#### **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

## Pursuant to Sections 102 and 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 ("Act")

#### Item No. 1:

The Board has passed a resolution on February 22, 2024 to approve under Section 62 and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended, and the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018, as amended (the "SEBI ICDR Regulations"), the issue of equity shares of the Company of face value of ₹ 1/- each (the "Equity Shares") for an aggregate amount not exceeding ₹ 12600 Million (Rupees Twelve Thousand Six Hundred Million only) to eligible Qualified Institutional Buyers ("QIBs") under Chapter VI of the SEBI ICDR Regulations and Section 42 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with Rule 14 of the Companies (Prospectus and Allotment of Securities) Rules, 2014, each, as amended.

The proposed issue of capital is subject to the approvals under applicable regulations issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI)/ the Stock Exchanges and any other government / regulatory approvals as may be required in this regard.

The issue/allotment of Equity Shares may be consummated in one or more tranches at such time or times and at such price, whether at a discount or premium to market price and on such terms and conditions as the Board (hereinafter referred to as the "**Board**" which term shall deemed to include any Committee(s) constituted/to be constituted by the Board) may in its absolute discretion decide, taking into consideration prevailing market conditions and other relevant factors and wherever necessary in consultation with advisors, lead managers and such other authority or authorities as may be necessary and subject to, as applicable, the SEBI ICDR Regulations, and other applicable guidelines, notifications, rules and regulations, each as amended.

The Board in accordance with applicable law and in consultation with lead managers, may offer a discount of not more than 5% or such percentage as permitted under applicable law on the floor price determined pursuant to the SEBI ICDR Regulations (i.e. not less than the average of the weekly high and low of the closing prices of the equity shares quoted on the stock exchange during the two weeks preceding the 'Relevant Date' (as defined below). For this purpose, 'stock exchange' shall refer to any of the stock exchanges where the Equity Shares are listed and in which the highest trading volume in the Equity Shares has been recorded during the two weeks immediately preceding the Relevant Date).

The 'Relevant Date', in case of allotment of Equity Shares will be the date when the Board decides to open the QIP for subscription.

The Net Proceeds from the issue of Equity Shares would be utilized towards meeting funding requirements and growth objectives of the Company including to augment the capital base of the Company for meeting funding requirements of its business activities, inter-alia for debt reduction, onward lending in accordance with the Reserve Bank of India's Master Direction – Reserve Bank of India (Non-Banking Financial Company – Scale Based Regulation) Directions, 2023 (erstwhile, Master Direction - Non-Banking Financial Company - Systemically Important Non-Deposit taking Company and Deposit taking Company (Reserve Bank) Directions, 2016), and any other provisions of applicable law, to improve and maintain the enhanced regulatory capital requirements in line with the growth objectives of our business and for other general corporate purposes, in such a manner and proportion as may be decided by the Board from time to time, in accordance with the applicable laws.
