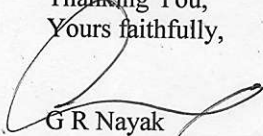

"THE ED officials believe that this may have been done through hawala channels. Besides, their line of investigation is where the accused got the money from and whether they are involved in money laundering," the source said.

The central agency is said to be particularly interested in Viren Khanna, as currency of different countries were found during a raid on his house by the CCB. Further, it is said that accused Rahul Thonse, who is a close contact of actress Sanjjanaa Galrani, runs a casino in Colombo, Sri Lanka. Several male stars from Kannada film industry had reportedly attended events at the casino. Besides, some of the accused allegedly have links with those arrested in the recent Kerala gold smuggling case too. "The ED is most likely to start probe into the money-laundering angle soon," the source added.

Meanwhile, actresses Ragini Duvvuri and Sanjjanaa Galrani, who have been arrested in the drugs case, were taken to KC General Hospital after they complained of health issues. After treatment, they were again questioned by the police. Ragini's police custody ends on Friday and the police may not seek further extension of her custody. The actress has moved a bail petition in court and it may come up for hearing on Friday.

BSY OFF TO TEST DELINEX NEXT WEEK

Yediyurappa to discuss cabinet expansion; Induction of ministers likely in October, or before session starts

KARNATAKA Chief Minister B S Yediyurappa is scheduled to head to New Delhi on September 18, a day after the 'in-auspicious' amavasya on September 17, and before the legislative session begins on September 21.

The agenda is clearly cabinet expansion. Yediyurappa told the media after his meeting with deputy commissioners, that he would visit New Delhi shortly. "I have sought time to meet the Central leadership to discuss cabinet expansion and various other issues. I will visit New Delhi in four or five days, once they give me an appointment," he said. There is speculation about the other issues on hand, especially as Yediyurappa is visiting New Delhi for a face-to-face meeting.

Source said there are a few more issues. On expansion of the cabinet, Yediyurappa needs to consult the central leadership on the candidates and portfolios. The other issue is flood aid, with the government requesting around Rs 8,000 crore, though the State is likely to get 10 per cent or less of this sum. Yediyurappa could be seeking more funds, considering that last year's flood damage still needs to be addressed.

The third issue is said to be the Covid situation. With cases continuing to gallop, Karnataka needs to set up oxygen plants and other infrastructure, for which funds are necessary. While some sources suggested that cabinet expansion will not take place till October, as the legislative session ends on September 30, others said it may take place much earlier. It is being said that some legislators have threatened not to attend the session if they are not inducted into the ministry, and have communicated this to Yediyurappa.

The Chief Minister is expected to meet BJP President J P Nadda, Home Minister Amit Shah, who is out of hospital, and General Secretary B. L. Santosh, besides the three Union ministers from Karnataka, D V Sridharan and Pralhad Joshi and Suresh Angadi.

It may be recalled that many ministers and leaders from the state had already visited Delhi and met the central leadership on the issue of cabinet expansion.

Previous govts turned a blind eye to drug menace, says CM

REITERATING that no one will be spared in the ongoing crackdown on drugs in Karnataka, Chief Minister B S Yediyurappa on Thursday said the previous governments had failed to curb the menace.

Speaking to reporters after his video conference with the District Commissioners, Yediyurappa said irrespective of connections and families, nobody involved in the racket will be spared. "For more than a decade, this (drug racket) was going on but the previous governments had turned a blind eye towards it. This time we are getting it investigated thoroughly," Yediyurappa told reporters in Bengaluru. The CM was asked a question about the alleged involvement of film actors, children of politicians and realtors in the ongoing case. Yediyurappa said such a detailed investigation into the drug mafia was being carried out for the first time in the country. "The investigation has exposed many people and the government will initiate appropriate action against the accused persons," he added. Earlier in the day his cabinet colleague and Tourism Minister C T Ravi raised questions against former Chief Minister Siddaramaiah. "By stating that the #Drug mafia operated in the past, former CM Sri @siddaramah has accepted his failure to take on Drug Peddlers. What stopped Sri Siddaramaiah in acting tough against this network in the same way that CM @BSYBJP is doing now? (SIC) CT Ravi had tweeted.

ED attaches Appugol's assets worth ₹31.3 cr under PMLA

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has attached immovable assets and bank accounts worth Rs 31.35 crore of Kannada film producer Anand Appugol. Appugol is the Chairman of Krantiveer Sangolli Rayanna Cooperative Society and booked under multi-crore fraud case.

He had produced Darshan Thoogudeepa starring "Krantiveer Sangolli Rayanna". The ED attaches to their official twitter account to confirm the attachment of the assets and various bank accounts of Appugol and his associates in the society under PMLA (Prevention of Money Laundering Act).

Withdrawal of criminal cases against BJP leaders condemned

THE decision of the state government led by B S Yediyurappa of dropping serious criminal cases against ministers, BJP MPs and MLAs is illegal, said former Congress MLA A R Lobo.

Addressing a press conference on Thursday at the Congress office, Lobo said that over 62 criminal cases have been withdrawn despite opposition from the directorate of prosecution and police department. "The cabinet has decided to drop the serious charges against BJP leaders including Chief Minister B S Yediyurappa, MP

Pratap Simha, ministers C T Ravi, B C Patil and CM's political secretary Renukacharya. The state law minister has justified the withdrawal of cases that it was to reduce the burden on courts and public interest.

There should be a fair probe by the High Court and Supreme Court. He added that nobody should be above the law and the Supreme Court should immediately bring a stay order on the same. "We had withdrawn cases against the commissioners and not of our party members. Dropping serious criminal cases, the BJP leaders are protecting themselves," he added.
