Modi made 22 billionaires in 10 years; INDIA bloc to make crores of people 'lakhpati': Rahul

CHAIBASA, MAY 7 --/ Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Tuesday criticised Prime Minister Narendra Modi and alleged that he wanted to hand over 'Jal, Jungle, Jameen' belonging to tribals to industrialists. Addressing an election rally in Jharkhand's Chaibasa, Gandhi promised to make crores of people 'lakhpati' if voted to power. Asserting that this Lok Sabha election is for saving the Constitution and the rights of tribals, poor and backward, he said INDIA bloc leaders were ready to sacrifice their lives to save the Constitution. The former Congress president said, "PM wants to hand over the 'Jal, Jungle, Jameen' of the tribals to 14-15 industrialists...Narendra Modi works for Adani, Ambani...he made 22 people billionaires in his 10-year tenure... We will provide Rs

1 lakh annually to poor women if voted to power." "The BJP wants to confine tribals to roles like domestic helps. They never want you to become doctors, engineers and lawyers. They want to hand over jungles to industrialists... The country is being run by 90 IAS officers and out of them, there is only one tribal who has been sidelined in Delhi. The tribal population is around 8 per cent in the country," he said. He also attacked the press for its alleged partisan role and claimed that majority of the media houses are run by industrialists. Gandhi promised to provide one-year apprenticeships to unemployed diploma holders and graduates. "If voted to power, we will give apprenticeship opportunities to unemployed graduates and diploma

holders and pay Rs 8,000 per month," he added. He announced that the INDIA bloc would compile a list of impoverished people, including those from tribal, Dalit, and OBC communities, to identify those living below the poverty line. Additionally, he pledged to provide Rs 8,500 per month to women, amounting to Rs 1 lakh annually. He also promised to scrap the contractual job system in PSUs and said reservation will be increased to above 50 per cent. "The Congress government will assure MSP (minimum support price) for all products by farmers; MNRGA daily allowance will be raised from Rs 250 to Rs 400 and remuneration of ASHA and anganwadi workers will be doubled," he said. Talking about jailed former Jharkhand Chief

Minister Hemant Soren, Gandhi said the BJP has put the tribal CM behind the bars but "Hemant Soren chootege (he will be released)" to which the crowd responded with slogans like "Jail ka tala tutega, Hemant Soren chootege (jail locks will be broken, Hemant Soren will be released)." Addressing the rally, Hemant's Soren's Kalpana asked the gathering whether it was right to put her husband behind the bars before the election. "INDIA bloc will give a befitting reply to it with 'vote ki chot (strike with vote)' on May 13, the date Singhbhum Lok Sabha seat goes to poll. Leaders including Gandhi appealed people to vote for INDIA bloc candidate Joba Manjhi of JMM, who is contesting against BJP's Geeta Kora. (PTI)

West Nile fever in Kerala: State govt orders all districts to be vigilant

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM, MAY 7 --/ The Kerala government on Tuesday said that West Nile fever cases have been reported from Thrissur, Malappuram and Kozhikode districts of the state. State Health Minister Veena George, in a statement, confirmed that cases of the viral infection have been reported in the state and that all the districts have been asked to be vigilant. As part of the vigil against the viral fever, spread by the Culex species of mosquitoes, the Minister has ordered that steps be taken for mosquito control by destroying their breeding grounds, the statement said. The minister said that there was no need to be concerned, but requested anyone showing signs of fever or other symptoms of the West Nile infection to seek treatment immediately. The main symptoms of West Nile infection are headache, fever, muscle aches, dizziness and loss of memory, but most patients do not experience these, she said. Some people experience symptoms like fever, headache, vomiting and

itching and in one per cent of the cases, it can lead to brain damage resulting in unconsciousness and sometimes death, the minister's statement said. But the death rate is relatively low compared to Japanese encephalitis which shows similar symptoms and is more dangerous. It said that instructions to begin pre-monsoon cleaning activities were already given in a high-level meeting held last week and now the District Medical Officers (DMOs) have been directed to further intensify the same. As there is no medicine or vaccine available against West Nile virus, symptomatic treatment and prevention are key, the minister said. As part of the preventive measures, she suggested wearing clothing that completely covers the body, use of mosquito nets and repellants and keeping one's home and surroundings clean. Earlier in the day, Kozhikode district health officials confirmed reports of five cases of West Nile fever there. The infected persons, which included children, are all fine now and back at their

homes with no new cases reported from the areas they live in, an official of the Kozhikode district surveillance team said. He also said that presently there was one person who is suspected of suffering from the vector-borne infection and is undergoing treatment. The official said that the samples of those who exhibited symptoms of the disease and had undergone treatment were sent to the National Institute of Virology in Pune as a routine exercise. "The results came back now and indicated that they were suffering from West Nile fever. They are all better now," he said. The West Nile fever is spread by the Culex species of mosquitoes. It was first detected in 1937 in Uganda. The fever was first detected in Kerala in 2011 and a six-year-old boy from Malappuram died due to the fever in 2019. Thereafter, in May 2022, a 47-year-old man died of the fever in Thrissur district. The West Nile virus can cause a fatal neurological disease in humans but most of those infected may not show any symptoms. (PTI)

To scrap Agniveer scheme, amend GST and implement Sarba religious code for tribals: Rahul Gandhi

GUMLA, MAY 7 --/ Congress leader Rahul Gandhi announced on Tuesday that the Agniveer scheme would be abolished if the INDIA bloc is voted to power, alleging that it was initiated by PM Narendra Modi and not by the Army. He also promised to amend the GST and bring out a separate Sarna religious code for tribals. "INDIA bloc will scrap the Agniveer scheme, a scheme brought by Modi and not by the Army. We do not want to differentiate between martyrs. Anyone sacrificing for the nation should be attributed martyr status, should be given pension," he said at an election rally in Jharkhand's Gumla. "The BJP government implemented wrong GST schemes with five tax slabs. We will amend it and make one tax slab which will be minimum. We will reduce the tax burden on the poor," he said. The former Congress chief attacked the BJP-led Centre for betraying tribals and alleged that Modi insulted President Droupadi Murmu. "PM insulted President Murmu, a tribal, by not inviting her to the new Parliament building inauguration and Ram Temple consecration in Ayodhya," he said. He also alleged that the saffron party is hell-bent to handover PSUs, railways, etc to industrialists. (PTI)

25,000 pen drives distributed': Kumaraswamy sees plot in sex abuse allegations against Prajwal

BENGALURU, MAY 7 --/ JD(S) leader H D Kumaraswamy has claimed that 25,000 pen drives with videos of women being sexually abused allegedly by his nephew, Lok Sabha election candidate Prajwal Revanna, were distributed before polls, and accused Minister Siddaramaiah and his deputy D K Shivakumar of a conspiracy. The former Chief Minister also sought to discredit the Special Investigation Team (SIT) formed by the Congress government on April 28 to probe the charges against Prajwal of sexually abusing several women after videos allegedly involving him started making the rounds on social media. It is not a Special Investigation Team but "Siddaramaiah Investigation Team" and "Shivakumar Investigation Team", the JD(S) second-in-command, who is the son of party supremo and former Prime Minister H D Deve Gowda, said.

of Prajwal's sleaze videos', Kumaraswamy further said. According to Kumaraswamy, one Naveen Gowda had sent the message about the "countdown". In his complaint to the Deputy Commissioner and the Superintendent of Police of Hassan district, Poornachandra has named five people including Naveen Gowda, Karthik Gowda (Revanna's driver), Chethan and Puttaraju alias Putty, he said. It has been more than a fortnight since the complaint made on April 21 but no action has been taken against these five people, Kumaraswamy said and demanded that they should first be arrested for "mortgaging the modesty" of women in the videos. Kumaraswamy alleged that 25,000 pen drives were distributed in the entire state, and cited a report in a regional daily to support his claim. "My question here is why no action was taken. If someone posts something on social media, immediately houses are searched and the person is made to sit in the police station. Why no action was taken against these five people despite a complaint?" he asked. "Chief Minister Siddaramaiah had confidently said that all the three JD(S) candidates in the Lok Sabha elections will be defeated," Kumaraswamy said, adding, "It raises doubts about the involvement of many people."

On April 25, Karnataka State Commission for Women Chairperson Nagalakshmi Chowdhary wrote to Siddaramaiah demanding an SIT probe into the tapes where Prajwal is allegedly seen sexually abusing several women. The same night the CM gave his nod and ordered the formation of a SIT, Kumaraswamy said. "In that letter, Nagalakshmi Chowdhary did not mention the name of Prajwal or Revanna but the Chief Minister called it 'Prajwal Revanna's explicit videos' in his post on 'X' when he announced the formation of SIT. This shows how the conspiracy was hatched," the JD(S) leader claimed. (PTI)

politicians. The bench has divided the hearing on Kejriwal's petition against his arrest into two parts. His main petition challenges his arrest by the ED and seeks it to be declared as illegal, while the second aspect pertains to grant of interim bail keeping in mind the ongoing Lok Sabha polls. The court has reserved the order on the issue of grant of interim bail. Before rising for the day, the bench indicated that tomorrow the judges will be sitting in different combinations, and if the hearing on matters listed for Wednesday gets completed and the judges have time in hand, they would resume hearing Kejriwal's plea against his arrest by the ED. "If not tomorrow, then we may take up the matter on Thursday. If not on Thursday, then

we will be taking up this matter next week," said Justice Khanna, without specifying any time frame for pronouncement of verdict on the issue of interim bail. Meanwhile, a Delhi court extended Kejriwal's judicial custody in the money laundering case till May 20. (PTI)

Kejriwal fails to get immediate relief from SC in money laundering case

NEW DELHI, MAY 7 --/ Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal failed to get any relief from the Supreme Court on Tuesday, with a two-judge bench rising without pronouncing an order on granting him interim bail to enable him to campaign in the Lok Sabha elections. Kejriwal has been accused of money laundering in a case linked to the alleged Delhi excise scam. A bench of Justices Sanjiv Khanna and Dipankar Datta, which reserved its order on grant of interim bail earlier during the day and said it will be pronounced at 2 p.m., rose without delivering its verdict. The bench reserved its decision after hearing the arguments put forth by senior advocate Abhishek Singhvi and Additional Solicitor General S V Raju, who appeared for Kejriwal and the Enforcement Directorate, respectively. Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, who also appeared for the probe agency, staunchly opposed showing any leniency to Kejriwal on account of the Lok Sabha polls and said granting interim bail to the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) national convener would amount to creating a separate class for
