The dividend warrants, upon approval of final dividend by the shareholders at the 67th Annual General meeting, will be posted by 24th August 2021. In case of shareholders opting for NECS/NACH, the dividend would be credited to their accounts by 24th August 2021.

It may be recalled that an Interim Dividend at Rs.1.50/- per equity share was declared by the Board at its meeting held on 2nd February 2021 and paid on 26th February 2021. With this recommendation, the total dividend for the year ended 31st March 2021 aggregates to Rs. 3.00/- (Rupees three only).

Please note that meeting of the Board of Directors of the Company commenced at 12.36 p.m. and concluded at 03.20 p.m.

Notes:

- 1 The above results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their respective meetings held on April 28, 2021.
- 2 The Board of Directors have recommended a final dividend of Rs.1.50 per share (on face value Re.1 per share). An interim dividend of Rs.1.50 per share was declared at the meeting of the Board of Directors held on February 02, 2021 and the same has been paid.
- 3 During the current quarter, the Company has allotted 125,513 equity shares pursuant to exercise of Employee Stock Options.
- 4 The step down subsidiary M/s.Foskor Zirconia Pty Limited, South Africa [FZL] has incurred a loss of Rs.1051 Lakhs for the year ended March 31, 2021.

 Out of this Rs.536 Lakhs has been considered in the Group consolidated financials, being share of the Parent. The Board of FZL is monitoring the business performance and will initiate suitable measures in due course.
- 5 Exceptional item (net) comprise of Rs.2492 Lakhs towards fair value changes of a Financial instrument availed by a step down subsidiary and is net of Profit of Rs.1370 Lakhs on divestment of partial stake investments in an Associate to comply with the Minimum Public shareholding requirement under the SEBI provisions.
- 6 In July 2020, the Company's wholly owned step down subsidiary, M/s. Thukela Refractories Isithebe Pty Limited, South Africa (TRI), (subsidiary of M/s. CUMI International Limited, Cyprus) ceased to be a step down subsidiary of the Company consequent to the approval of its voluntary de-registration by the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC), South Africa.
- 7 Impact of COVID 19 Pandemic
 - The Covid 19 pandemic is unprecedented and measures to contain it has caused significant disturbances and slow down of economic activity. The Company's operations & financial results for the first quarter have been adversely impacted due to scaling down / suspension of operations across all plants due to supply chain constraints, shortage of workforce and various safety measures taken across all areas of operations.

 The operations were resumed gradually and has revived at a better page as the year progressed. The Company has relied on the available information.

The Company has relied on the available information and assumptions, as at the date of approval of these financial results, to arrive at its estimates. The Company continues to monitor the economic effects of the pandemic while taking steps to improve its execution efficiencies and the financial outcome.

- 5 The step down subsidiary M/s.Foskor Zirconia Pty Limited, South Africa [FZL] has incurred a loss of Rs.1051 Lakhs for the year ended March 31, 2021. Out of this Rs.536 Lakhs has been considered in the Group consolidated financials, being share of the Parent. The Board of FZL is monitoring the business performance and will initiate suitable measures in due course.
- 6 Exceptional item (net) comprise of Rs.2492 Lakhs towards fair value changes of a Financial instrument availed by a step down subsidiary and is net of Profit of Rs.1052 Lakhs on divestment of partial stake investments in an Associate, to comply with the Minimum Public shareholding requirement under the SEBI provisions.
- 7 In July 2020, the Company's wholly owned step down subsidiary, M/s. Thukela Refractories Isithebe Pty Limited, South Africa (TRI), (subsidiary of M/s. We draw your attention to the following paragraph on "Material Uncertainty related to Going concern" paragraph included in the audit report on the financial statements of Foskor Zirconia (Pty) Limited which is a subsidiary of CUMI International Limited, a subsidiary of the Parent, issued by an independent firm of Accountants based out of South Africa vide its report dated April 23, 2021 reproduced by us as under:

"We draw attention to the condensed income statement, which indicates that Foskor Zirconia (Pty) Ltd incurred a net loss of R 23 229 837 for the year ended 31 March 2021. As of that date, the liabilities of the company exceeded its total assets by R 112 036 230. The company is experiencing significant operating cash flow constraints and is considering various options. These options include sourcing of vendor finance, possible business rescue, possible sale of the business and voluntary liquidation. No firm decision has been taken in this regard. The company has also entered into discussions to convert certain accounts payable balances amounting to R 68 000 000 to a term loan to improve liquidity. The ultimate outcome of these discussions are unknown at this stage. These events or conditions indicate that a material uncertainty exists that may cast significant doubt on Foskor Zirconia (Pty) Ltd's ability to continue as a going concern. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter"

The Parent's Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of these consolidated financial results that give a true and fair view of the total comprehensive income (comprising profit and other comprehensive income) and other financial information of the Group including its Associate and Joint Ventures and the consolidated balance sheet and the consolidated cash flow statement in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Act read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations. The respective Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group and of its Associate and Joint Ventures are responsible for maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Group and its Associate and Joint Ventures and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the consolidated financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatements, whether due to fraud or error, which have been used for the purpose of preparation of the consolidated financial results by the Directors of the Parent, as aforesaid.
- 6. In preparing the consolidated financial results, the respective Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group and of its Associate and Joint Ventures are responsible for assessing the ability of the Group and its Associate and Joint Ventures to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the respective Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the Group and its Associate and Joint Ventures or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.
- 7. The respective Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group and of its Associate and Joint Ventures are responsible for overseeing the financial reporting process of the Group and of its Associate and Joint Ventures.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Consolidated Financial Results

- 8. Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the consolidated financial results as a whole are free from material misstatements, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with SAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these consolidated financial results.
- 9. As part of an audit in accordance with SAs, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:
 - Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the consolidated financial results, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide the basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.



- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances. Under Section 143(3)(i) of the Act, we are also responsible for expressing our opinion on whether the company has adequate internal financial controls with reference to financial statements in place and the operating effectiveness of such controls. (Refer paragraph 16 below)
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the Board of Directors.
- Conclude on the appropriateness of the Board of Directors use of the going concern basis of accounting and, based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the ability of the Group and its Associate and Joint Ventures to continue as a going concern. If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the consolidated financial results or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Group and its Associate and Joint Ventures to cease to continue as a going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the consolidated financial results, including the disclosures, and whether the consolidated financial results represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.
- Obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence regarding the financial results/ financial information of the entities within the Group and its Associate and Joint Ventures to express an opinion on the consolidated financial results. We are responsible for the direction, supervision and performance of the audit of financial results / information of such entities included in the consolidated financial results of which we are the independent auditors. For the other entities included in the consolidated financial results, which have been audited by other auditors, such other auditors remain responsible for the direction, supervision and performance of the audits carried out by them. We remain solely responsible for our audit opinion.
- 10. We communicate with those charged with governance of the Parent and such other entities included in the consolidated financial results of which we are the independent auditors regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit. We also provide those charged with governance with a statement that we have complied with relevant ethical requirements regarding independence, and to communicate with them all relationships and other matters that may reasonably be thought to bear on our independence, and where applicable, related safeguards.
- 11. We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular issued by the SEBI under Regulation 33(8) of the Listing Regulations, as amended, to the extent applicable.



Other Matters

- 12. We did not audit the financial statements/financial information of ten subsidiaries included in the consolidated financial results, whose financial statements/financial information reflect total assets of Rs. 150,700 lakhs and net assets of Rs. 121,151 lakhs as at March 31, 2021, total revenues of Rs. 119,288 lakhs, total comprehensive income (comprising profit and other comprehensive income) of Rs. 23,093 lakhs and cash flows (net) of Rs. 8,333 lakhs for the year ended March 31, 2021, as considered in the consolidated financial results. The consolidated financial results also include the Group's share of total comprehensive income (comprising profit and other comprehensive income) of Rs. 1,010 lakhs for the year ended March 31, 2021, as considered in the consolidated financial results, in respect of two joint ventures, whose financial statements have not been audited by us. These financial statements /financial information have been audited by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our opinion on the consolidated financial results, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries and joint ventures is based solely on the reports of the other auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above. Of these, seven subsidiaries are located outside India whose financial statements/financial information have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in their respective countries and which have been audited by other auditors under generally accepted auditing standards applicable in their respective countries which constitute total assets of Rs. 125,375 lakhs and net assets of Rs. 98,957 lakhs as at March 31, 2021, total revenues of Rs. 104,085 lakhs, total comprehensive income (comprising profit/loss and other comprehensive income) of Rs. 13,766 lakhs and cash flows (net) of Rs. 8,214 lakhs for the year ended March 31, 2021. The Parents Management has converted the financial statements of such subsidiaries located outside India from accounting principles generally accepted in their respective countries to accounting principles generally accepted in India. We have audited these conversion adjustments made by the Parent's management. Our opinion in so far it relates to the balances and affairs of such subsidiaries located outside India is based on the report of other auditors and the conversion adjustments prepared by the Management of Parent and audited by us. Our conclusion is not modified in respect of the above matters.
- 13. The consolidated financial results include the unaudited financial information two subsidiaries, whose financial information reflect total assets of Rs. 30 lakhs and net assets of Rs. 23 lakhs as at March 31, 2021, total revenue of Rs. Nil, total comprehensive income (comprising loss and other comprehensive income) of Rs. Nil and cash flows (net) of Rs. Nil for the year ended March 31, 2021, as considered in the consolidated financial results. These financial information are unaudited and have been furnished to us by the Management and our opinion on the consolidated financial results, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries, is based solely on such unaudited financial information. In our opinion and according to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, these financial information are not material to the Group.
- 14. Our opinion on the consolidated financial results is not modified in respect of the above matters with respect to our reliance on the work done and the reports of the other auditors and the financial information furnished by the management.
- 15. The consolidated Financial Results include the results for the quarter ended March 31, 2021 being the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published unaudited year to date figures up to the third quarter of the current financial year, which are subject to limited review by us.



16. The consolidated annual financial results dealt with by this report have been prepared for the express purpose of filing with National Stock Exchange of India and BSE Limited. These results are based on and should be read with the audited consolidated financial statements of the group, its Associate and Joint Ventures, for the year ended March 31, 2021 on which we have issued an unmodified audit opinion vide our report dated April 28, 2021.
