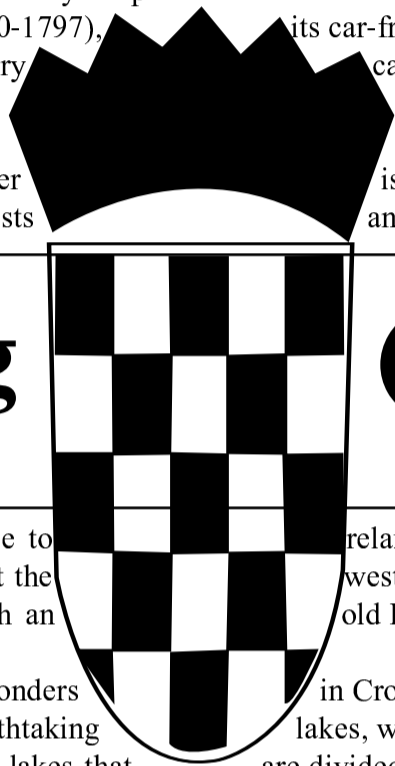
Tucked somewhere between eastern and western Europe, Croatia has something to offer every type of traveler. Its 3900-mile-long Adriatic coastline dotted with over 1200 islands and islets delights beach and sun lovers; its eight UNESCO World Heritage Sites amaze lovers of history; its eight national parks attract nature enthusiasts; and its many picturesque towns and cities full of Roman and Byzantine ruins, vestiges of Venetian times, and Austro-Hungarian buildings charm fans of art and architecture.

Dalmation Islands:

Many tourists visit Croatia to explore the blissful Dalmatian islands, of which the most fashionable is Hvar. Here, trendy Hvar Town is home to some of the country's top hotels and best seafood restaurants. Dating back to the years spent under Venetian-rule (1420-1797), its car-free old town is made up of a spacious main square overlooked by a 16th-century cathedral, a pretty fishing harbor, and a hilltop fortress.

Mljet:

The island of Mljet is one of the larger islands off the coast of Southern Croatia. With 72% of the island covered by forests and the rest dotted by fields, vineyards

and small villages, Mljet is a perfect place to relax. The island contains two salt lakes, Veliko and Malo Jezero, that are located at the western end of the island. In the middle of Veliko Jezero, there is a small island with an old Benedictine monastery.

One of the most beautiful natural wonders in Croatia and all of Europe, the Plitvice National Park consists of several breathtaking lakes, waterfalls and lush forest. The park's most notable features are the 16 interconnecting lakes that are divided into upper and lower clusters. Formed by natural travertine dams, the lakes range in distinct colors from turquoise to blue, green and gray.

Diocletian's Palace:

The Diocletian's Palace forms the ancient city of Split, a Croatian harbor city. The Palace was named UNESCO world cultural heritage and was built from 295 till 305 AD. The Palace is rectangular and surrounded by walls. Today the Diocletian mausoleum, the Jupiter Temple, the pillars and the gateway are highlights of the building. Numerous museums and galleries inside the Palace make history become alive and show how everything has looked in the past and what functions the Temple had.

Dal lake declared eco-sensitive zone

Srinagar, Nov 14: The Jammu and Kashmir government has set up a ten-member committee to declare Srinagar's famous Dal Lake and its surrounding areas as an eco-sensitive zone (ESZ), following concerns over its shrinking size. Pollution and encroachments have resulted in the Dal Lake shrinking from its original area of 22 square kilometers to about 10 square kilometers, according to an assessment by the Dredging Corporation of India (DCI) in 2017.

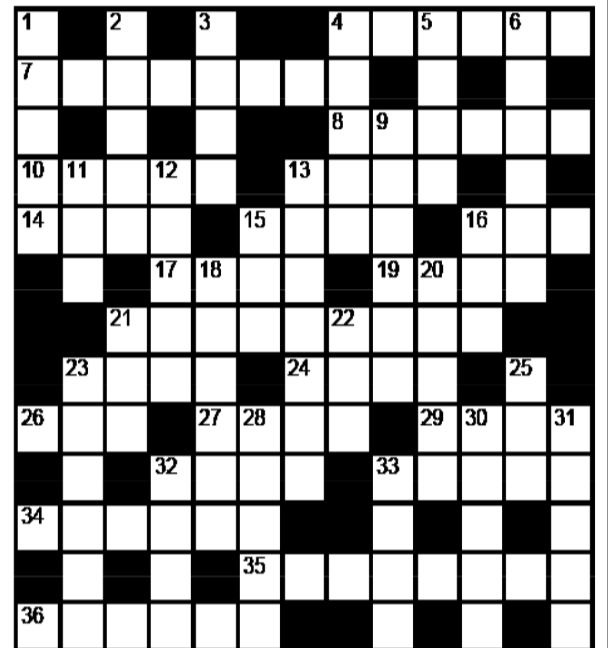
The DCI also found that the world-famous lake's capacity has shrunk to about 40 per cent and that its water quality has deteriorated. "Sanction is hereby accorded to the constitution of a 10-member committee to finalise the draft of the notification for declaring Dal Lake and its surrounding areas as eco-sensitive zone," Additional Secretary of General Administrative

Department (GAD) Subash Chibber said. The committee shall finalize the draft notification within a period of one month, he said, adding that all facilities and infrastructure to the committee shall be provided by the Housing and Urban Development Department. The DCI assessment also found that intense pollution by untreated sewage and solid wastes that flow into the lake, encroachments of water channels and clogging has diminished the circulation and inflows into the lake, leading to extensive growth of the weed water hyacinth which has emerged as a health hazard. Further, it established that the depth of the lake has reduced at many places due to siltation and encroachment, and that continuing night soil discharge from the 800 to 900 houseboats causes extreme pollution in the water body.

San Francisco: Dressed in pilot's cap, toe nails painted in bright red, little LiLou, a cute little pig is all set to greet you with a hoof at the gates of San Francisco airport and guide you till your take off.

Pigs might not fly, but LiLou the therapy pig wants to make air travel less stressful.

The five-year-old Juliana pig and her owner, Tatyana Danilova, are part of San Francisco International Airport's "Wag Brigade" - a program that brings therapy animals to the airport to cheer passengers up and help ease travel anxieties.

LiLou breezes through the metal detector at airport security and trots to the departure gates. She raises a hoof in greeting, poses for selfies and entertains departing

work," said Danilova. "Everybody is usually very happy and it makes them pause for a second and smile and be like, 'oh, it's great.'"

When she's not delighting passengers at the airport, LiLou lives with Danilova in her downtown San Francisco apartment, where she

enjoys a diet of organic vegetables and protein pellets, sleeps in her own bed and goes for daily walks around the neighborhood.

Danilova says LiLou loves interacting with people, but, as a prey animal, doesn't like having anyone approach her from behind.

At the airport, eight-year-old Katie Schroeder, from San Ramon, California, squealed in delight as LiLou bashed out a tune on her piano, using her hooves and snout.

"I've never seen a pig in the airport. She can do tricks like a dog," she said.
