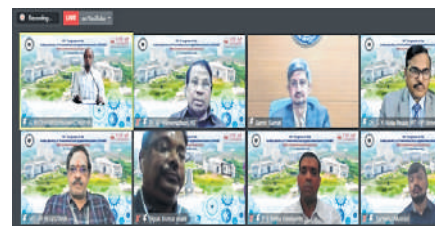
## Senior Citizen helpline 14567 extending helping hands to elderly in UT

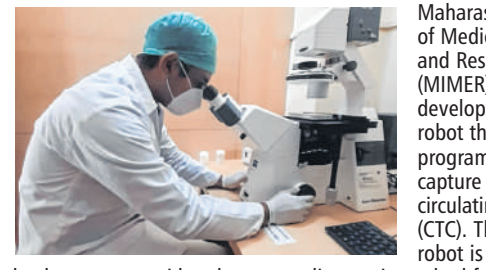
## Central Railway celebrates International Day of Persons with Disabilities
