Isro solar mission Aditya-L1 set for launch on Sept 2

Moon rover Pragyan sends photos of exploration

FIVE DAYS AFTER its Chandrayaan-3 Lander Module scripted history by landing successfully near the lunar south pole, the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) Monday released photographs taken by the Moon rover and announced that its first solar mission, Aditya-L1, to study the Sun will be launched at 11.50 am September 2 from the Sriharikota spaceport.



A combination of two photos shows a crater (left) that the Chandrayaan-3 rover Pragyan encountered on August 27, and the path (right) retraced by it on the lunar surface, as seen by the navigation camera onboard the rover.

Putting out photographs of a crater and the imprint of the rover's wheels on the lunar surface, ISRO said, "On August 27, 2023, the Rover came across a 4-metre diameter crater positioned 3 metres ahead of its location. The Rover was commanded to retrace the path. It's now safely heading on a new path."

The rover has left tracks behind on the lunar surface as captured by its navigation camera. One of the reasons for choosing a landing spot close to the Moon south pole is the presence of craters that usually remain in shadow completely, increasing the likelihood of presence of frozen water that will be key to future space missions. The space agency also announced the liftoff Saturday

of Aditya-L1. It is being prepared for its travel 1.5 million km away from the Earth - only 1% of the distance to the Sun - to the Langrange point L1 or L1 point which provides an unobstructed view of the Sun even during a solar eclipse.

This distance to the L1 point is about four times what was covered by Chandrayaan missions. Just like Chandrayaan-3, the satellite will be placed in an elliptical orbit around the Earth, a series of manoeuvres will raise the orbit as well as velocity of the spacecraft, till it is eventually slingshot towards the Sun.

The distance to the L1 point will be covered by the space-

craft in four months. It will then be placed in a halo orbit around the L1 point to allow the payloads to start making observations. The spacecraft will carry seven scientific payloads to study the upper layers of the solar atmosphere called chromosphere and corona, particles and plasma coming from the Sun, the magnetic field of the Sun, and the drivers of space weather.

This radiation, heat, flow of particles, and magnetic fields constantly influence the Earth. Studying this can also shed light on the space weather of other planets.

Another important science objective of the mission is to find clues to the mystery of

coronal heating. One of the long standing mysteries of the Sun is why its atmospheric layer called the corona is a million degrees hot even though the surface is just over 5,500 degrees Celsius.

While Aditya L1 is the first ever mission by the space agency to study the Sun, it is the second space-based observatory being launched by it - the previous one being AstroSat meant for astronomy research launched in 2015.

The instruments of Aditya-L1 are tuned to observe the solar atmosphere, mainly the chromosphere and corona. In-situ instruments will observe the local environment at the L1 point.

Nuh turns into a fortress: Police say no yatra

CHECKING AT BORDERS, ferrying devotees to Nalhar temple - Haryana's Nuh district saw heavy police deployment Monday amid calls that the jalabhishek yatra would be taken out. Police reiterated that the yatra did not take place and that they only allowed for the jalabhishek programme with locals and a few VHP members.

ADGP Mamta Singh told *The Indian Express*, "There was no yatra. We had told them we would not hamper the jalabhishek programme and people offered it without any issue like any other Monday. Around 700-800 people offered jalabhishek today. Our denial was only for the yatra. There were many locals from across Nuh who came in 14-15 vehicles. Since we didn't want to have a crowd gathered at the temple, we asked them to park their vehicles at Police Lines and took them in two tempo travellers. One was occupied by a few VHP members and some sadhus. I am not aware if they are going to all three temples. We checked all vehicles and no weapons were found. No arrests or detentions have been made in Nuh as of now." There were multiple checkpoints on the road leading to Nalhar temple, starting from Ghamroj toll plaza in Sohna where police carried out checking of all vehicles.

At the Gurgaon-Nuh border were police and Rapid Action Force personnel, taking down details of passengers and their vehicles before entering the district. ADGP Singh had said that they did not restrict locals from entering the temple.

BJP likely to go for LS polls in Dec: Mamata

WESTBENGAL CHIEF minister Mamata Banerjee on Monday said that the BJP might conduct the Lok Sabha polls in December itself, claiming that all choppers have been booked by the saffron party for campaigning.

Banerjee, who was speaking at a TMC youth wing rally, cautioned that a third term for the

BJP would ensure the nation faces an "autocratic" rule. The BJP has "already booked all choppers", so that no other political party can use those for canvassing, Banerjee claimed.

The chief minister also blamed some people engaged in "unlawful activities" for the illegal firecracker factory blasts that

have occurred in the state. She alleged that this was being done "with support from a few police personnel".

Banerjee claimed that the BJP has "already booked all choppers" to campaign in the Lok Sabha polls, so that no other political party can use those for canvassing. **PTI**

In call with PM, Putin says won't attend G20

RUSSIAN PRESIDENT Vladimir Putin spoke to Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday and conveyed his inability to attend the G20 Summit in New Delhi on September 9-10. Putin informed Modi that Russia would be represented by Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov.

While expressing an understanding for Russia's

decision, Modi thanked Putin for Russia's consistent support to all the initiatives under India's G20 presidency, the Prime Minister's Office

(PMO) said.

"The two leaders reviewed progress on a number of issues of bilateral cooperation and exchanged views on regional and global issues of mutual concern, including the recently concluded BRICS Summit in Johannesburg," the PMO said in a statement.

Putin did not attend the BRICS Summit in person, but joined it virtually instead. Lavrov represented Russia at the summit in Johannesburg. Last week, the Kremlin had

announced that Putin would not attend the G20 Summit in person, saying he has a "busy schedule" and the main focus is still the "special military operation" in Ukraine.

Modi met Putin at the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation Summit in Samarkand last year, where he told him that "this is not the era of war".

After the Russian invasion of Ukraine, Putin did not attend the G20 Summit in Bali last November.

Liquor excise scam: CBI books ED official

THE CBI HAS registered an FIR against ED Assistant Director Pawan Khatri in connection with an alleged payment of ₹5 crore by liquor businessman Amandeep Dhall who wanted help in the Delhi excise policy scam case, officials said.

Along with the two, the CBI has also named an assistant general manager of Air India Deepak Sangwan, the CEO of Claridges Hotels and Resorts Vikramaditya, chartered accountant Praveen Kumar Vats and two others - Nitesh Kohar, an UDC in the ED, and Birender Pal Singh, they said. The CBI action was initiated on a complaint from ED, which during its probe in the Delhi government's excise policy scam found that Amandeep Dhall, an accused in the case, and his father Birender Pal Singh gave ₹5 crore bribe to chartered accountant Praveen Vats for arranging help in the ED probe, the officials said. **-PTI**
