## Row over BBC film reaches DU, Ambedkar University

At least 24 students who gathered outside Delhi University's Arts Faculty for a mass screening of the controversial BBC documentary, *India: The Modi Question*, were detained, the police said on Friday, adding that they were later released.

On Friday morning, the National Students' Union of India (NSUI) announced a screening at 4 p.m. on the North Campus, while the Bhim Army Students' Federation said it would hold a viewing outside the university's Arts Faculty at 5 p.m.

A similar screening was planned by the Students' Federation of India (SFI) on the Ambedkar University campus. SFI joint secretary Yashita Singhi said the mass screening was scheduled to take place at 1 p.m. However, the university cut off the electricity supply to stop the viewing, she alleged.

A day before Republic Day, Jamia Millia Islamia too witnessed similar scenes after the SFI's plans to organise a screening of the documentary on the Gujarat pogrom of 2002, were thwarted by the university and the police. Thirteen students were de-

tained and released later. On Tuesday, JNU had witnessed protests over the screening even as the administration had cut off power supply to the campus.

### Scenes at DU

NSUI activist Ajil K. Binu, who was among the detained students, said, "We were peacefully trying to screen the documentary but were detained by the police. The administration did not say anything."

DU Proctor Rajni Abbi said the students' outfits had not sought the administration's permission. "No permission was sought from us but the students continued to protest. The police will take action as necessary," she said.

"Around 4 p.m., students gathered outside the

gate. Since it can disturb the peace in the area, they were asked to disperse. When they decided not to, we detained 24 students," DCP (North) Sagar Singh Kalsi said.

Section 144 of the CrPC has been imposed in the area to maintain law and order and large gatherings have been restricted, the police said.

### Ambedkar University

While the university administration said it had not received any information regarding the screening, Ms. Singhi said the students were barred from entering the canteen area as well. She also alleged that students affiliated to the ABVP tried to disrupt the gathering and played religious songs.

## Sisodia urges DU V-C to retain ad hoc teachers

Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia on Friday requested Delhi University Vice-Chancellor Yogesh Singh to facilitate the absorption of ad hoc and temporary teachers in Delhi government colleges. Mr. Sisodia said the ongoing interviews for assistant professors in different colleges of DU have been "catastrophic as reports say 70% of ad hoc teachers are being displaced".

"Many of these ad hoc teachers have been teaching in Delhi University colleges for decades. They understand the challenges of an institution like Delhi University. They know how to deal with students coming from different parts of the country with diverse linguistic backgrounds and academic experiences. The experience of teaching in a classroom cannot be replaced," he said.

"Ordinance XVIII-4(a) provides for the appointments of teaching staff to be done by the governing body. In our 28 [government] colleges, we want to go ahead with the absorption of the ad hoc and temporary teachers," he added.

## SC to hear AAP's plea on mayoral polls next week

Bharadwaj thanks the court for early hearing, says party was forced to seek SC's intervention to end BJP's illegal control of MCD; AAP members' conduct in House exposes their drama: Khurana

The Supreme Court on Friday agreed to list on February 3 a petition filed by AAP's mayoral candidate Shelly Oberoi seeking time-bound conduct of the mayoral polls.

The petition was orally mentioned before Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud by senior advocate A.M. Singhvi, appearing for Ms. Oberoi. "It will be listed on February 3, 2023," the CJ said.

The election was stalled on January 24 for the second time this month after the MCD House meeting was adjourned by Satya Sharma, BJP councillor and the presiding officer appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor, following a ruckus.

AAP had won 134 of the 250 wards in the MCD polls in December, while the BJP managed to garner 104 wards.

Delhi is yet to get a Mayor despite the poll results being declared over 50 days ago.

Thanking the Supreme Court for scheduling a hearing next week, AAP chief spokesperson Saurabh Bharadwaj said, "Our plea calls for swift and timely conduct of Mayor, Deputy Mayor and Standing Committee elections in Delhi, which have been long overdue."

### War of words

"The entire country knows that AAP wants to get the

mayoral polls held freely and fairly, but the BJP is seeking to cling on to power in the MCD illegally," he added.

The BJP has, instead, pinned the blame for the delay in mayoral polls on AAP and accused its councillors of repeatedly creating a stir in the MCD's House meetings.

Mr. Bharadwaj said AAP had requested the court to ensure that the mayoral

elections are conducted as per the Delhi Municipal Corporation Act, 1957, which stipulates that nominated members of the MCD do not get a vote in the mayoral polls.

"The BJP's actions reveal their desire to control the MCD despite their tenure ending in March 2022. For the past year, they have used the pretext of unification and delimitation to maintain hold over the civic body," the AAP leader said.

### 'AAP running away'

"It is AAP which doesn't want the elections to take place," Delhi BJP spokesperson Harish Khurana said.

He added that AAP councillors, who protested the presiding officer's decision to administer the oath to the aldermen first in the January 6 House meeting leading to an adjournment, were silent in the House during the January 24 meeting.

"This shows that their protest was nothing but a drama," Mr. Khurana added.

## Will decide on date for mayoral polls after SC hearing, says presiding officer

With AAP moving the Supreme Court for holding the mayoral elections in a "time-bound manner", presiding officer Satya Sharma told *The Hindu* that she will decide on the poll date only after the apex court's hearing on February 3.

Ms. Sharma, a BJP councillor appointed as the presiding officer for the mayoral polls by the Lieutenant-Governor, said her initial plan was to reconvene the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) House meeting in the first week of February to hold

the internal election for the office of the Mayor.

The Capital is yet to witness the Mayor's election after two meetings - held on January 6 and 24 - were adjourned due to a ruckus between BJP and AAP councillors. It's been more than 50 days since AAP secured a majority by winning 134 of the 250 seats in the MCD polls, followed by the BJP's 104 seats.

AAP councillor and leader of the House in the MCD,

Mukesh Goel, said his party approached the Supreme Court because the presiding officer "has no intention" of convening the next House meeting soon. "We have also placed before the court the issue of the presiding officer giving voting rights to the aldermen. The presiding officer has to be unbiased," he said.

According to Section 79 (6) of the Delhi Municipal Corporation Act, 1957, if a grave disorder arises in a meeting, the Mayor or the person presiding the session may adjourn it to a date specified by them. MCD officials said as per this Section, the presiding officer will have to convey

the date to reconvene the meeting.

But MCD's director for Press and Information, Amit Kumar, said, "According to my interpretation, this Section applies only when a Mayor is already in place."

"The presiding officer will have to work as per the provisions in the Act, which clearly states that the aldermen do not have voting rights in meetings. Similarly, she will have to convey the date to the MCD's executive wing for the next meeting. Based on her suggestion, the executive wing will send the file to the L-G," said an MCD official.

## Delhi BJP to launch app to assess leaders' performance

Addressing a two-day meeting of the BJP's Delhi unit, party vice-president Bajjayant 'Jay' Panda said the performance of the party's office-bearers will be monitored through a soon-to-be-launched mobile app. The road map for the Lok Sabha election (2024), the Assembly poll (2025) and the results of the recently held municipal polls were some of the topics discussed in the meeting on Friday. Party sources said an organisational overhaul could happen after the two-day event.

"Changes in the party's city unit may be made soon," a source said, adding that a full-time president of the Delhi unit could be appointed any time after February 1. According to sources, Delhi BJP working president Virendra Sachdeva is among the contenders for the job. In the party meeting on Friday, Mr. Sachdeva asked the BJP workers to "expose the corruption of the Kejriwal government" and dedicate their next 400 days to the party's outreach programmes, in time for the Lok Sabha election.

## 'Kejriwal must apologise to city's traders'

## Police nab college student for stalking minor girls online

A 17-year-old college student was apprehended for allegedly stalking minor girls and threatening to circulate their private pictures on social media, the police said on Friday.

A senior police officer said they received a complaint from a 14-year-old victim's father, who said the accused threatened his daughter.

The victim told the police that she had shared private photos with a boy she met on Instagram.

"She said that the accused was pressuring her into having inappropriate conversations and sharing more photographs," the officer added.

The police identified the location of the accused, who is pursuing his graduation from the School of Open Learning, based on his call detail record.

"The accused told the police that he came in possession of some private pictures of a girl and start-

### The accused came in possession of private photos of a girl, following which he started asking her for nude photos, said a senior police officer

ed following her on Instagram. He kept her private pictures saved on his mobile phone and used to stalk her online all the time," Deputy Commissioner of Police (North) Sagar Singh Kalsi said.

"After befriending her, he started asking for her nude photos. But when the girl declined, he showed the nude photos he already had with him and demanded more photos and sexual favours online," the DCP added.

The police have registered a case under Sections 354A (sexual harassment), 354D (stextortion) of the Indian Penal Code, and relevant sections of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act.

At a time when history is being fictionalised, director Raj Kumar Santoshi uses creative licence to bust the canards that have been allowed to fester over the years to delegitimise Mahatma Gandhi in public conscience. From being called a pawn of the Empire to faking fasts, a notion has been created that Gandhi forced the first government of independent India to release ₹55 crore to Pakistan.

The film suggests that it triggered Nathuram Godse to kill Gandhi on January 30, 1948, and goes on to bust the half-truth. Based on prominent Hindi scholar Asghar Wahjat's play, Santoshi revisits the events leading up to Gandhi's assassination and then takes a

One could question the need to provide a

platform to Godse and create a false equivalence with Gandhi but as the film progresses it becomes clear that Gandhi and Godse are just metaphors. The idea is to initiate a dialogue on the idea of India that got diminished at the time of the partition. Instead of brushing the divide under the carpet of euphemisms, it experiments with the bitter truths and seeks to find a closure.

At a time when the Hindutva ideology has

seen a spike, Santoshi denies Godse the pleasure of martyrdom and allows him to evolve. At the same times, he attempts to humanise and critique Gandhi in his parallel universe.

Deepak Antani as Gandhi gets the gait and smile of Gandhi right and manages to provide an insight into the Mahatma's mind. Chinmay Mandlekar is not bad either but gets theatrical at times. Young Tanisha Santoshi is impressive as the woman whose devotion to Gandhi comes in the way of her love life.

In a stroke of brilliance, composer A.R. Rahman reimagines the prayer *Vaishnav Jan To* as a hymn for heart ache.

The story of a son of India who puts country before self, *Pathaan* is a crowd pleaser that marks the return of Shah Rukh Khan to action genre with new toys and a lot more bombast. Returning after a hiatus, Shah Rukh is in form in the larger-than-life space of Yash Raj banner's growing spy universe where writers pick strands from the real world and propel them at escape velocity.

Here, director Siddharth Anand draws from current affairs like the abrogation of Article 370, Pakistan's fascination for Kashmir, bio warfare and mysterious viral attacks to conjure up a spectacle sans secrets that is safe for the thin skinned and provides fans of Hollywood spy agents some smart *desi* stuff to cheer about.

Moving at a breakneck speed in locations across the world, it is about an aging Indian secret agent (Shah Rukh) who puts together a team of retired agents to navigate where the red tape doesn't stick. Their fight is against an insider called Jim (John Abraham) who has turned rogue and is out to finish India in collusion with a Pakistani general. Along the way, Pathaan comes across an ISI agent Rubina (Deepika Padukone) whose fashion sense is obvious, but her designs are ambiguous.

Writers Sridhar Raghavan and Abbas Tyrewala (dialogues) segue Shah Rukh's genetic material with the screenplay to create some whistle-inducing dialogues on Pathaan's commitment, courage and camaraderie. With Shah Rukh, it is not just about brawn as he brings his trademark wit, irreverence and self-deprecatory humour, making *Pathaan* different from Tiger and Kabir, the other agents prowling in the vicinity. It is only Shah Rukh who could

pop a pain killer with the coolt of chewing a gum.

The writers present a world where terrorism has been corporatised and the services of mercenaries are available to the highest bidder. It is this colour-agnostic enemy who has no shame in putting lucre before humanity that *Besharm Rang*, the so-called controversial song in the film, hints at. More importantly, the film engages with the definition of nationalism as to how you look at your country – mother or beloved. Pathaan says a lover can betray but a mother can't.

Like the good old days, the writers have given the surname-less villain a compelling back story and the hero the licence to put him in this rightful place. They have gently mixed the personal with the political. For instance, the Pakistani general who has evil designs on India is fighting cancer. Interestingly, in the geopolitics of the narrative, there is no mention of the U.S., Russia is an indispensa-

ble ally and an orphaned Pathaan (Shah Rukh Khan) finds his identity during a mission in Afghanistan. Also, the film refrains from painting every Pakistani with the same brush and differentiates between political interests and a global crisis.

In the macho space, Siddharth has created solid platforms for female characters. Dimple Kapadia is imposing as Pathaan's boss who doesn't let emotion come in the way of duty. And in between the good and the evil, Deepika comes as a shining shade of grey. Together, Shah Rukh and Deepika are like camphor and flame who threaten to set the screen on fire with their chemistry where grace meets ruse.

The affair of an Indian and Pakistani agent reminds of the *Tiger* series and provides material for one among many inside jokes in the film which in a way carries forward *Veer Zara's* gender equation between the two countries in Hindi ci-

nema. Salman Khan's cameo on a moving train is a kind of bonus for the fans. Wish we had more to chew between the lines.

Delivering one of his better performances in the last few years, John turns out to be a strong match for Shah Rukh. It is not just the abdominal muscles; he provides the film a breath of cool air.

More than the political layers, the makers are interested in putting together breathtaking action sequences. Shot in almost all possible means of transport, they are a step ahead than what we have watched before in Bollywood, but the computer-generated imagery is not seamless, and the lack of intrinsic logic becomes baffling at times. The utter lack of surprise in the way some of the conflicts resolve leaves one disappointed. Also, certain scenes and plot devices sound like Hindi dub of sequences lifted from Hollywood tent poles, making them feel generic and plastic.

Siddharth focuses too much on choreographing action, often leaving emotions hanging by a thread. It is the individual charm of the performers that makes up for the lack of strong emotional core. No wonder, early in the film, a scientist says, science is easy; love is hard.

# South Africa's Power Cuts Not Sparing The Dead

Johannesburg, South Africa: The power crisis that has struck South Africa can leave citizens and businesses deprived of electricity for hours at a time - but few victims are more vulnerable than undertakers.

Mortuary directors are urging the bereaved to carry out fast-track funerals to avoid decay and ease pressure on morgue refrigerators.

"The industry is seeing a large number of putrefied bodies," the South African Funeral Practitioners Association (SAFPA) declared bluntly this week.

Burial within four days "is cost-effective and prevents families from seeing their de-

parted ones in a poor state of decomposition," it said.

That could require uncomfortable change in a country where most funerals take place one or two weeks after the death - and mourners file past an open coffin, with the dead bodies on view, on the day of the funeral.

Undertakers ease dependence on the state power monopoly Eskom by using diesel generators to keep their morgues cold. But they are being hit with soaring energy bills.

"Smaller parlours are battling to make ends meet because now the majority of their funds are going towards dealing with" the



outages, said Dududu Magano, spokesman for the National Funeral Directors' Association. Scheduled blackouts, known as load shedding, have burdened Africa's most industrialised economy for over a decade, as Eskom's creaking coal-

fired plants struggle to meet demand. But the outages hannesburg undertaker of 10 years, blamed the outages for recently causing her refrigerator's compressor to fail.

"The constant on-and-off caused it to stop working, but luckily I had a back-up compressor. Can you imagine what would have happened if I didn't?" she told AFP, saying she would have to pass on the higher electricity costs to clients.

'Ripple effect' Industry regulations require funeral parlours and mortuaries to have back-up generators, but not all comply.

"Generators don't come cheap," said Mike Nqakula, who owns a funeral home in the

# Protests against Quran burning held across the Middle East

Protests were held on Friday in several predominantly Muslim countries to denounce the recent desecration of Islam's holy book by far-right activists in Sweden and the Netherlands.

The moves angered millions of Muslims around the world and triggered protests.

Swedish officials have stressed that freedom of expression is guaranteed by the Swedish Constitution and gives people extensive rights to express their views publicly, though incitement to violence or hate speech isn't allowed. Demonstrators must apply to police for a permit for a public gathering. Police can deny such permits only on exceptional grounds, such as risks to public safety.

Iraq's powerful Shiite cleric Muqtada al-Sadr asked in comments released Friday whether freedom of speech means offending other people's beliefs.

# US On Edge Over Expected Release Of Fatal Police Brutality Video

Memphis, United States: The southern US city of Memphis braced itself for unrest Friday as authorities prepared to release a video depicting the fatal assault of a Black man by five police officers who, the victim's mother said, "beat him to a pulp."

The police officers, who are also Black, were charged with second-degree murder in the beating of 29-year-old Tyre Nichols, who died in hospital on January 10, three days after being stopped on suspicion of reckless driving.

"They had beat him to a pulp," Nichols's mother Row-vaughn Wells told CNN, sobbing as she described him in hospital. "He had bruises all over. His head was swollen like a watermelon. His neck was bursting because of the swelling."

"I knew my son was gone," Wells said. Memphis police chief Cerelyn Davis said the graphic video, which will be released after 6:00 pm Central time (0000 GMT Saturday), shows Nichols crying out for his mother.

"What I saw on this video was more of a groupthink sort of mentality. And no one took a step to intercept or intervene," Davis said. "And that's why the charges are as severe as they are."

# Black Boxes Of Nepal Plane That Crashed To Be Analysed In Singapore: Report

Singapore: Singapore's Transport Ministry will analyse the black boxes of a Yeti Airlines flight that crashed in Nepal on January 15, killing all 72 people on board, including five Indians, in the country's worst air crash in 30 years.

The Yeti Airlines flight 691, after taking off from Kathmandu's Tribhuvan International Airport, crashed on the bank of the Seti River between the old airport and the new air-



port in the resort city of Pokhara, minutes before landing. Fifty-three Nepalese passengers and 15 foreign nationals, including five Indians, and four crew members were on board the plane when it crashed.

ATR-72 plane's flight recorder, said an MOT spokesperson in a statement on Thursday.

The analysis will be carried out at TSIB's flight recorder readout facility, which was set up in 2007.

Gandhinagar: Japanese engineer Masahiro Hara, known for inventing the ubiquitous 'QR code' nearly 30 years ago, announced on Friday that he is now working on a new version of the popular tracking system.

Unlike the present black and white QR code design, the new version will have more colours and may be rectangular in shape rather than current square pattern, said Mr Hara while talking to reporters on the Karnavati University campus in Uvards village of Gandhinagar district.

"I am in the process of inventing a new QR code. It will take some time though. Unlike the current version, the new code system will have colours and it may be rectangular rather than the present square shape," said Mr Hara, who was on his maiden trip to India.



# Nepal's Combative Deputy PM Loses Post Over Citizenship

Kathmandu, Nepal: Nepal's top court on Friday barred combative deputy prime minister Rabi Lamichhane from office for failing to regain citizenship in the Himalayan republic after giving up his US passport.

Lamichhane, 48, is well-known for his career as a television host, making his name as an anti-corruption crusader through aggressive interviews with public officials. He was one of the biggest winners in elections last November, securing his new party a place in the ruling coalition and himself the post of deputy prime minister. But Supreme Court spokesman Bimal Poudel told AFP that Lamichhane was ineligible to keep his post after not "following the due process" when he relinquished his US citizenship in 2018. "The constitutional bench of the Supreme Court has ruled that his candidacy and election to the post of a member of the House of Representatives are void," Poudel said.
