## Sports

- Ensured monthly diet money to 11 sportspersons in GNK College in Yamuna Nagar.

- Supported for training to 4 sportsperson of Abhinav Bindra Foundation for one year Project.
- Installed open Gym in Tezli stadium, Chachrauli for help the Athletes in their warm-up and fitness..
- Installed Open Gyms in District prison YNR, Panipat and Gurugram to ensure good health & fitness among inmates & staff member.
- Installed Open gym with swings in 10 Govt. schools of Yamuna Nagar.



## Community Reach

- 05 Community Multi-speciality health check-up camps were organized, covering 835 community members in YNR and JSR and distributed required medicines.
- Under the Project "Open Defecation Free Yamuna Nagar" constructed more 26 individual toilets for BPL/EWS families in Chikan.
- Distributed monthly pension to 142 Sr. citizen, widow and PWD's in Faizpur, Kalesar, Tazewala, Mandoli and Dussani village.
- Supported Balkunj child care home-Chachrauli for their monthly food requirements for 80 children on each month.
- Construct a shed, Dump soils, Installed water Tank in the cremation ground of faizpur, Arriyanwala & Kishanpura in YNR.
- Distributed 250 Nutrition kit to anemic girls and pregnant ladies in YNR & Chennai on monthly basis for 6 Months.
- Arranged lunch on every month for 400 migrant people in Yamuna Nagar under food for all program.
- Installed 130 benches in villages and govt. schools in YNR & Pune and also installed 50 street lights in villages of YNR.
- Celebrate International Women's Day across all the locations and Sensitized over 2500 people on the Social issues facing by Women's in the society.
