FM slams Congress over inflation during UPA govt

Discussion on 'White Paper' in Rajya Sabha

FINANCE MINISTER NIRMALA Sitharaman on Saturday took a dig at the Congress saying the grand old party mastered the art of ruling accomplishments of the previous government as they did while managing inflation during the 10-year UPA regime.

She said the Modi-led government toiled for 10 years to bring the economy back on track, taking India from 'Fragile Five' to 5th largest economy of the world.

Sitharaman said the inflation rate was below 4% in the last year of Atal Bihari Vajpayee government, but it remained significantly high during the 10-year UPA regime.

"Gur ko gobar karna inki mastery hai (Congress has mastery of ruining something that has been accomplished)," she said.

The finance minister attacked the Congress, saying its government did complete developments in time, but now Prime Minister Narendra Modi personally monitors progress of development projects, even with district-level officers.

Giving reasons for coming out with the White Paper now, Sitharaman said a similar exercise earlier would have im-

pacted the confidence of institutions, investors, as well as the people. As an elected government, she said it is imperative to inform the public and Parliament about the true picture of the economy during the UPA regime and efforts taken by the Modi government to revive the economy. In an apparent jibe at the erstwhile National Advisory Council headed by Sonia Gandhi, the finance minister said India needs a clean and accountable governance, and not

governance through extra-constitutional body. Congress fears people who could overshadow the 'first family', she said, citing names of great leaders like BR Ambedkar, Syama Prasad Mookerjee, and Karpooori Thakur. In her reply, she highlighted various measures taken by the Modi government to restore the economy back on track. She also said unemployment rate for graduates declined from 17.3% in 2017 to 13.4% in 2023.

'Every Indian invested in making nation developed'

PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA Modi on Saturday said today is the time for creating history with every person in the country resolving to make India a developed nation.

Speaking after inaugurating or laying foundation stones of 1.3 lakh houses under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) across Gujarat through video link, he also said that his government has succeeded in pulling 25 crore people out of poverty, and the biggest beneficiaries of its schemes are Dalits, OBCs and tribals.

"Today's time is the time of creating history," Modi said. During the Swadeshi and Quit India movements, freedom had become every person's goal, and the creation of Viksit Bharat (developed India) has become a similar resolution for the nation today, he said. "Today everyone, including children, wants India to become a developed nation in the next 25 years and every body is contributing to the effort," the Prime Minister added. "Look at the figure of 1.3 lakh houses. I have not seen such a large figure even when I conduct national-level programmes for giving houses under PMAY. I congratulate the Gujarat government. For any poor person, having his own house is a guarantee of better future," Modi said.

The biggest beneficiaries of the government's welfare



schemes for the poor have been Dalits, Other Backward Classes and tribal families, he said, adding that "if anyone benefited most from Modi's guarantee, it is these families". "The poor include every community. Benefits of welfare schemes are reaching everyone without discrimination. Modi has stood guarantee for those who had no guarantee," the prime minister further said.

Describing the youth, farmers, women and poor as the "four pillars of Viksit Bharat," he said their empowerment is his government's top commitment. The biggest achievement of his government was to bring 25 crore people out of poverty, Modi said. He congratulated all the families who received new houses at Saturday's function and wished them a bright future.

17th LS took very important decisions: Modi

PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA Modi on Saturday said the five years of the 17th Lok Sabha were a period of reform, perform and transform with the country moving towards "big changes" at a fast pace.

In his address in the Lok Sabha on the last day of the Budget session, Modi said that during the last five years, game-changing reforms were made in which a strong foundation of a 21st century India can be seen. "The country has moved towards big changes at a fast pace and all members of the House made an important contribution. Such works were completed for which people had waited for centuries," the Prime Minister said in the final session before the Lok Sabha polls.

For generations, people had dreamt of one Constitution but this House made that possible by removing Article 370, he said and noted that several important decisions were taken during the 17th Lok Sabha.

"Several challenges were met and the country was given an appropriate direction," Modi said. — PTI

Electoral bonds: BJP got ₹1.3k cr in 2022-23

THE RULING BJP received nearly ₹1,300 crore through electoral bonds in the 2022-23, which was seven times more than what the Congress got in the same period through the same route.

The BJP's total contributions stood at ₹2,120 crore in the 2022-23 fiscal, of which 61% came from electoral bonds, according to the party's annual audited report submitted to the Election Commission. In FY2021-22, the party's total contributions were to the tune of ₹1,775 crore. The party's total income in 2022-23 stood at ₹2,360.8 crore, up from ₹1,917 crore in FY2021-22.

The Congress, on the other hand, earned ₹171 crore from electoral bonds which was down from ₹236 crore in FY2021-22. The BJP and the Congress are recognised national parties. The Samajwadi Party, a recognised state party, had earned ₹3.2 crore through electoral bonds in 2021-22. In 2022-23, it received no contributions from these bonds. Another state recognised party, the TDP, earned ₹34 crore through electoral bonds in 2022-23 which was up 10 times from the previous fiscal.
