Details of the violation(s)/ contravention(s) committed or alleged to be committed	In a consumer case filed before District Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission (DCDRC), Shamli (Uttar Pradesh) by a customer against the Company, dealer and an insurance company, DCDRC imposed penalties against the defendants in the final order. A penalty of Rs. 50,000/- was imposed upon the Company expecting that appropriate action may have been taken against the dealer.
Impact on financial, operation or other activities of the listed entity, quantifiable in monetary terms to the extent possible	The Company shall file an appeal before the State Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh and the current penalty amount of Rs. 50,000/- does not form a major financial impact on the Company.
