

Mehbooba's daughter can meet her, rules SC

AGENCIES New Delhi Asking the government to spell the objection it had in letting a daughter meet her mother, the Supreme Court on Thursday allowed the daughter of former Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Mehbooba Mufti to meet her. A bench headed by Chief Justice of India (CJI) Ranjan Gogoi allowed Iltija Javed to visit Srinagar, provided she first takes permission from the district authorities concerned on the issue of moving freely in the city. She can meet Mehbooba Mufti in private on a date of her choice, it said. Attorney General K.K. Venugopal and Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, appearing for the Centre, had opposed the plea, saying that she must approach the District Magistrate first. The bench said that it is her privilege

to move this forum. "What is the objection in her going to meet her mother?" it asked. Iltija Javed, who is presently in Chennai, had claimed that her mother is under detention ever since the abrogation of Article 370 which granted special status to Jammu and Kashmir. She said that she was deeply concerned about her mother's health as she has been under detention for nearly a month now. She told the court that she was not allowed to move around in Srinagar and meet her mother in private. The government had said if she approached the District Magistrate, she would be allowed to visit Mehbooba Mufti.



The court also asked the Centre's counsel that will they be standing in the way of a woman who wants to meet her mother, to which counsel said 'no'. The counsel told the court that when she was in Srinagar last time, she was neither allowed to meet her mother nor move out of her house. In her plea, filed through advocate Aakarsh Kamra, Iltija, 32, requested the top court to grant her permission to meet her mother in private for at least an hour every day in fulfilment of her right under Articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution, as she is extremely worried the health and well-being of her mother and apprehends a serious risk to her life. She claimed that she is not affiliated to any political party and said that she wants to take care of her family and other affairs without any restrictions on her movements.

SC directs to shift Tarigami to AIIMS

NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Thursday ordered to shift ailing CPI-M leader Mohammed Yousuf Tarigami, who is under detention in Jammu and Kashmir, to the All India Institute of Medical Science (AIIMS) here, saying that his health is top priority. A bench headed by Chief Justice Ranjan Gogoi also sought the Centre's response on a plea filed by CPI-M General Secretary Sitaram Yechury challenging the detention of Tarigami. Yechury's counsel and senior advocate Raju Ramachandran told the court that during his recent visit to Srinagar, Yechury had found that Tarigami's movement has been restricted and his security vehicles have been withdrawn. Ramachandran stressed to pursue the habeas corpus petition filed in this regard. Yechury on Monday filed an affidavit in the Supreme Court after his visit to the Valley to meet his detained party colleague Tarigami. —Agencies

In Tihar, with rape accused as inmates

Just before he left for Jail No 17, the former finance minister had a parting shot at the government. "I'm only worried about the economy," he said, in a quick aside with reporters amid the confusion over which agency will transport him. It was a sequel to his "5 per cent" dig at the GDP growth rate earlier this week. Earlier in the day, senior advocate Kapil Sibal appearing for Chidambaram pleaded before an apex court bench, headed by Justice R Banumathi, "I am begging of you. Please don't do this. Protect my client till you hear this case. He shouldn't be sent to Tihar". He also pleaded that his client was at an advanced age of 74 "Put him under house arrest or give interim bail", Sibal argued. Solicitor General Tushar Mehta sought his judicial custody on the ground that he was a powerful public person and he could definitely influence or hamper the probe. Sibal, in turn, argued, "There is nothing against him. There is no charge-sheet. If I am a powerful person and I can influence witness, they should bring some evidence of at least an attempt at tampering with evidence or trying to influence witnesses." "Potential of, likely to, apprehension of, can't be the reasons for me going to the judicial custody," he added. "It is basically humiliation. There must be proof which has to be given," Sibal said. Mehta replied "So far as the ED case is concerned, the Supreme Court has accepted the possibility of tampering." Earlier in the day, another special CBI judge O P Saini in the Rouse Avenue Courts had granted bail to Chidambaram and his son Karti, saying allegation by CBI and ED against them in the Aircel-Maxis case were "not grave" as money laundered is only Rs 1.13 crore, which was too small compared to the charge levelled against former minister Murasoli Maran.
