Mbappe, Kane fail to impress

The top scorers in their respective leagues have failed to replicate their form in Euro 2020



Kylian Mbappé still to find form

Kylian Mbappé scored the most goals in France last season, and Harry Kane did likewise in the Premier League.

It's not just the fact that neither Paris Saint-Germain nor Tottenham won their leagues that links them. Nor the fact that both strikers are being talked about for transfers to new clubs after the European Championship.

Although prolific for their clubs, Mbappé with 27 league goals and Kane with 23, neither has managed to replicate their domestic scoring output at the European Championship.

Kane managed only one shot on target in the three games for England. Mbappé had three for France. But neither striker found the back of the net.

"I think it's the world of a big player," England coach Gareth Southgate said, discussing Kane. "Inevitably he's come through those periods and scored important goals for us and played exceptionally well. So it's a bit of a repetitive cycle."

Perhaps it's a reflection of the toll of more gruelling pandemic-congested seasons on players' bodies.

France is at least reaping the benefit of recalling Karim Benzema after six years in international exile. It was the Real Madrid forward scoring for France for the first time in 2,085 days, twice in fact, that secured a 2-2 draw against Portugal on Wednesday and passage into the round of 16.

"I knew as soon as I would be in the national team, the critics would come out, that is part of the football game

Through to round of 16

Euro 2020 is down to the knockout stage, with the 24 qualifiers now 16 as they are whittled down to the side that lifts the trophy on 11 July.

but I never give up," Benzema said.

"Everyone was waiting for this goal and that was some kind of extra motivation for me. Of course there is another pressure than when you play for your club because it is your whole country but for me it is a great pleasure."

At least it was Mbappé who earned a penalty for Benzema, which is a greater contribution than Kane has made as England also advanced as group winners.

Euro 2020, however, will be missing Europe's leading striker in the knockout phase. Three goals from Robert Lewandowski weren't enough to carry Poland through to the next round.

Brazil beat Colombia 2-1 in a tense Copa America match on Wednesday that featured three extraordinary goals.

Brazil pip Colombia

Colombia opened the scoring in the 10th minute after Juan Cuadrado crossed from the right and found Luis Diaz all alone in the middle of Brazil's penalty box. The striker shot a powerful volley to the right side of goalkeeper Weverton and scored possibly the best goal of the tournament.

Colombia then started defending against a Brazil team that barely stopped surrounding its penalty box. It appeared as if Colombia would be able to hold out, until Argentine referee Nestor Pitana's knee came into play.

Pitana accidentally blocked a pass by Neymar about 10 meters in front of the Colombian area in the 78th minute. Colombian defenders momentarily stopped, but Brazil substitute Lucas Paqueta just moved the ball to left-back Renan Lodi and his cross found Roberto Firmino, whose angled header beat Colombian goalkeeper David Ospina.

Busquets proves he is key to Spain

After helping Spain avoid elimination at the European Championship, Sergio Busquets had to pause for a moment while talking about his time away from the squad because of the coronavirus.

The Spain captain teared up recalling the doubts that went through his mind after being told he had to go into isolation only days before the tournament was to begin.

"I'm emotional because I had to go through some difficult times," Busquets said.

"I had to stay at home for 10 days, not knowing if I was going to be back or not."

Spain was glad Busquets did make it back, just in

ship and struggled with poor finishes and a shaky defense in the first two matches. The 32-year-old midfielder, the only member left from Spain's World Cup-winning squad in 2010, gave the team that much-needed balance it had been missing so far at Euro 2020.

Busquets was the first Spaniard to touch the ball when the match started at La Cartuja Stadium, and he was in control of the midfield from then on. Collected and composed as usual, Busquets showed no signs of being affected by his less-than-ideal preparations because of the virus. He constantly guided his teammates and helped create chances in attack and keep the defense protected.

Busquets, who was asymptomatic with the virus and could practice at home while in isolation, had been replaced in the first two matches by Rodri Hernández, who couldn't bring in the same attitude and leadership of the veteran Barcelona player.

Busquets took over as captain after Sergio Ramos was left off the squad after playing sparingly this season because of injuries. Jordi Alba had been the captain at Euro 2020 in Busquets' absence.

Busquets was loudly cheered by the home crowd when he was substituted by Thiago Alcántara in the 71st minute after feeling a little tightness in his calf, which he said shouldn't be a problem ahead of the round of 16.

"He played perfectly," said Spain coach Luis Enrique, who decided to wait for Busquets instead of dropping him from the squad despite not knowing if he would fully recover from the virus.



Finland have the monkey off their back

Finland were always likely to be Group B underdogs considering this was their first ever EURO. Three points from three games, not to mention a third-placed finish, represented a more than respectable showing, albeit not quite enough to reach the knockout stage.

They showed that Finland belonged at Euro, they most certainly did that. The team were defensively compact for much of their campaign and ensured a contest against each of their opponents.

Finland put in an admirably brave performance against Belgium in their final group fixture, eventually succumbing to a 2-0 defeat in St Petersburg. Though the team's qualification looked unlikely after that result, thousands of fans stayed behind after the final whistle to salute Markku Kanerva's squad.

Finland have the monkey off their back now, having had that first taste of major tournament football.

Oh no! Not again

Euro 2020 racking up own-goals at a wild pace

The own-goals at this year's European Championship are coming at a blistering, and record-breaking, pace.

Two own-goals scored Wednesday by Slovakia in Spain's 5-0 victory made it eight so far at Euro 2020. That's already five more than the tournament record of three set at Euro 2016.

The first Slovakian mishap came when goalkeeper Martin Dúbravka pushed a high rebound off the crossbar into his own net. Juraj Kucka then knocked in the final goal of the rout in Seville.

There previously had been only nine own-goals scored in 40 years from the 1976 tournament through Euro 2016. And before this year, there had never been a European Championship game with two own-goals. There have been two in the past week.

Portugal also scored two on Saturday, four minutes apart.

Defenders Rúben Dias and Raphaël Guerreiro gave Germany a 2-1 lead in a match the Germans ended up winning 4-2.

The scorers of all eight own-goals in the group stage ended up on the losing team, including Germany defender Mats Hummels in France's 1-0 victory. The list includes three goalkeepers who had varying degrees of luck. Poland goalkeeper Wojciech Szczęsny was unlucky that a Slovakian opponent's shot rebounded off the post and against the back of his arm to go in. Finland's Lukáš Hrádecký was a little clumsy reaching for a ball that bounced back off a post from Belgium defender Thomas Vermaelen's header.

Dúbravka's error Wednesday was harder to explain and came minutes after he dived to save a penalty from Álvaro Morata.

When Euro 2016 set the record five years ago it was the first 24-team edition of the tournament. The 51 games was an increase of 20 on the previous 16-team format.
