In Delhi, vehicles are worst offenders when it comes to pollution

AMONG LOCAL SOURCES, vehicles may have contributed the most to air pollution in Delhi over the week from October 21 to 26, according to an analysis by the Centre for Science and Environment (CSE).

Vehicles caused half or around 51% of the national capital's own contribution to PM2.5 levels from October 21 to 26, the analysis said. When contribution from other NCR districts and biomass burning to air pollution in Delhi is considered, vehicles contributed around 17% of the PM2.5 concentration.

The daily share of vehicular emissions ranged from around 49.3% to 53% over the week. This was followed by residential sources at 13%, industries at 11% and construction at 7%.

The CSE has drawn data from the Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology's Decision Support System (DSS) which provides information on the contribution of emissions from Delhi and surrounding 19 districts to air quality in Delhi. The DSS modelling uses an existing emissions inventory prepared by the Energy and Resources Institute. This inventory is being updated this year.

The overall share of "combustion sources" was also found to be higher than that contribution of construction and residential sources. The overall share of all combustion sources that include vehicles, peripheral industries, energy sector, waste burning and residential cooking among others, have contributed higher than the dust sources that include construction and road

dust. "The contribution of Delhi's own sources to pollution levels in the city was estimated to be around 32.9%, while the contribution from the NCR districts and biomass burning contributed around 4.5%."

The CSE analysis also used data from Google Maps to determine the traffic speed along 15 arterial roads in the city over the week. "High congestion was found on all roads," with the maximum congestion on GT Karnal Road and Guru Ravindras Marg, the analysis notes, explaining that the average speed was found to be 27 to 32 kmph on the roads analysed.

It further adds: "The working day before Diwali (October 21) and October 22 saw heavy congestion and average speed was observed at 23.7 and 23.8 kmph respectively. On Diwali day (October 24) and post-Diwali day, when overall traffic reduces normally, average speed on road was higher at 33 and 32 kmph respectively. Diwali day had the least traffic volume."

With vehicular emissions contributing to nitrogen dioxide levels, increased concentration of this gaseous pollutant was also found to coincide with the time that congestion is recorded on the roads, according to the analysis which used the Central Pollution Control Board's hourly data. NO2 levels peaked at 7 pm on October 22 and 26. The analysis makes a case for a "verifiable and measurable shift to public transport". It states: "Even though vehicles are the top polluters in Delhi, action to control their explosive numbers and usage have remained the slowest. Even the air emergency measures enforced for the very poor and severe categories of AQI under the GRAP do not include action, barring increased parking charges... the city also needs extensive networks of walking and cycling infrastructure to connect different neighbourhoods for functional usage at the local level."

"This is the week when AQI turned 'very poor' and the analysis is on what contributed to Delhi's air. The DSS doesn't look at freetracker emissions, which is a small-dairthing," said Anurita Roychowdhury, executive director, research and advocacy, CSE.

AS THE number of farm fires in Punjab saw a sharp spike on Wednesday, recording the season's highest single-day figure of 3,775, Union Minister Shubendra Yadav took to Twitter to slam the AAP Aamritsar party, which is in power in both Punjab and Delhi.

The fire count is up from 1,842 recorded on Tuesday, according to data from the Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI).

IARI data shows that Punjab has recorded 21,490 paddy residue burning events from September 15 onwards. This is

around 19% more than the figure of 18,000 recorded till November 2 last year, but lower than the figure of 37,756 recorded till November 2, 2021, and 22,720 recorded till November 2, 2019.

Till November 2, Haryana has recorded 2,249 incidents of stubble burning this year, lower than 3,241 recorded till November 2 last year.

The contribution of stubble burning to PM2.5 levels in Delhi on Wednesday was around 12%, going by data from the SAFAR forecasting system. Delhi recorded a 24-hour average AQI of 376, in the 'very poor' category, according to the Central Pollution Control Board's 4 pm bulletin. This is marginally better than the AQI of 424 recorded Tuesday, first

'severe' air day of the season. On Twitter, Yadav wrote: "Scrap this! As of Oct 26 Punjab a state run by the AAP government, has seen an over 19% rise in farm fires over 2021. Haryana has seen a 30.6% drop. Just today, Punjab saw 3,634 fires. There is no doubt over who has turned Delhi into a gas chamber. Wondering how?"

"Scam is where AAP is. In the last 5 years, the Central Government gave Rs 1,347 crore for crop residue management machines to Punjab, and 22,720 for crop residue management machines to Punjab. The state bought 1,20,000 machines, 11,275 of those machines have gone missing. Money utilisation shows record incompetence. Last year, Rs 212 crore were left unspent. This year, the Central

Govt gave Punjab Rs 280 crore for crop residue management machines. So, about Rs 400 crore was available but the state got chose to sit with the funds forcing helpless farmers to burn the crop residue," he wrote.

Responding to the Union Minister, Dr Gupta, advisor to the Delhi government, tweeted: "Sir, please don't cherry-pick data. Number of fire instances is not the correct way of measuring fires. The total area burnt on 27 Oct 2022 was 4 lakh hectares which is only 2.95 lakh hectares on 27 Oct 2021. This means a 35% decrease."

Punjab Chief Minister Bhupinder Singh Mann, earlier in the day, also said the BJP was "stooping low by indulging in pollution

politics". "I had three cities of Punjab being in 32 cities of north India with poor air quality index (AQI), but the BJP and Centre have unleashed a slanderous campaign against hard-working and responsible farmers of state by squarely blaming them for environmental hazards," Mann said in a video, adding that farmers of Punjab will not tolerate this.

Questioning the "the silence of BJP over far worse AQI" in Faridabad, Manesar, Gurgaon, Sonapat, Gwalior, Indore and other cities in other states where the party is in power, Mann said, "It is being projected that only Punjab and Delhi were causing pollution and rest all were like Switzerland."

BS III and IV vehicles may face heat if pollution doesn't abate

IF THE air quality and pollution level in the national capital continues to worsen, the Aam Aadmi Party government may impose a ban on all BS III and BS IV diesel and petrol vehicles to control vehicular pollution, said officials.

Of the BS III and BS IV cars running in Delhi, almost 60% are diesel vehicles and two lakh are petrol vehicles. In its latest order, the commission for air quality management (CAQM) has advised that Delhi and state governments in NCR may ban such vehicles.

As per rules, if such vehicles are found playing after the restrictions are imposed, they will be impounded and challaned Rs 20,000 by the enforcement wing.

Officials at the transport department said they have started planning to hire and register

parryvan buses to encourage the public to use private vehicles, including cars and bikes, at home and use public transport.

"We are waiting for the order from GNCTD. Once it comes, it will just take 2-3 days to hire and register the buses on the road. It's a transport official.

In an effort to control vehicle emissions, the Delhi transport department has held meetings with BS-IV and BS-VI owners to persuade them to use CNG-compliant fuel with buses routed to and via Delhi.

Transport minister Kailash Gahlot said Wednesday, "About 3,000-3,500 buses from the neighbouring states enter Delhi. Not only the transport commissioner, but I have also raised the matter several times during the interstate meetings and asked them not to send diesel vehicles and trucks to Delhi."

Last year, the plan was made to deploy 982 parryvan buses

and around 650 buses were deployed to the Delhi and NCR.

"Fare for travelling in these buses will remain similar to DTC and cluster fares. Woman passengers will get travelling services through pink passes," said the officials.

Environment Minister Gopal Rai Wednesday appealed to the residents of the capital to contribute to the fight against pollution. Speaking at a press conference, he suggested live strings to follow to battle pollution, including working from home.

He suggested that since construction is banned, people should report any such activity by sending photos and location on the Green Delhi App. He also asked citizens to carpool, work from home and not burn wood or charcoal and appealed to RWAs to provide electric heaters to senior citizens who are unable to afford to burn wood or coal to escape the cold.

5 Uzbek women go missing from shelter

New Delhi: Five of seven women Uzbek women, rescued from a sex trafficking racket by the Delhi Police in August, went missing from a shelter home in Dwarka last week. The Delhi Commission for Women has issued summons to the Delhi Police and the private NGO to find the women.

Police in Dwarka lodged a missing person report and are looking for the women while staff in New Delhi are looking for men involved in the racket.

According to police, the women were brought to India via Nepal and forced into sex work. In August, seven of them were rescued by the New Delhi District with the help of the Uzbekistan Embassy and a private NGO. The women were shifted to a temporary shelter home set up by the NGO in Dwarka.

An official at the NGO alleged, "We knew the women were in danger and had informed the local police several times over the phone. In September, we received a call from a man who threatened to kidnap them. We had again informed the police."

On October 28-29, five of the NGO senior officers in the New Delhi district said they had arrested 3 of the accused men and non-bailable warrants were issued against 2 others. "The women were not shifted to another NGO because they said they felt safe at the Dwarka one," claimed an officer.

Hemant Tiwal, Additional DCP (New Delhi) said they have received the summons and will abide by the directions of DCW.

In Dwarka, police said they are trying to find the women but none of the CCTVs around the shelter home is operational. ENS
