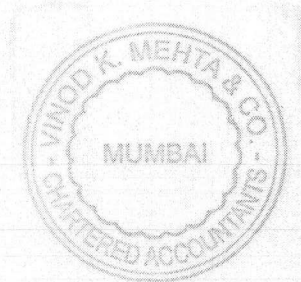
OTHER MATTER:
