### Huntsman Announces Agreement to Sell Textile Effects Division

Ahmedabad, Huntsman Corporation (NYSE: HUN) today announced it has entered into a definitive agreement to sell its Textile Effects division to Archroma, a portfolio company of SK Capital Partners. The total enterprise value of the transaction is approximately \$718 million, which includes the assumption of approximately \$125 million in net underfunded pension liabilities as of December 31, 2021. The acquisition is being partially funded by preferred equity, of which Huntsman is taking up to \$80 million, an amount SK Capital Partners will seek to syndicate prior to the transaction. Over the last twelve months ending June 30, 2022, the Textile Effects division reported sales of \$772 million and adjusted EBITDA of \$94 million. Huntsman anticipates cash taxes on the transaction of approximately \$50 million. Huntsman intends to report Textile Effects as discontinued operations beginning in the third quarter of 2022. The transaction is subject to regulatory approvals and other customary closing conditions and is expected to close in the first half of 2023. (20-4)

Part-II: Other Notes  
 1. The above results were reviewed by the Audit committee and subsequently approved and taken on record by the Board of Directors of the company at its meeting held on Friday, 12/08/2022. The statutory auditor of the company has carried out limited review of the above financial results.  
 2. The company is having substantial interest in two associated partnership firms. The company doesn't prepare consolidated financial statements by applying equity method of accounting under Indian Accounting Standard (Ind-AS) -28 "Investments in Associates and Joint Ventures" as there is no operations in the said partnership firms during the period covered by the financial results, and no profit / loss is attributable to the company.  
 3. The company operates only in one segment i.e. Infrastructure and hence there is no other primary reportable segment as required by Indian Accounting Standard (Ind-AS) - 107 "Segment reporting".  
 4. The outbreak of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic globally and in India causing significant disturbance and slowdown of economic activity. The company is monitoring the impact of global health pandemic on its financial position and liquidity. The company used the principles of prudence in applying judgments, estimates and assumptions. The company has considered wherever applicable the possible effects on the carrying amounts of receivables, inventories, loans and other assets as on June 30, 2022. Based on current indicators of future economic conditions, the management expects to recover the carrying amount of these assets in full without any loss. However, the impact of COVID-19 on the Company's Financial Statements may differ over the period of time, from the estimated as of the date of approval of these financial statements. Management will continue to closely monitor any material changes to future economic conditions.  
 5. On October 8, 9 & 10, 2020, the company along with certain other group companies, firms and promoters, were subjected to Search and Survey operations by the Income Tax Department u/s 132/133 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 ("The Act"). During the course of Search / Survey proceedings, no unrecorded cash was found by Income-Tax Department. Certain documents of company were seized and the proceedings for the same are currently underway. The ultimate outcome of the matter is yet to be determined and the management of the Company along with their legal consultants, do not expect any material liability consequent to these proceedings. Hence no provision has been made in the financial results in respect of this matter. Previous Periods' Years figures have been re-grouped / re-classified wherever necessary to make it comparable with the current period.
