## Mamata flags question in CAPF test

West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Thursday raised strong objection to reports of a question asked at the CAPF (Central Armed Police Force) recruitment examination on "poll violence in West Bengal", and accused the BJP of using Central forces to serve its political interests.

"I was shocked to see that politically motivated questions were asked in an exam conducted by the UPSC. It shows how the BJP has politicised the Central forces to serve its political interests," she said.

The Chief Minister went on to allege that the CAPF was used to "capture booths and kill people at Sitalkuchi in Cooch Behar during the Assembly poll in West Bengal".

"This is too much and completely unacceptable. What is the message the Union government is trying to send out?... That if you want to work in the Central forces, you have to be a yes man of BJP and believe whatever canards they are spreading," Ms. Banerjee asked.

# Union Ministers demand action against Opposition MPs

They complain to Rajya Sabha Chairman over violation of House rules

A day after the monsoon session of Parliament was adjourned amid scenes of chaos over the pushing through of the General Insurance Bill, senior Ministers in the Union government on Thursday demanded that Rajya Sabha Chairman M. Venkaiah Naidu initiate strong action against Opposition MPs who, they said, violated rules on the floor of the House.

Parliamentary Affairs Minister Pralhad Joshi, Leader of the House in the Rajya Sabha Piyush Goyal, Information and Broadcasting Minister Anurag Thakur, Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan, Labour Minister Bhupendra Yadav and others addressed a joint press conference, castigating the Opposition for what they termed obstructionist behaviour and alleged manhandling of the marshals.

"The Opposition's approach of 'my way or highway' is extremely condemnable," said Mr. Goyal, adding that the group of Ministers met Mr. Naidu and Deputy Chairman of the House Harivansh, and made an earnest appeal that the strongest possible action be taken against the Opposition MPs for deplorable behaviour and manhandling of the marshals.

Mr. Thakur said "the Secretary-General's table in the Rajya Sabha is not meant for dancing and protesting", referring to an incident when an Opposition leader was seen atop a table inside the Upper House.

"We demand that Rajya Sabha Chairman should take stringent action against those Opposition MPs who

broke rules," Mr. Joshi said, alleging that it was "pre-decided by the Congress and its friendly allies" that they would not allow Parliament to function.

Mr. Thakur alleged that "anarchy from streets to Parliament" was the Opposition's only agenda during the monsoon session.

He said the Opposition should apologise to the nation for what happened in Parliament.

A group of Opposition leaders also met Mr. Naidu and complained against the alleged heckling of MPs, including women members. Earlier on Wednesday, Mr.

Naidu broke down over the huge ruckus in the House, and equated the act of some Opposition MPs to "sacrilege in the temple of democracy". The monsoon session was later cut short by two days.

Leaders of several Opposition parties on Thursday held a rally in protest against the government on several issues, including Pegasus snooping, farm laws, and alleged manhandling of their MPs in the Rajya Sabha, with Congress leader Rahul Gandhi saying the voice of people was crushed in Parliament and democracy was "murdered".

## 'Modi must emulate Manmohan, Gowda'

O'Brien cites ex-PMs' vote in House

Two former Prime Ministers Manmohan Singh and H.D. Deve Gowda came to vote on the Constitution Amendment Bill, popularly referred to as OBC Bill, in the Rajya Sabha, while Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Home Minister Amit Shah were "absconding", the Trinamool Congress said on Thursday.

At a press conference a day after the General Insurance Bill was passed by the Rajya Sabha amid a scuffle between members and the marshals deployed in the House, party leader Derek O'Brien said the Opposition had no choice but to protest vociferously.

"What option did the Opposition have in a parliamentary democracy where the government crosses all limits? Do we still sit on our seats and suck lollipops? They must remember that

we represent more than 60% of the people of India. The BJP had got 37% of vote in the 2019 election and the remaining people voted for the Opposition parties," Mr. O'Brien said.

The entire Opposition wanted a debate on the internal security, but Mr. Modi and Mr. Shah were missing, he said. Mr. Modi has only made one appearance each in both Houses at the beginning of the session to introduce his expanded Cabinet.

Mr. O'Brien said both Mr. Modi and Mr. Shah should learn parliamentary etiquette from the former Prime Ministers. "Why has the Prime Minister of India not answered a single question on the floor of Parliament for the last four to five years. Don't ask us why we disrupted Parliament. It is you who disrupted Parliament with your boorish behaviour," he added.

# New Union Ministers to tour 212 LS constituencies

BJP's Jan Ashirwad Yatra to underline inclusive Cabinet

Newly sworn-in Ministers in the Narendra Modi government and those elevated to Cabinet status will be covering 212 Lok Sabha constituencies and travel over 19,567 km in what is being termed as a "Jan Ashirwad" (People's Blessing) Yatra to be organised by the BJP from August 16.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi was unable to introduce his Council of Ministers to Parliament at the start of the monsoon session as is customary because of the Opposition's protests on the Pegasus snooping scandal and the three contentious farm laws. At that time, Mr. Modi had decried the fact that his newly inducted Ministers, who hailed majorly from marginalised communities, were not being given

the usual courtesies by the Opposition.

Soon after that, the BJP decided that a "Jan Ashirwad Yatra" to "introduce" these Ministers directly to the people would be undertaken. According to party sources, a schedule has been drawn up for each Minister and the area he or she will have to cover.

"For example, in western

Uttar Pradesh seats, we will have B.L. Verma, S.P. Singh Baghel, in Kanpur, Bhanu Pratap Verma, and in Awadh, Ajay Mishra and Kaushal Kishore. The Kashi area will have NDA ally Anupriya Patel, Gorakhpur will have a yatra by Pankaj Choudhary," a source said.

The idea is to create a buzz around the fact that the new Council of Ministers has 27 Ministers from the Other Backward Classes, 12 belonging to the Scheduled Caste category, eight from tribal communities and 11 women, and that these Ministers were not accorded even the usual courtesies by the Opposition.

The party hopes that with the Assembly polls in Uttar Pradesh, the Ministerial appointments and identity issues will get a boost in public perception.

# Opposition anti-people and anti-development, says Goyal

Minister says govt. bringing laws for the good of the nation

Leader of the House in the Rajya Sabha Piyush Goyal on Thursday called the Opposition's charges about Wednesday's Parliament proceedings "a bunch of lies", and said the latter had behaved like violent hooligans in India's "temple of democracy" in a bid to block the insurance amendment Bill's passage.

Blaming the "arrogance" of some Opposition leaders who had showed "their mindset in Parliament over the past few days", Mr. Goyal said their obstructive approach to legislative business was just driven by the need to "try and prove a point and make the session a washout".

The Minister was addressing the national conclave of

the Confederation of Indian Industry on Thursday afternoon.

"If Parliament is not allowed to function, if our temple of democracy is converted into a platform for hooliganism and violence, I think it is a big blot and a shame for people who have used our temple of democracy to play out very petty politics and a mindset which is anti-progress, anti-development and anti-people," said the Minister in charge of Commerce and Industry, Textiles, Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution.

Stating that the government was pushing through laws for "the good of the nation and people at large", Mr. Goyal said the changes introduced in the session would help children, small

enterprises and bank depositors in troubled banks such as PMC Bank. "The biggest issue that they (Opposition) were literally fighting for, was to block a Bill which would have given our insurance companies power to serve the people better," he said.

"We saw such unsavoury instances being played out in Parliament. And to top it off, the bunch of lies that were played out today on television. Really, one feels ashamed how a very poor leadership over the past many decades, largely revolving around a few people and their families, has actually killed Indian enterprise and Indian animal spirits," Mr. Goyal said, adding he does not know how the mindset of such 'negative thinking' politicians can be changed.

# Twitter blocks Cong. official handles, leaders' accounts

Last week, it removed a tweet and blocked Rahul's account

A war of words erupted between Twitter India and the Congress on Thursday after the social media platform blocked the party's official handle and the accounts of several senior leaders. It also blocked the party's Tamil Nadu, Rajasthan, Gujarat and Maharashtra handles, besides that of the Mumbai Regional Congress Committee and the Daman & Diu Congress Committee.

The move comes just days after Twitter blocked former Congress president Rahul Gandhi for posting a photograph of the parents of a nine-year-old girl who was allegedly raped and murdered in Delhi.

In defiance, party general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra changed her display picture to Mr. Gandhi's, while others like Youth Congress chief B.V. Srinivas changed both his display picture as well the name of his handle to Rahul Gandhi.

By Thursday evening, prominent leaders whose handles had been suspended by Twitter for violating its policy included Randeep

Surjewala, K.C. Venugopal, Ajay Maken, Sushmita Dev, Bhanwar Jitendra Singh and Lok Sabha member Manickam Tagore among others.

All these leaders' as well as the Congress's handle had shared the same photograph in solidarity with Mr. Gandhi.

Breaking his silence on the Twitter episode, Mr. Gandhi said on Instagram, "If fighting for justice for murder and rape victim is a crime, then I am guilty. They can lock us out on a platform but they can't lock our voice for the sake of the people."

Last week, Twitter removed Mr. Gandhi's tweet along with the photo, as sharing of photos of a victim or her relatives is barred under the Indian Law.

However, the Congress targeted Twitter for adopting "double standards",

since functionaries of the National Commission for Scheduled Castes (NCSC) had shared similar photos with the parents of the victims but no action was taken against them.

Ms. Vadra said on Twitter, "Is Twitter following its own policy for the suspension of Congress leaders' accounts or the Modi government's? Why hadn't it locked the account of SC commission that had tweeted similar photos before any of our leaders did? By locking Congress leaders' accounts en masse, Twitter is blatantly colluding with the stifling of democracy by the BJP government in India."

Replying to a query on the development, a Twitter spokesperson said the "Twitter Rules" were enforced judiciously and impartially for everyone on its service.

# Sonia to talk to top Oppn. leaders

After the virtual interaction on Aug. 20, a physical meet is likely in Sept.

Congress president Sonia Gandhi will hold a virtual interaction on August 20 with top Opposition leaders like West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee, Maharashtra Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray and Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin among others, a senior Congress leader said on Thursday.

Other invitees include NCP chief Sharad Pawar, Jharkhand Chief Minister Hemant Soren, CPI general secretary D. Raja and CPI (M) general secretary Sitaram Yechury.

Though the agenda is not known, the senior leader said Ms. Gandhi wanted to keep the momentum going in terms of Opposition unity, and the virtual meeting was likely to be followed by a physical meeting in September, either as a dinner or a lunch get-together. The meeting is a signal that the

Congress is keen to be a rallying point for the Opposition parties in the run-up to the 2024 Lok Sabha polls.

## Sibal's dinner meeting

Her virtual interaction with Opposition leaders comes in the wake of a dinner hosted by senior Congress leader Kapil Sibal, one of the Congress's group of 23 dissenters who had asked Ms. Gandhi for reforms within the Congress.

Though Mr. Sibal's dinner on August 9 was meant to celebrate his 73rd birthday, an impressive line-up of heavy weights gave it distinct political flavour. Among the leaders who attended it were Mr. Pawar, Rashtriya Janata Dal patriarch Lalu Yadav, Samajwadi Party's Akhilesh Yadav, Mr. Yechury, Mr. D. Raja, Omar Abdullah of the National Conference, Sanjay Raut of the Shiv Sena, Pinaki Misra of the Biju Janata Dal, Derek O'Brien of the Trinamool Congress, Tiruchi Siva of the DMK and Naresh Gujral of Akali Dal.

In political circles, Mr. Sibal's dinner was being interpreted as a challenge to the leadership of the Gandhis, as at least two members were reported to have been critical of the Congress leadership.

The Congress president's interaction with the Opposition heavyweights would add to the party's efforts to keep the Opposition flock together.

# Kargil leaders to fight for Article 370 in SC

Three top leaders from Ladakh's Kargil district, who challenged the Central government's August 5, 2019 move in the Supreme Court earlier this week, on Thursday said the leadership of the region had decided "to launch a legal battle against the dilution of Article 370 and express desire to see the

pre-August 5 position". Sajad Kargili, one of the petitioners, said the Kargil Democratic Alliance, a grouping of regional parties and local seminaries, had always held that the 2019 decisions were "illegal and unconstitutional".

"The Kargil leadership has now decided to start a legal fight in the Supreme Court, as a false narrative is being woven that the people

of Ladakh are happy with the status of Union Territory (UT). We are hopeful the court will do justice. We desire for the pre-August 5 position," Mr. Kargili told *The Hindu*.

KDA leaders, during a meeting with Union Minister of Home G Kishan Reddy on July 1 last, conveyed the stand on the revocation of special provisions of Article 370 and 35A. "
