CHENNAI: Tamil Nadu Chief Minister MK Stalin on Friday announced the extension of Covid-19 lockdown till August 9, without any further relaxations. The present lockdown comes to an end on July 31. Stalin chaired a meeting here to discuss the Covid-19 spread in Tamil Nadu and neighbouring states and the steps to be taken. He said the meeting also discussed the risk of higher Covid spread due to gathering of people at certain places due to the relaxations announced earlier, and urged District Collectors and police officials to take strong action in case of lockdown violations.

Youth shoots BDS female house surgeon, kills himself

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: In a shocking incident, a youth Rakhin on Friday barged into the house of Manasa, a 24-year-old house surgeon in Bachelor of Dental Science (BDS) in Kerala's Ernakulam district, shot the girl and then killed himself. Bijesh, the CEO of the Dental College, said the incident occurred at Kothamangalam where Manasa was doing her house surgery. "The police after speaking to the parents of Manasa said the youth Rakhin hailed from the same place as their daughter in Kannur. There were some issues between the two and he was warned by the police at Kannur in the past," Bijesh added.

CBI books Amrapali Biotech, its directors in bank fraud case

NEW DELHI: The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) has registered a case against Delhi-based Amrapali Biotech India Pvt Ltd and others including its directors in a bank fraud case and carried out searches at their premises. A CBI spokesperson said that the agency registered a case on a complaint from the Punjab National Bank, and erstwhile Oriental Bank of Commerce against the Amrapali Biotech India and others, including its Directors Sunil Kumar, Sudhir Kumar Chaudhary, Ram Vivek Singh, Seema Kumari, and Sunita Kumari, on the allegations of fraud.

Venkaiah visits Bharat Biotech's facility in Hyderabad

HYDERABAD: Vice President M Venkaiah Naidu on Friday visited vaccine maker Bharat Biotech's manufacturing facility at Genome Valley near here. There is no room for vaccine hesitancy. Vaccination drive against Covid-19 should become pan-India 'Jan Andolan' with increased participation from all sections of the people, he said according to a series of tweets from the vice president's Secretariat. "...Shri Naidu was briefed on the processes for the development of various life-saving vaccines. #BharatBiotech," a tweet said.

Body of 4-yr-old girl found stuffed in bag in Gurugram

GURUGRAM: The body of a four-year-old girl was found stuffed in a bag near the Kisan Bhawan in the Khanda Anaz Mandi area here, the police said on Friday. The identity of the deceased is yet to be ascertained, the police said. A passerby spotted the bag and informed the cops on Thursday morning. "On getting the information, we rushed to the spot with our forensic team and dog squad and found a minor's body stuffed in a bag. The body was decomposing and appeared to be a day or two old," said a police officer.

DMK pushing for beggar rehabilitation centres in TN

CHENNAI: The DMK government in Tamil Nadu under Chief Minister MK Stalin is in the process of rehabilitating the beggars in the state. The Supreme Court had stated in a recent verdict that begging cannot be banned through legislation, adding that the court cannot take an "elitist" view in the matter. Taking a cue from the Supreme Court observation, the Tamil Nadu government is planning to open rehabilitation centres across districts.

Kerala milk producers get highest price per litre: Minister

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: Dairy farmers in Kerala get Rs 36 for a litre milk, which is the best procurement price in the country, state Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development, and Milk Cooperatives Minister J Chinchurani said on Friday. In his address at the launch function of Kerala State Cooperative Milk Marketing Federation's (Milma) homogenised toned milk sachet (525 ml/Rs 25), she said that the state-owned Milma has been instrumental in achieving the goal of self-sufficiency in milk production in Kerala.

Covid cases increasing in TN: Health minister

TAMIL NADU: Tamil Nadu Health Minister Ma Subramanian has said that Covid-19 cases in the state have been increasing for the last 3 days. "No of Covid cases has been increasing in the last 3 days. RT-PCR tests have increased. The state recorded 1,859 fresh cases compared to 1,756 cases. Unfortunately, many people are not wearing face masks. Vigilance in TN-Kerala border is increased", said the minister. Kerala has witnessed a rise in Covid cases as well. It recorded 22,064 new cases on Thursday, with a positivity rate of 13.53 per cent.

Assam cops summon Mizoram MP, paste notice at Delhi home

The Assam Police has summoned Mizoram's lone Rajya Sabha MP K Vanlalvena on August 1 for questioning over his alleged "threatening statement" in connection with the Monday violence along the interstate border, and pasted a notice at his Delhi residence. The Assam Police also said it will take "lawful action" against Vanlalvena who had allegedly made a "threatening" statement over the border clash in which five policemen and a civilian were killed. Official sources said a team of Assam Police CID, which has arrived in Delhi, visited Vanlalvena's residence and the Mizoram House looking for him without any success.



Sources said Vanlalvena is believed to be avoiding the team. The MP was not available for comments. Since the Resident Commissioner of Mizoram reportedly refused to receive any notice served on Vanlalvena to join the Assam Police investigation, the CID team pasted the notice on his residence. "It has come to light that you have given a threatening state-

ment in media targeting civil and police officials in connection with the incident which is a subject matter of investigation. "Therefore, there are reasonable grounds to question you to ascertain facts and circumstances from you," the Assam Police notice read. The Mizoram MP has been asked to appear before the Officer-In-Charge of the Dholai police station in Assam's Cachar

district at 11 am on August 1 "without fail". Mizo Zirlai Pawl, a Mizo student body, accused the Assam government of "threatening" Vanlalvena, a former president of the outfit. "He has been conspired, blamed and charged against different criminal cases in connection with the Assam-Mizoram border conflict. Any problem should not happen to him. This is also information to Himanta Biswa Sarma, the CM of Assam," the MZP said in a written statement. Sources said police do not require the approval of the Speaker or Rajya Sabha Chairman to record an MP's statement, but need their permission, as the case may be, before arresting an MP.

Challenging new IT Rules
HC to hear in Aug pleas of FB, WhatsApp

NEW DELHI

The Delhi High Court Friday said it will hear on August 27 the pleas by Facebook and WhatsApp challenging the new IT rules for social media intermediaries, requiring the messaging app to "trace" chats and make provisions to identify the first originator of information, on the ground that they violate the right to privacy and are unconstitutional. A bench of Chief Justice D N Patel and Justice Jyoti Singh listed the matter for August 27 after Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, representing the Centre, said he was in some difficulty and urged the court to adjourn the hearing. The request was not opposed by senior advocates Harish Salve and Mukul Rohatgi, appearing for WhatsApp and Facebook respectively. The new Information Technology (Intermediary Guidelines and Digital Media Ethics Code) Rules, 2021 were announced by the government on February 25 and requires large social media platforms like Twitter, Facebook, Instagram and WhatsApp to comply with the norms by May 25.

SOME MINISTERS LIKELY BE DROPPED FROM GEHLOT CABINET

Few ministers have expressed willingness to work for the organisation, says Maken

Some ministers are likely to be dropped from the Ashok Gehlot Cabinet for the proposed reshuffle in Rajasthan. Those who will be dropped will get a chance to work in the organisation. The in-charge general secretary Ajay Maken has hinted this af-

"There are some ministers who have come forward and told to me that they are ready to work in the organisation to strengthen the party and I am very thankful to them," said Maken while talking to media before leaving to Delhi, although he denied

giving the number of such ministers and said that there are many who willing to work for the organisation. A Cabinet expansion and appointments to district Congress posts is expected soon, following demands by supporters of former deputy chief minister Sachin Pilot for a bigger share of power in the state led by Ashok Gehlot. "There are people who are eager to leave government positions and work for the organisation. We are proud of such people," Maken said, his remarks indicating that some ministers in the Gehlot Cabinet may now make way for fresh faces.

HC permits schools to collect 85% fee in six installments

The Madras High Court on Friday permitted private unaided schools in Tamil Nadu to collect 85 per cent of the annual fees for the year 2021-22 in six installments from students whose parents had not suffered loss of income during the Covid-19 pandemic period. This, provided the schools conducted the online classes without any hindrance, the court said. Parents who have suffered loss of income during this period shall make an application to the school management, who shall consider their request and collect 75 per cent of the fees, as per a circular by the Commissioner of School Education for 2021-2022, in six instalments. Justice D Krishnakumar issued directions to this effect today while disposing of a batch of over 45 writ petitions from the Federation of Association of Private Schools in Tamil Nadu (FAPSIT).

BJP should not listen to everything BSY says: BJP leader

2020 Lockdown: Indian women worst sufferers

The 2020 nationwide lockdown India imposed in response to the Covid-19 pandemic caused disruptions that negatively impacted women's nutrition, according to a new study from the Tata-Cornell Institute for Agriculture and Nutrition. Published in the journal *Economia Politica*, the study shows that women's dietary diversity - the number of food groups consumed - declined during the lockdown compared to the same period in 2019. Most concerning, the drop was due to decreased consumption of foods like meats, eggs, vegetables and fruits, which are rich in micronutrients that are crucial to good health and development. "Women's diets were lacking

in diverse foods even before the pandemic, but COVID-19 has further exacerbated the situation," said Soumya Gupta, a research economist at TCI who coauthored the study along with Prabhu Pingali, TCI director; Mathew Abraham, assistant director; and consultant Payal Seth. "Any policies addressing the impact of the pandemic on nutritional outcomes must do so through a gendered lens that reflects the specific, and often persistent, vulnerabilities faced by women." The Indian government instituted a national lockdown to slow down the spread of Covid-19 on March 24, 2020. Disruptions to agricultural supply chains subsequently led to price fluctuations, especially for nonstaple foods. The

lockdown was lifted on May 30, 2020, though some restrictions remained in certain areas of the country. TCI analyzed surveys of food expenditures, dietary diversity and other nutrition indicators at the national, state and district levels in the states of Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and Odisha. They found that food expenditures significantly declined during the lockdown, especially in less developed districts. Nearly 90% of survey respondents reported having less food, while 95% said they consumed fewer types of food. The largest drop in food expenditures was for micronutrient-rich fresh and dried fruits, as well as animal products such as meat, fish and eggs.

NEW DELHI: The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) has registered a case against Delhi-based Amrapali Biotech India Pvt Ltd and others including its directors in a bank fraud case and carried out searches at their premises. A CBI spokesperson said that the agency registered a case on a complaint from the Punjab National Bank, and erstwhile Oriental Bank of Commerce against the Amrapali Biotech India and others, including its Directors Sunil Kumar, Sudhir Kumar Chaudhary, Ram Vivek Singh, Seema Kumari, and Sunita Kumari, on the allegations of fraud.

Body of 4-yr-old girl found stuffed in bag in Gurugram

GURUGRAM: The body of a four-year-old girl was found stuffed in a bag near the Kisan Bhawan in the Khandas Anaz Mandi area here, the police said on Friday. The identity of the deceased is yet to be ascertained, the police said. A passerby spotted the body and informed the cops on Thursday morning. "On getting the information, we rushed to the spot with our forensic team and dog squad and found a minor's body stuffed in a bag. The body was decomposing and appeared to be a day or two old," said a police officer.

DMK pushing for beggar rehabilitation centres in TN

CHENNAI: The DMK government in Tamil Nadu under Chief Minister MK Stalin is in the process of rehabilitating the beggars in the state. The Supreme Court had stated in a recent verdict that begging cannot be banned through legislation, adding that the court cannot take an "elitist" view in the matter. Taking a cue from the Supreme Court observation, the Tamil Nadu government is planning to open rehabilitation centres across districts.

Contract Farming Act will ruin rural eco: Kisan Sansad

The Kisan Sansad, being held at Jantar Mantar by the Samyukt Kisan Morcha (SKM) despite flooding by heavy rain, passed a resolution, after 2 days of deliberations on July 28-29, urging the Indian Parliament to repeal the Farmers Agreement on Price Assurance and Farm Services Act, 2020, described shortly as the Contract Farming Act. Rejecting the law, it questioned the government's policy to excluding the landless farmers in its agri-digitisation plans and linking entitlements to only the landed farmers, which is "clearly against the National Policy for Farmers, 2017." It resolved "full protection be offered to uphold farmers' interests (economic viability, environmental sustainability and social equity) in all marketing options for them, such that any contract farming option is only based on prior informed consent, on par with other options available to a farmer and not on coercion.

"Further, strong regulation should be put in place at the state level which protects the small farmers from predatory contract farming, which fixes clear accountability and liability on the companies which enter into the contract farming arrangements, which stipulates the companies should provide at least the MSP to farmers, which ensures access to justice for the farmers and speedy resolution of cases where farmers face losses due to exploitative practices of the companies, and which removes any provisions which enable corporate takeover of the farmers' lands," the resolution added.

Assam cops summon Mizo MP, paste notice at Delhi home

The Assam Police has summoned Mizoram's lone Rajya Sabha MP K Vanlalvena on August 1 for questioning over his alleged "threatening statement" in connection with the Monday violence along the interstate border, and pasted a notice at his Delhi residence. The Assam Police also said it will take "lawful action" against Vanlalvena who had allegedly made a "threatening" statement over the border clash in which five policemen and a civilian were killed.

Official sources said a team of Assam Police CID, which has arrived in Delhi, visited Vanlalvena's residence and the Mizoram House looking for him without any success.

Sources said Vanlalvena is believed to be avoiding the team. The MP was not available for comments.

Since the Resident Commissioner of Mizoram reportedly refused to receive any notice served on Vanlalvena to join the Assam Police investigation, the CID team pasted the notice on his residence.

"It has come to light that you have given a threatening statement in media targeting civil and police officials in connection with the incident which is a subject matter of investigation.

"Therefore, there are reasonable grounds to question you to ascertain facts and circumstances from you," the Assam Police notice read. The Mizoram MP has been asked to appear before the Officer-In-Charge of the Dholai police station in Assam's Cachar district at 11 am on August 1 "without fail".

Mizo Zirlai Pawl, a Mizo student body, accused the Assam government of "threatening" Vanlalvena, a former president of the outfit. "He has been conspired, blamed and charged against different criminal cases in connection with the Assam-Mizoram border conflict. Any problem should not happen to him. This is also information to Himanta Biswa Sarma, the CM of Assam," the MZP said in a written statement.

2020 lockdown: Women worst sufferers

The 2020 nationwide lockdown India imposed in response to the Covid-19 pandemic caused disruptions that negatively impacted women's nutrition, according to a new study from the Tata-Cornell Institute for Agriculture and Nutrition.

Published in the journal *Economia Politica*, the study shows that women's dietary diversity - the number of food groups consumed - declined during the lockdown compared to the same period in 2019. Most concerning, the drop

was due to decreased consumption of foods like meats, eggs, vegetables and fruits, which are rich in micronutrients that are crucial to good health and development.

"Women's diets were lacking in diverse foods even before the pandemic, but COVID-19 has further exacerbated the situation," said Soumya Gupta, a research economist at TCI who coauthored the study along with Prabhu Pingali, TCI director; Mathew Abraham, assistant director; and consultant Payal Seth. "Any policies addressing the impact

of the pandemic on nutritional outcomes must do so through a gendered lens that reflects the specific, and often persistent, vulnerabilities faced by women."

The Indian government instituted a national lockdown to slow down the spread of Covid-19 on March 24, 2020. Disruptions to agricultural supply chains subsequently led to price fluctuations, especially for nonstaple foods. The lockdown was lifted on May 30, 2020, though some restrictions remained in certain areas of the country.
