Q3 FY23 Consolidated operating income at Rs 11,282 mn (Y-o-Y of 17.5%) with EBITDA* of Rs 2,660 mn (Y-o-Y of 46.3%) 9M FY23 Consolidated operating income at Rs 33,032 mn (Y-o-Y of 19.7%) with EBITDA* of Rs 7,408 mn (Y-o-Y of 47.2%)

Bengaluru, India, February 8th, 2023 – Narayana Hrudayalaya Limited, a leading healthcare provider in India, announced its financial results for the third quarter (Q3 FY23) ended December 31st, 2022.

Financial Highlights for the Quarter (Q3 FY23) - Prepared in accordance with Ind AS ('Indian Accounting Standards')

- Consolidated total operating income was Rs 11,282 mn for Q3 FY23 as compared to Rs 9,598 mn in the corresponding period of the previous year, reflecting an increase of 17.5% YoY and decline of 1.2% QoQ
- Consolidated EBITDA* stood at Rs 2,660 mn, reflecting a margin of 23.6% as against Rs 1,819 mn in Q3 FY22, translating into YoY growth of 46.3% and QoQ degrowth of 3.2% respectively
- Consolidated PAT* stood at Rs 1,539 mn, reflecting a margin of 13.6% as compared to Rs 975 mn in Q3 FY 22, translating into YoY growth of 57.7% and QoQ degrowth of 8.9% respectively

Financial Highlights for the Nine Months (9M FY23)

- Consolidated total operating income was Rs 33,032 mn for 9M FY23 as compared to Rs 27,606 mn in 9M FY 22
- Consolidated EBITDA* of Rs 7,408 mn for 9M FY23, reflecting a margin of 22.4% as against Rs 5,032 mn in 9M FY 22
- Consolidated PAT* stood at Rs 4,333 mn for 9M FY23, reflecting a margin of 13.1% as compared to Rs 2,732 mn in 9M FY 22

As on December 31st, 2022, the Total Borrowings less Cash & Bank Balance and Current Investments was Rs. 2,142 mn representing a net debt to equity ratio of 0.11. (Out of which, borrowings worth US\$ 33.3 mn is foreign currency denominated).

Other Highlights during the Quarter

- Rabindranath Tagore International Institute of Cardiac Sciences (RTIICS), Kolkata has successfully conducted Robotic Partial
 Nephrectomy on a patient with Single Kidney
- Mazumdar Shaw Medical Centre (MSMC), Bengaluru performed the highest number of Robotic Gynaecological Procedures for benign conditions and reached the milestone of 150 successful Complex Airway Reconstructions and touched about 1,500 patient base for complex aerodigestive anomalies & problems till date
- SRCC Children's Hospital, Mumbai achieved the highest quarterly volumes of 18 successful BMT procedures
- NH Mysore performed some cutting-edge & complex clinical procedures in the Interventional radiology and GI Sciences segments in the quarter such as
 - TIPS procedure performed in view of Budd Chiari Syndrome and Hyperthermic Intraperitoneal Chemotherapy procedure
 - Laparoscopic Heller Cardiomyotomy with Toupet Fundoplication performed for achalasia cardia

"Despite several holidays and festivals which affect patient footfall, the third quarter delivered steady performance supported by the growth in business across our flagship units, newer hospitals and improvement in payor mix. Our Cayman unit managed to contribute to the overall performance despite the holiday season and we remain optimistic on strong growth prospects of overseas business.

We continue to strengthen our current position and grow our brand through several strategic initiatives that will drive our vision to offer integrated healthcare services to people across our core geographies."
