Third wave is imminent if rush at markets swells unchecked

The rush to the markets continued to swell unabated and, if it continues, it seems that a third wave of corona cannot be stopped and the government will have to face the brunt of such an occurrence very soon.

The administration attributed the rush to congested roads which are only of 10 ft breadth in the Old City. But it is also true that the people, too, looked careless. They tossed all Covid protocols to the winds—maintaining social distancing and hand hygiene and wearing masks.

Such places as Ibrahimpura, Lakherapura, Budhwara, Jumerati and Goddha Nakkas are the main markets in the Old City, where thok kirana markets are operated. But there is no control by any monitoring agency on the rush. If this continues, a third wave cannot be stopped.

On the first day, the crowds were much more controlled and police teams were deployed at many sensitive points, but, on the second day of unlock, the rush was heavy and there was no monitoring agency constituted or assigned to keep a close vigil on the markets. No policeman was seen in the markets to control the crowds swelling all around. This shows the carelessness







'THIS TIME, WE'RE MORE ALERT'

'There may be an overall rush in the markets, but at individual shops, we maintained strict Covid protocols. We've instructed the traders to follow all Covid norms and guidelines—maintaining social distancing and wearing masks. This time around, we're more alert in this regard. The rush may also be because of unlock after 50 days; people who were staying locked up in their homes have now moved out in the

If cases don't increase in a week, markets will reopen

BHOPAL: The administration may give some relaxations for reopening markets in the next week in Bhopal, Indore and in a few other cities in the state. The corona curfew was partially lifted on June 1, but the collectors of different districts have set different timings for reopening markets. At a few places, the markets were allowed to open till 3 pm. At a few other places, markets were allowed to remain open till

late in the evening. In such districts as Damoh and Morena, markets were partially reopened. In Bhopal, shops selling essential items have been allowed to reopen. Similarly, in Indore, only grocery shops were permitted to reopen.

It is because of confusion over reopening of markets that some traders are mounting pressure on the people's representatives to allow them to restart their businesses.

According to sources, several BJP leaders have held discussions with Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan about the reopening of markets. Chouhan has reportedly assured those leaders that, if there is no increase in the number of cases in a week, some more relaxations may be given in corona curfew. He also assured the BJP leaders that, if the cases do not shoot up, all markets would reopened after June 15.

The protest by traders over alleged discrimination in opening of shops during the graded unlock in the state capital continued on the second consecutive day on Wednesday. On the first day of unlock, the traders had protested at Bairagarh and Old City for not being allowed to open their shops.

The Kapada Vyapari Sangh called on DME minister Vishwas Sarang, who is minister-in-charge of the district for Covid affairs on Wednesday to register their protest against discrimination in opening of shops during the graded unlock. DME minister Sarang requested them to wait for three to four days more for permission to open their

shops. The textile traders expressed their disappointment to the DME minister, stating that 'roti, kapda aur makan' were the basic needs of the people. The graded unlock had benefited 'roti' (grocery) and 'makan' (construction businesses), but 'kapda' shops had still not opened.

'MINISTER ASSURED US'

'We called on minister Vishwas Sarang, who requested us to wait for four or five days more. Our consignments have already been dispatched from Gujarat, but we haven't received them. Still, they're demanding money. How can we pay them when our shops haven't been opened? The entire wedding season has been nonproductive for us. Even Eid passed, but our shops weren't opened. Three to four members of the staff work in our shops—how can we pay them, either? So, our entire business is ruined because of the lockdown. Now, those shops which were already open have been opened officially during the unlock. We told the minister that roti, kapda aur makan were important. Shops of roti and makan have been opened, but kapda shops are still closed, so it's not justice'

HONEY TRAP PEN DRIVE ISSUE

SIT returns empty-handed from former CM's house

A special investigation team probing into a 'honey trap' case on Wednesday went to the house of former chief minister Kamal Nath to collect the 'pen drive' related to the case but it had to return empty-handed. Reason? Nath was not out of station.

While addressing the online press conference on May 21, Nath claimed that was in possession of a pen drive/CD related to the honey trap case. His claim had kicked up the dust in

the political corridors as well as in the police department, which is investigating the case.

The SIT was quick to send a notice to Nath under relevant provisions of CrPC said asking him to hand over the pen drive/CD to its sleuths.

The notice stated that this 'pen drive/CD was extremely important evidence' in the FIR lodged in Palasia police station and it would make the probe more effective and stronger. The notice added that Nath should be present in his house in Bhopal at 12:30 pm on June 2 for recording his statement and handing over the pen drive/CD to the SIT.

Sources claimed that when the team reached the ex-CM's house, Nath's counsel informed the SIT
