In a standout performance, Meenal Chaube from Raipur recorded the largest win, defeating Congress candidate Deepti Dubey by over 150,000 votes.

Cong names new gen secys for 11 states, UTs

With an eye on the Punjab Assembly elections in 2027, the Congress has announced former Chhattisgarh chief minister Bhupesh Baghel as the new general secretary in-charge of the state.

the Congress has shown alacrity in its approach by picking Baghel for organising the state party machinery. Baghel has replaced Harish Chaudhary, who has been shifted to Madhya Pradesh.

Kashmir and Ladakh. He has replaced Bharat Singh Solanki as the AICC in-charge for J&K. Incidentally, a committee formed to ascertain the reasons for the party's poor showing had pointed an accusing finger at Solanki.

Baghel had earlier also played a crucial role in the party's win in the Himachal Pradesh Assembly election in 2022 where he was sent as a senior observer. The Congress had dislodged the BJP-led Jairam Thakur government from power in that closely fought election.

Having suffered setbacks in the subsequent elections in Haryana, Maharashtra and Delhi, the party has also removed some of the state in-charges. Baghel replaced Harish Chaudhary, who has been shifted to Madhya Pradesh.

The Congress has also appointed Rajya Sabha member and chief whip Rajani Patil as the in-charge for Himachal Pradesh and Chandigarh in place of Rajeev Shukla.

With just about two years to go for the Punjab elections, the party is now sensing an opportunity in Punjab and soon after AAP's loss in Delhi, the Leader of Opposition in Punjab Assembly and Congress leader Partap Singh Bajwa had claimed that 30 AAP MLAs were planning to switch over to the grand old party.

Similarly, Syed Naseer Hussain, a member of Rajya Sabha from Karnataka, has been named general secretary in-charge for Jammu &

Japan & Singapore to sign MoU in education & skills with Assam

Assam Chief Minister, Himanta Biswa Sarma on Saturday signalled towards a deeper association with Japan and Singapore as he announced three major developments during a press meet ahead of Advantage Assam 2.0 summit.

He said that two Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) will be signed with Japan and Singapore, to strengthen ties in education and skill development. "Talks are on to establish a Japan Language Testing Centre in Assam, while academic tie-ups with Singapore. A Japan Language Testing Centre will be set up in Assam," he added.

Kerala ragging: All 5 accused barred from further studies

The Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council (KNMC) Saturday decided to bar all five accused involved in the ragging incident at the Kottayam Nursing College from continuing their studies. A council meeting convened here observed that the accused did not deserve to complete their studies or enter the service profession.

Professor/Assistant Warden-in-Charge of the student hostel, Ajeesh P Mani, pending an inquiry for allegedly failing to prevent ragging and effectively intervene in the matter.

The hostel's housekeeper-cum-security staff was also ordered to be removed immediately, according to a statement issued by the Health Minister's office. The action was taken following an inquiry conducted by the Director of Medical Education, as per the instructions of Health Minister Veena George, the statement added.

A nursing council member described the Kottayam ragging incident as an "extremely cruel act" and said it cannot be justified under any circumstances. "We will never justify the incident. What we want to em-

phasise is that allowing such individuals into the nursing profession would be a disaster," said Usha Devi, a council member.

She said the Council would soon inform the concerned authorities of its decision to debar the accused students. "We made the decision in a way that leaves them no chance to continue their studies. Through the District Health Services (DHS), we will inform the government of our decision, which will also be conveyed to the college authorities," the Council member told a news agency. The state government has ordered an investigation into the incident, while the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) has sought a report from the state police within 10 days.
