ASHA, Anganwadi, other scheme workers to go on 2-day strike

A joint platform of scheme workers under programmes like Anganwadi, ASHA, and national health mission on Thursday gave a call for a two-day nationwide strike from Friday to press for better service conditions and benefits. The platform affiliated to ten central trade unions will also join 'Jail Bharo Satyagraha' call, a statement said. "The unions and federations of scheme workers (anganwadi, ASHA, Mid-Day Meal, NHM, Samagra Sikksha etc) affiliated to the central trade unions (INTUC, AITUC, HMS, CITU, AIUTUC, TUCC, SEWA, AICCTU, LPP, UTUC) will go on two days strike on August 7-8, 2020," the joint statement by ten central trade unions said.

Scheme workers, who are among frontline workers in the fight against COVID-19, are forced to take this step after four months of the outbreak of the pandemic and the lockdown because none of the minimum requirements for them - safety, insurance

and risk allowance- is provided by the government, the unions charged.

Many of the workers have died due to coronavirus during this period and even their monthly wages are not paid for months together, the unions claimed. They asked the government to clear all pending dues of wages and allowances etc of all scheme workers immediately. The unions said that strikes and struggles are going on in different parts of the country.

In Bihar, ASHA (Accredited Social Health Activist) workers went on strike from Thursday. In some states and areas where the Covid-19 situation is very bad, scheme workers will work wearing black badges.

They will join the Satyagraha/jailbharo called by the central trade unions on August 9, 2020, Quit India Day, with the slogan of 'Save India Day' (keeping physical distance and all norms by WHO), the statement said. The unions are

demanding safety gear for all frontline workers, especially ASHA and anganwadi workers and those in the health sector who are engaged in containment areas and red zones. They are also seeking frequent, random and free coronavirus tests of all frontline workers.

They also demanded a Rs 50 lakh insurance cover to all frontline workers covering all deaths on duty and Pension/jobs for the dependants of the workers and also coverage of treatment for Covid-19 for the entire family. A minimum compensation of Rs 10 lakh be given for those who got infected while on duty, the unions demanded. Additional Covid Risk Allowance of Rs 10,000 per month should be provided for all the contract and scheme workers engaged in Covid-19 duty, especially ASHA and anganwadi workers and workers in NHM, they added.

The unions are also pressing for including scheme workers in the category of

Court rejects Indrani Mukerjea's bail plea in Sheena Bora murder case

Mumbai : A special CBI court here rejected the bail plea of Indrani Mukerjea, the prime accused in the Sheena Bora murder case, noting that the possibility of the accused influencing prosecution witnesses cannot be ruled out. After failing to secure bail multiple times on medical grounds, Mukerjea in December last year filed another plea, seeking bail on "merits" of the case.

Special CBI court judge JC Jagdale rejected the plea on Wednesday. The court observed that some important case witnesses like Rahul Mukerjea, son of accused Peter Mukerjea, and Vidhi, daughter of Indrani Mukerjea and her former husband and co-accused Sanjeev Khanna, were yet to be examined. "There is no doubt that the accused is an influential and wealthy person. Therefore, the possibility of influencing

prosecution witnesses cannot be ruled out," the judge said.

While arguing for bail, Indrani Mukerjea told court that the prosecution's case was "false and baseless" and she had nearly 120 documents to prove it. She submitted that there is no scientific evidence to prove that the crime happened. She pointed out inconsistencies in the evidence put forth by the prosecution to prove her role as a conspirator and one of the killers of her daughter Sheena Bora. She also raised doubt about the "credibility and legality" of the probe. Indrani Mukerjea claimed there are numerous contradictions in the testimonies of prosecution witnesses, including accused-turned-approver Shyamwar Rai.

"They have either contradicted their own statements, or the statements of the other witnesses, or the prosecutions

story itself," she had submitted.

However, the judge in his order observed that in the middle of trial, the court cannot declare that the part evidence is either wholly reliable, or partly reliable, or totally unreliable.

"At the present juncture, the court cannot conclude that the evidence led by Shyamwar Rai (approver) has falsified or suffered from fatal infirmities due to cross-examination of the said witness," the court noted. The judge further observed that at this stage, the trial court cannot pass a final conclusion about the evidentiary value of the witnesses. "In my opinion, the accused and the advocate concerned should cooperate with the trial court to finish the said trial," the judge added. Indrani Mukerjea is currently lodged at the Byculia women's jail in Mumbai.

Delhi govt begins trial of e-ticketing system in buses to prevent spread of Covid-19

New Delhi : Two military generals of China have said that China needs to have a relook at its relationship with the United States. Dai Xu and Qiao Liang spoke to different publications in which they admitted that China is no match for the US based on the current balance of power.

They also said that the only way forward for China is peace, not war. General Dai said that traditionally, China and the US had a very close trade relationship, but the Trump administration has now branded the country a trade terrorist and a global economic aggressor.

Among them is the United States' ruthless push towards portraying China in a negative light which is beyond the expectations of most Chinese officials. He also said that

China has not received support from any country.

General Dai then went on to say that the US has been united at the domestic front. He also said that China needs to understand that China is not a paper tiger, but a real tiger that kills people.

Suggesting the way forward, the military general said that China doesn't need to make a loud announcement to be number 1. General Dai said that even if China knows it can beat the US, it needs to keep a low profile. He also said that China should consider the US as world's number 1.

Major General Qiao, meanwhile, kept his focus on China's relationship with Taiwan. He said that China "should not consider the coronavirus pandemic as an opportunity to take back Taiwan by force". He said that the risk is too high for China. The military commander said that Taiwan can be used by the US and its western allies to impose sanctions on China. This will stop Beijing from importing resources needed for its industry.

India's first Kisan Rail between Maharashtra, Bihar to start from Friday

The first Kisan Rail, introduced by the Ministry of Railways for providing a seamless supply chain of perishable produce, will start from Devlali in Maharashtra's Nashik at 11 am on

Friday for Danapur Bihar's capital Patna. The announcement regarding the "Kisan Rail" was made in the current year's Budget. Union Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar will launch the train via video-conferencing tomorrow.

The train, which will run on a weekly basis with an initial composition of 10 + 1 VPs will reach Danapur at 6:45 pm on the next day after covering the journey of 1,519 kilometres in over 31 hours.

Bhusawal division of Central Railway is primarily an agro-based division.

The train will take stops at Nasik Road, Manmad, Jalgaon, Bhusaval, Burhanpur, Khandwa, Itarsi, Jabalpur, Satna, Katni, Manikpur, Prayagraj Chheoki, Pt. Deendayal Upadhyay Nagar and Buxar.

According to Railway, Nasik and the surrounding region produces a huge quantity of fresh vegetables, fruits, flowers, other perishables, onions, and other agro products. These perishables are mainly transported to areas around Patna, Allahabad, Katni, and Satna.
