tra's population was 95 million. He added the electoral roll had 97 million voters. "The constituencies where they added [voters] are BJP's...they were added wherever the BJP won." Gandhi said more voters than the adult population of Maharashtra was not a speculation. "These are facts. This is not our data. This is the ECI's data...there are factual anomalies...90% strike rate [for the BJP]...The ECI is the final authority. We are asking them. You would not be able to explain how there are more voters in Maharashtra than the adult population of the state," Gandhi said.

Gandhi asked for the electoral roll with complete addresses to explain it. "If they give us that, we will have another press-conference where the answers to the questions [they raised] will be given...My concern is that the strategy is to delay and destroy. The ECI needs to give data...The next step is that we go to the judicial system...This is a small piece of the puzzle. The big piece of the puzzle is voter deletion."

Gandhi said they do not know how many voters were deleted and where. "We know how many have been added. We do not know how many have been deleted. We suspect the number of deleted is more than the number added."

The ECI responded to Gandhi's comments saying it values views, suggestions, and questions. "ECI considers political parties, as priority stakeholders, of course the voters being the prime & deeply values views, suggestions, and questions coming from political parties. Commission would respond in writing with full factual & procedural matrix uniformly adopted across the country," said the ECI.

Maharashtra chief minister Devendra Fadnis rejected Gandhi's charges saying the ECI has categorically replied to all the questions. "Gandhi is doing a cover fire as he knows that after the February 8 election results, his party will be nowhere in Delhi," he accused Gandhi of creating a new narrative. "If he does not introspect

and continue to console himself with lies, his party's revival is impossible. Rahul Gandhi should introspect his defeat."

Gandhi this week also raised the issue in Lok Sabha during the debate on the President's speech. He flagged anomalies and sought data from the ECI.

B'DESH EX-PREMIER

Thousands of protesters trying to disrupt Hasina's address had demolished and set fire to the home of Mujibur Rahman, her father and Bangladesh's founding leader. The violence continued after Hasina spoke.

Bangladesh's foreign ministry handed over a protest note to India's acting high commissioner in Dhaka, conveying "deep concern, disappointment and serious reservation" over her comments, it said on its Facebook page.

"The ministry...requested...India to immediately take appropriate measures, in the spirit of mutual respect and understanding, to stop her from making such false, fabricated and incendiary statements," it said.

Hasina could not be contacted for comment.

Although India did not comment on the communication from Bangladesh, external affairs ministry spokesperson Ranjiv Jaiswal condemned the destruction of Rahman's home as an "act of vandalism".

"All those who value the freedom struggle that nurtured Bangla identity and pride are aware of the importance of this residence for the national consciousness of Bangladesh," he said.

Local media linked the protest to an online speech by former Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina. Social media posts had earlier called for a "Bulldozer Procession" towards Sheikh Mujibur Rahman's residence located at Dharmochi-32 if Sheikh Hasina delivered a speech, as reported by Dhaka Tribune.

By 10:45 pm (local time), an excavator had been brought to demolish the house. Protesters, who arrived in a rally around 8 PM, forced their way in, breaking into the main gate before proceeding to vandalise the property.

HOTTEST JAN EVER AS LA NINA FAILS TO MODERATE TEMPS

NEW DELHI: Global temperatures shattered records again in the first month of this year as January became the warmest ever recorded, marking an unprecedented 18th month out of the last 19 that were above a critical climate threshold despite cooling La Nina conditions that typically moderate global heat.

January's average surface air temperature reached 13.2°C, scoring 1.75°C above pre-industrial levels, according to data released on Thursday by the European Union's Copernicus Climate Change Service.

The reading breaches the 1.5°C threshold of warning that scientists warn could trigger catastrophic climate impacts if sustained.

Samantha Burgess, strategic lead for climate at the European Centre for Medium-Range Weather Forecasts, described January 2025 as "another surprising month, continuing the record temperatures observed throughout the last two years, despite the development of La Nina conditions in the tropical Pacific and their temporary cooling effect on global temperatures."

The twelve-month period from February 2024 to January 2025 averaged 0.73°C above the 1991-2020 average and 1.67°C above the estimated 1850-1900 pre-industrial levels, intensifying concerns about meeting Paris Agreement targets aimed at limiting global temperature rise.

Regional temperature patterns revealed stark variations across the globe.

While northeast and northwest Canada, Alaska, Siberia, southern South America, Africa, much of Australia, and Antarctica experienced above-average temperatures, significant below-average readings were recorded in the United States, easternmost Russia (including Chukotka and Kamchatka), the Arabian Peninsula, and mainland Southeast Asia.

Experts said the trend could continue. "The La Nina is not strong enough to impact temperatures globally."

Int'l gadget theft racket busted in Rohtas, 271 iPhones recovered

SASARAM: Rohtas police busted an international racket involved in the theft of costly electronic gadgets and arrested five of its members during a raid near the NHAI toll plaza on NH-19 (GT Road) near Shivagrad in Rohtas district on Friday.

The thieves—four from Jaunpur in Uttar Pradesh and one from Kishanganj—were travelling in a car carrying 271 iPhones, 11 Apple Watches, and 30 ear buds stolen from a warehouse in Vijayvada, Andhra Pradesh, Rohtas superintendent of police (SP) Ranshan Kumar said.

The sensational theft had become a matter of prestige for AP police after it came in cognisance of their chief minister and the DGP of the state was himself

monitoring the case. He thanked Rohtas police after the arrests and recovery, the SP said.

The arrested thieves had taken a route through Odisha, Jharkhand, Bihar, and Uttar Pradesh before entering Nepal to deliver the stolen gadgets, whose recovery would be nearly impossible as Indian IMEI numbers cannot be tracked in foreign countries, the SP said.

He added that it was a high-profile racket with members spread across India and neighbouring countries.

The gang had access to GPS locations of warehouses storing costly electronic gadgets and operated in multiple layers including reconnaissance, theft, transportation, and delivery. They also had contacts to evade police and intelligence surveillance.
