GOVT SCHOOL PROGRAMME

Bridge course to 'ready' kids in Class 1



There are nearly 6.5 lakh students in Class I in nearly 33,000 government primary schools across the state. *Javed Raja*

THE STATE education department has launched a 'school readiness programme' for Class I students across all government schools in order to achieve good results in upper primary classes.

While the admission drive is under process which will continue till August 31, on an average, there are nearly 6.5 lakh students in Class I in nearly 33,000 government primary schools across the state.

Through a special curriculum framed for a three-week bridge course, which lays emphasis on what anganwadi centres misses out as the focus is more on health than education, the school readiness programme has been launched from this academic session that started in June.

The government has already conducted a test run in 100 government primary schools in districts of Naramada and Surat (city) with a mix of rural and urban students during academic session 2018-19.

Based on the test results and National Achievement Survey (NAS) framework, the curriculum for the programme has been framed by the Gujarat Council of Educational Research and Training (GCERT), the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), Quality Enhancement Cell of Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) and a non-government organisation Central Square Foundation (CSF).

"The concept of stressing on teaching and learning right from the first day a child comes to school in Class I should be done away with. Most of the times, a child in a government school comes without going to a pre-school or an anganwadi centre. We will be able to achieve desirable results in Class VIII only when the foundation is strong. So,

first we need to develop their motor skills and introduce them to language and mathematics in a fun way," said principal secretary, education, Vinod Rao.

In addition to the existing curriculum, government school teachers will include this programme at the first one hour for 21 days. Activity books have been prepared for both students and teachers.

Adding to the objective behind launching this programme, GCERT director T.S. Joshi said since the National Education Policy (NEP) also lays focus on the foundation learning, it has been on a mission mode in the state. "A similar framework is there since 1997, but its proper implementation was not done by the teachers. But the outcome of this 21-day programme will be evaluated at the end of the programme and academic session."

The outcome of the pilot study revealed that students were regular to school unlike previously where the rate of absenteeism among Class I students was high. Also, the feeling among students and their parents that they have to study and teachers will help them in that was strengthened.

"A strong sense of discipline and etiquette was observed among these students which otherwise was difficult to develop. Significant changes were noticed among them when teaching was made fun through games, rhymes, stories, theme-based conversation, drawings and activities," said Dharmesh Ramanuj, one of the curriculum committee members.

The state government has also approved the introduction of international assessment tools, Early Grade Reading Assessment (EGRA) and Early Grade Mathematics Assessment (EGMA) for Class I students. This is expected to help teachers in understanding students' capabilities and thus accordingly frame remedial teaching.

WHO CAST THE VOTE?

THE BY-ELECTION to two Rajya Sabha seats in Gujarat saw BJP candidates S Jaishankar and Jugal Thakor winning, as expected, and even scoring some non-BJP votes. Apart from 100 BJP MLAs, five non-BJP MLAs also voted for the BJP. However, Jaishankar (104) got one vote less than Jugal (105). This is because one vote for Jaishankar was invalidated on technical grounds, and speculations are rife that the invalid vote was that of senior cabinet minister and former Gujarat BJP chief, R C Fald. Though the BJP has been denying this adding that any of the five non-BJP votes could have been the invalid vote, nobody spoke in clear terms on whose vote was invalidated. Sources said the vote could indeed be that of Fald, and the BJP is not speaking on the subject to avoid causing embarrassment to one of its senior leaders. Even the Chief Electoral Officer's office responded with a "We don't know" when asked if the invalid vote was Fald's.

'KADAK' IMPLEMENTATION

The body language of Minister of State for Home, Pradeepsinh Jadeja, recently became a talking point in the Gujarat Assembly, when a Bill to ban e-cigarettes was in discussion. Introducing the Bill, Jadeja stated that the state government was committed to save the youth from the addiction of liquor and tobacco. Speaking on the Bill, Congress MLA from Bhiloda constituency Anil Joshiyara said the body language of Jadeja, while speaking in the Assembly, was very 'kadak' (firm), and he would like it if similarly, the implementation of the ban would also be 'kadak'. Joshiyara said the prohibition on liquor saw numerous violations in the state, and that even those who provide information on the bootleggers are being targeted by the latter. Jadeja is one of the ruling BJP's outspoken ministers in the Vijay Rupani government.

Cop arrested for 'selling' illegal weapon to accused in robbery bid

Ahmedabad: Police arrested a city-based constable for allegedly providing a revolver to a man accused of trying to rob a company in Ghatlodiya area of the city Saturday night.

The arrested constable has been identified as Gajendrasinh Vibhal, who was posted at the Ahmedabad police headquarters. He has been in service for 12 years.

Gajendrasinh allegedly sold a revolver to one Chirag Bhavsar who used the weapon to commit a robbery at India Infoline company in KK Nagar of Ghatlodiya. Bhavsar was apprehended by the company's security guards as he tried to break into the office. The constable procured the illegal weapon from Madhya Pradesh, police said.

"During interrogation,

Bhavsar revealed that he owed Rs 8 lakh in gambling and wanted to pay off his debts. He procured a weapon from Gajendrasinh for Rs 55,000 and then tried to loot the company. We picked Gajendrasinh from the headquarters on Sunday. He has been booked under appropriate sections of the Indian Penal Code and the Arms act," said a Ghatlodiya police officer. **ENS**

Two held for stealing from houses during Rath Yatra; booty worth Rs 3L recovered

THE LOCAL Crime Branch (LCB) of Ahmedabad arrested two persons and recovered cash and jewellery worth Rs 3 lakh, which they had allegedly stolen from houses in the old city during the recently

held Rath Yatra. According to investigating officers of the LCB, the duo was arrested around 2 pm on Sunday near Shah Alamo dargah in the city. The arrested have been identified as Rajni Fakir Sheikh and Shabbir Ali Hussain Sheikh, both natives of Ahmedabad. "They were travelling in a

Suzuki Access car and held during a patrol check near Shah Alamo dargah. We recovered jewellery worth Rs 1,74,480 and Rs 1,24,000 in cash. They revealed that they had broken into houses on July 4 during the occasion of Rath Yatra, using the loud environment as a cover-up," said a senior official of LCB.
