Europeans this period is 6000 years ago. Rice cultivation became widespread in China 6600 years ago. People started using milk from domestic animals in food. Genes capable of digesting milk proteins were added to the human genome 6600 years ago. Evolution began to separate humans from other animals through natural selection on a part called 'brain'. As a result, two hundred thousand years ago, the size, structure and biological processes of the brain changed. The virtues of intelligence, that is, cleverness and wisdom, were added to human beings. Is there a correlation between brain size and intelligence? Scientists are also divided on this question. Scientists have discovered two genes associated with brain size and intelligence? One of which is known as microcephalin. When a single copy of microcephalin is mutated, the brain is smaller than normal. The change in the human genome has occurred approximately 37,000 years ago. New changes are seen in the populations of Europe, the Middle East and the Americas. When it comes to brain development, it is said that 'slow and steady wins the race'. This race is the principle of natural selection. The gene change that separated the brain of Homosapiens from that of Ostelophth occurred about 2.5 million years ago. Since humans split from the nearest chimpanzee 5 million years ago, only about 30 genes have achieved the art of being automatically copied through natural selection, called gene duplication. Evolution is environment dependent. Climate change must have a direct impact on humans. To survive against this change, the genes of his body must also be changed. This is the basic concept of 'evolution'. And so it happens. Monkeys mainly eat fruits. Our ancestors also had a diet rich in fruits. A special color sighted eye is required to see bright red, yellow or red spots, which humans have acquired during evolution.

The human eye has distinguishing three colors. Most mammalian eyes have one cell capable of distinguishing only two colors. One cell is sensitive to blue color due to a special gene. This gene is located on chromosome-7. While the genes responsible for sensitivity to red and green color are located on the sex chromosome that differentiates humans as male and female. Humans have only one copy of the X chromosome. If there is a mutation in the gene for color, it becomes difficult to distinguish red or green color. It is called color blindness. Now assume that females have two copies of the X chromosome. What if the second copy of the color-sensing gene becomes active? A woman has the ability to distinguish the basic four colors. Due to which even a thin difference between adjacent colors can be distinguished easily. Such vision reveals 'Tetra Vision'. which
