Take suo moto cognizance of hate speech

NEW DELHI: A group of 262 eminent citizens, including former high court judges and bureaucrats and war veterans have penned a letter to the Chief Justice of India requesting him to take suo moto cognizance of the alleged hate speech made by Tamil Nadu Minister Udhayanidhi Stalin, who is the son of Chief Minister M.K. Stalin, over his remarks on 'Sanatan Dharma'. The letter stated that Stalin Jr.'s comments amount to hate speech against a large population of India and strikes at the very core of the Constitution of India which envisages Bharat as a secular nation. It said that the state government refused to take any action against Udhayanidhi Stalin and rather chose to justify his remarks. It stated that the



action of the TN government ran in the face of the judgment of the Supreme Court which had directed that state governments should take suo moto action against any hate speech crime without waiting for any complaint. "Since the State Government has refused to take action and acted in contempt of the Court's orders and gravely undermined or rather made a mockery of the rule of law, we urge the Hon'ble Supreme Court to take the suo moto notice of contempt, ensuring accountability for the inaction of the State Government of Tamil Nadu," the letter stated. Notably, the Supreme Court in the case of Shaheen Abdullah v. Union of India and Ors., observed that there cannot be fraternity unless different religious communities are amenable to live in harmony. The top court had ex-

pressed concern over the growing incidents of hate speeches in the country and had directed the governments and police authorities to take suo moto action in such cases without waiting for formal complaints. It had said that any delay on the part of the administration in taking action on 'very serious issues' will invite the court's contempt as action is needed in order to preserve the secular character of the country. Udhayanidhi Stalin, had spoken at a function of Tamil Nadu Progressive Writers on eradication of Sanatan Dharma, saying that it was against social justice. He had also said that Sanatan Dharma must be eradicated like mosquitoes, dengue, I'm also Sanatani: Kejrival NEW DELHI: Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Tuesday, while commenting on Tamil Nadu minister Udhayanidhi Stalin's remark on Sanatan Dharma that sparked a widespread controversy, said "we should respect other's religion". 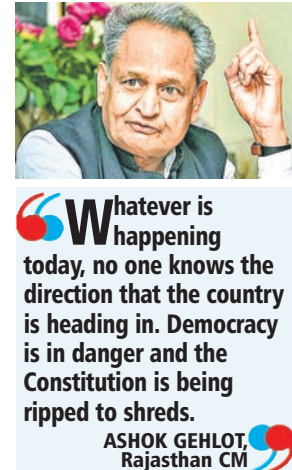

Kerala's churches try to stem the flow

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM

Concerned over the migration of young members abroad, particularly to Europe and Canada for higher studies and employment, the Catholic Church in Kerala has launched initiatives aimed at enticing them to remain in the state. For Kerala, remittances from Malayalis living abroad have been a lifeline of the economy. The Church's move marks a first for a major community in the state attempting to put the breaks on migration. SENTHIL BALAJI CASE

MINISTER WITHOUT PORTFOLIO SERVES NO PURPOSE, SAYS HC

CHENNAI

The Madras High Court on Tuesday said the Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu may be well advised to take a decision about the continuance of V Senthil Balaji (who is in judicial custody) as a Minister without portfolio in the state cabinet, as it serves no purpose and does not augur well with the principles of Constitutional ethos on goodness, good governance and purity in administration. The first bench comprising Chief Justice JV Gangapurwala and Justice PD Audikesavalu made the observation while disposing of two quo warranto petitions filed by advocate Ramachandran and former AIADMK MP J Jayavardhan and a PIL from advocate ML Ravi.

"The present petition brings to the fore the erosion of the high standards of characters and conduct demanded from the Members of the Legislature. The petitioners expect and legitimately so, high standards of moral conduct by the persons in power. The Chief Minister is the repository of the people's faith. Political compulsion cannot outweigh the public morality, requirements of good/clean governance and the Constitutional morality", the bench added. The bench said, "A Minister is a people's representative and as a Minister is conferred with Legislative and Executive powers, the business of the Government is performed in consonance with the Business Rules by a Minister only with respect to the portfolio assigned to him. With the Cabinet Sys-

tem of Governance, the entire Cabinet is responsible for its collective decisions, so also for its individual Ministerial decisions." "The Ministers without portfolios do not have any specific Ministries, nor they do have carved out responsibilities. The Chief Minister is an Executive Head. It is the responsibility of an Executive Head to assign Ministerial responsibilities to an elected representative. However, if he feels that a particular elected representative cannot be assigned the responsibility of a Minister, there cannot be moral or Constitutional basis to retain such a Member of the Legislative Assembly as a Minister without portfolio, which would be opposed to the ethos, good Governance and Constitutional morality or integrity," the bench said.

Umar Khalid's bail plea hearing adjourned

AGENCIES New Delhi

The Supreme Court on Tuesday adjourned hearing on bail plea filed by student activist Umar Khalid who was arrested and charged under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act in connection with the alleged larger conspiracy case behind the 2020 Delhi riots. A bench comprising Justices Bela M. Trivedi and Dipankar Datta was apprised that a letter seeking adjournment has been circulated as senior advocate Kapil Sibal, who would argue on Khalid's behalf, is appearing before Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud-led Constitution Bench hearing pleas against abrogation of Article 370. At this, the bench remarked: "How many times? Mr. Sibal is bound to

be busy. We cannot wait for any particular senior counsel." The top court clarified that it is granting the "last opportunity" and posted the plea for hearing in the coming week. On August 18, the hearing in the matter was deferred and the plea was directed to be listed after a period of two weeks. Also in August, Justice Prashant Kumar Mishra of the Supreme Court had recused himself from hearing the matter and the plea was directed to be listed before a different bench. "This will come before some other bench. There is some difficulty on part of my brother (Justice PK Mishra)," a bench headed by Justice A.S. Bopanna told the parties. Khalid has approached the top court against denial of bail by the Delhi High court.

Plea seeks quashing of notification restoring RaGa's LS membership

NEW DELHI: A plea has been filed in the Supreme Court seeking quashing of the August 7 notification which restored the Lok Sabha membership of Congress leader Rahul Gandhi following the apex court order staying his conviction in a 2019 defamation case over his Modi surname remark. The top court had on August 4 stayed his conviction in the defamation case. Gandhi represents Wayanad in the lower House of Parliament. The Congress leader was disqualified as an MP on March 24 after a Gujarat court convicted and sentenced him to two-year imprisonment for criminal defamation for comments he made about the Modi surname.

Protest march by Meitei body today

IMPHAL: Apprehending serious law and order problems, the Manipur government has cancelled curfew relaxations in Meitei-dominated five valley districts on Wednesday and massive security measures put in place in view of the protest march called by the Coordinating Committee on Manipur Integrity (COCOMI). The COCOMI, an umbrella body of the Meitei community, and its women wing, called the protest march on Wednesday to remove an army barricade at Phougakchao Ikhai in Bishnupur district, a few kilometres away from tribal-dominated Churachandpur district. Locals claim that due to

BJP should know who they're dealing with: Gehlot

ONLINE REPORT / Jaipur Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot said the Centre's push for 'one nation, one election' without developing a consensus is an example of democracy being in danger in India. Gehlot was asked about his opinion on holding simultaneous elections for the Lok Sabha and state assemblies across the country. "I have been saying this for a long time. Whatever is happening today, no one knows the direction that the country is heading in. Democracy is in danger and the Constitution is being ripped to shreds. Simultaneous polls are an example of this. The Centre could have done this by taking opposition parties along and holding discussions with them," the chief minister said in Hindi. Referring to former President Ram Nath Kovind heading the committee to examine the issue, the Congress leader said, "The President's post is a prestigious one. I have never heard of a former President heading a committee."

High turnout in Kerala, Tripura, Bengal; moderate in UP, U'khand

LUCKNOW/AGARTALA High voter turnout was recorded in most of the six assembly constituencies in seven states where the by-election was held on Tuesday. The counting of votes is on September 8 for the by-election - seen as a litmus test for the opposition alliance INDIA against the BJP-led NDA ahead of the assembly polls in five states later this year and the 2023 Lok Sabha election. In Dhanpur and Boxanagar seats in Tripura, where the Congress had extended support to the CPI(M), the average turnout was around 76 per cent. Six persons were injured in a stray incidents of violence in the northeastern state. In Dhupguri in West Bengal and Puthupally in Kerala, where the INDIA bloc constituents were up against each other, the voting was around 76 per cent and nearly 73 per cent respectively. The by-election saw the INDIA alliance also putting up a united front in the Ghosi constituency in Uttar Pradesh, where the

voting was moderate at around 50.30 per cent, and in Jharkhand's Dumri where a total of 64.84 per cent of 2.98 lakh voters exercised their franchise. Utarakhand's Bageshwar, where the main contest is between the BJP and the Congress, saw 55.44 per cent voting. Out of the seven seats, three (Dhanpur, Bageshwar and Dhupguri), were held by the BJP and one each by the SP (Ghosi), CPI(M) (Boxanagar), JMM (Dumri) and the Congress (Puthupally). In Uttar Pradesh, the Ghosi seat fell vacant after the resignation of Samajwadi Party (SP) MLA and OBC leader Dara Singh

Chauhan, who rejoined the BJP. While the ruling BJP-led NDA has fielded Chauhan, Samajwadi Party candidate Sudhakar Singh has got the support of the Congress and Left parties. Chauhan was a minister in the previous BJP government headed by Yogi Adityanath. He resigned from the Council of Ministers on January 12, 2022 and switched to the SP. The Akhilesh Yadav-led party has alleged misuse of official machinery and has written to the Election Commission on the matter. It claimed that Muslim voters were being prevented from exercising their franchise in some places.

Bandh disrupts life in Kolhapur

Maratha reservation returned to the centre stage last week after the police baton charged and lobbed tear gas shells to disperse a violent mob in Antarwali Sarathi village in Jalna district



KOLHAPUR: The bandh called by Maratha outfits in western Maharashtra's Kolhapur on Tuesday received a good response, as a majority of the commercial establishments remained shut in the city. Sakal Maratha Samaj led an agitation in Kolhapur's Dasara Chowk, condemning the violence against protesters allegedly refused to let authorities shift a man on hunger

strike for Maratha quota to the hospital. According to the police, the overall bandh was peaceful, and no untoward incident was reported anywhere in the city or district. "Traders in the market areas of the city supported the bandh and all commercial establishments remained closed till evening," Kolhapur Superintendent of Police Mahendra Pandit said.
