BJP to follow no-repeat policy in deciding names for top posts in local bodies: Paatil

EXPRESS NEWS SERVICE VADODRA, SEPTEMBER 5

GUJARAT BJP president CR Paatil on Tuesday said that the party has decided to adhere to its "no-repeat" policy while deciding names for the top posts of the local bodies, which are due to see a mid-term change of guard at the completion of the first half of the five-year tenure on September 8.

Speaking to media persons in Gandhinagar, Paatil said that in "an attempt to make the process transparent", BJP was keen on giving a chance and training to new leaders, as the party holds 90.5 per cent of seats in the local bodies.

"The Gujarat BJP has initiated a process to hand over responsibility to around 1,500 leaders. The BJP has been following the tradition of 'no-repeat' for a long time and posts held by members for the last few years. We will follow the same for the posts of mainly mayor, deputy mayor, standing committee chairperson, ruling party leader, district panchayat president, vice-presidents and members of the executive. This will ensure that maximum new persons get a chance to serve and also gain (administrative) experience," Paatil said.

He added that with 90.5 per cent of the seats in its kitty in the state's local bodies, BJP has also held an exercise to seek recommendations from local leaders about the upcoming nomination.

"... new people should get the opportunity and they are trained in the process too... So, we have taken this decision... The BJP is a party of its workers. The party workers have the right to put forth their ideas. Therefore, the BJP held an exercise in each district for every seat, we sent a three-member team, including a woman, to hear the members of the local units, including the elected representatives. The names (for the posts) that were recommended by the leaders were discussed and they were called in to meet the CM," said Paatil.

In view of the recent incidents of some BJP leaders making allegations against rivals within the party, Paatil said that the party would "verify" any accusation against any leader being considered for the top posts.

MURDER OF 7-YEAR-OLD GIRL HC acquies man sentenced for life, asks state to frame rules on preparing discovery panchama

THE GUJARAT High Court, while acquiescing a man sentenced to life imprisonment for the murder of a seven-year-old girl in 2012, directed the state authorities on Tuesday to prepare guidelines and circulate the same among its police officers on how discovery panchamas are to be prepared in consonance with two Supreme Court judgments of 2022.

The HC noted that the deposition of the complainant - the deceased girl's sister - did not inspire confidence and the deposition of two crucial child witnesses did not corroborate with other prosecution witnesses' statements. It added that none of the witnesses had seen the incident occur and the IO's evidence was deficient in several aspects, including drawing of the discovery panchama.

The HC observed, "In my opinion, the outcome of the serious offence of murder of seven-year-old girl could have been altered, if the investigation was carried out in a proper manner and the prosecution was vigilant enough to establish the guilt."

Accused Kapilkumar Mandali, who was also charged for rape, along with sections 302 (murder), 201 (destruction of evidence) and 364 (abduction) of the Indian Penal Code, was convicted for the latter three offences in 2014 by a sessions court in Vadodra.

Mandali, who had filed the alleged incident, was arrested from Bihar over three weeks later, following which he had revealed the location of the child's body, leading to the discovery of her remains 26 days after the alleged murder.

The HC added that the state government should frame rules for the preparation of discovery panchama before the trial court, adding that such guidelines shall be framed within four weeks.

The HC also directed the register commutation in the order to all listed the discovery of the body (bones and hair) of the victim from a secluded place. The remains were found after 26 days from a place, which is not accessible by people," it added.
