Sunset ride: Ropeway operator booked in Gujarat

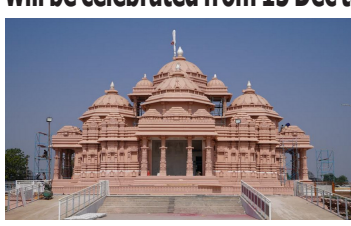


RAJKOT: The forest department has filed an offence against Usha Breco Ltd, the company operating the Girnar ropeway service in the Junagadh district.

Morbi collapse: No safety clause in contract on bridge maintenance

MORBI: The 15-year contract the Oreva Group signed with Morbi municipality for the upkeep of the suspension bridge didn't have a word about its safety.

The details were part of submissions made by the defence in the court of the chief judicial magistrate, which upheld them and rejected on Saturday the prosecution's plea for further remand of two Oreva managers, Deepak Parekh and Dinesh Dave.

There are a total of 1,346 booths in Junagadh district. The voter turnout in the district has remained average in the past two assembly elections.
