Global REIT, InvIT Investors Seek Tax Parity with Listed Cos

The investors, sponsors also want legal sanction to raise debt from insurance cos, FPIs

Mumbai: Global institutional investors and sponsors of Real Estate Investment Trusts (REITs) and Infrastructure Investment Trust (InvITs) are seeking parity with listed companies on tax treatment of their business trusts. They also want legal sanction to raise debt from insurance companies and foreign portfolio investors (FPIs). Despite the Finance Ministry's approval in Budget 2019 for debt funding, such entities still don't have access to liquidity through this channel. "The InvITs and REITs market in India has grown exponentially with two of the four largest listed realty sector securities as REITs. It is now imperative that these are treated on a par with listed entities. This will ensure a level playing field and offer necessary support to these nascent products

Infra Boost

REITs, InvITs still don't have access to debt funding. Since the first listing 3 years ago, the market has expanded quickly to 7 InvITs and 3 REITs across infrastructure assets

that are growth drivers for the economy," said Sigrud Zialcita, CEO, Asia Pacific Real Estate Association (APREA). APREA has made representations to the government and statutory bodies on behalf of investors and sponsors. Since the first listing three years ago, the market has expanded quickly to seven InvITs and three REITs across infrastructure assets like roads, power transmission, commercial real estate and gas pipelines,

with a market capitalization of \$18 billion. These REITs and InvITs have cumulatively accumulated more than Rs 2 lakh crore worth of assets under management. They have raised more than Rs 40,000 crore of equity raised from domestic, global investors

in case of a default. Sponsors are of the view that the Trust Act allows trusts to borrow, but business trusts are being treated differently. Moreover, business trusts are governed by stringent SEBI regulations that enable enforcement. "Owing to robust regulation, operating assets and AAA ratings, InvITs and REITs make a compelling case for debt investments by FPIs and Insurance companies. Both global FPIs and insurance companies have subscribed to units of business trusts heavily showcasing their confidence," said Harsh Shah, CEO, IndiGrid. Shah believes if India wants InvITs to play a meaningful role in attracting capital to the infrastructure sector including monetisation program for the government of India through InvITs, regulators need to enable subscription to debt securities by FPIs and insurance companies.

ESG: India Inc's New Alpha Mantra?

Among many new paradigms established last year, ESG stood out for both investors and corporates (ESG refers to the framework of a company to include environmentally conscious business practices, strong social responsibility and corporate governance). There is a visible rise in demand from asset managers to invest in companies with high ESG scores. Data from Morningstar shows sustainable funds in India saw inflows of more than half a billion dollars from January to March 2020. Why? "Several studies highlight that companies with good ESG scores tick most of the checkboxes for investing, tend to mitigate environmental and social risks, and tend to have stronger cash flows, lower borrowing costs and durable returns," Chintan Haria, Head of Product & Strategy, ICICI Prudential AMC told ET. Agrees Rajesh Dahiya, Executive Director at Axis Bank. "As a commercial lender, ESG factors do play a role in lending decisions. In fact, over the past few years, we have worked to put in place a policy and system that integrates environmental and social risk imperatives into our credit appraisal in corporate lending."

COVID has ensured there is greater focus on ESG - US data shows a record \$27.7 billion flew into ESG ETFs in 2020, more than three times the previous year. "In times of Covid-19 uncertainty, it was again proven that companies having better ESG strategy do well by protecting people, communities and economic performance," says Mahendra Singh, MD & CEO of Dalmia Cement. "Therefore, it is a natural inclination for investors to follow ESG and sustainability as alpha to beat the indices, and reduce overall volatility and known systematic market risks." The success of ESG in corporate strategy is because a strong framework of environment-friendly business practices with a socially responsible approach and strong governance ensure business-risk mitigation. "Longevity is the fruit of strict adherence to ESG," says Jinesh Gopani, Head Equity at Axis Mutual Fund. But beyond longevity, is the strength of a company's ESG

Formal Job Creation Declined in November

New Delhi: Formal job creation declined in November 2020, with net job additions under both the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) and Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) remaining below those in the preceding month. Provisional payroll data from the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (Mospi), released on Monday, showed that the EPFO added 1.01 million net new subscribers in November compared to 1.05 million in October and 1.33 million in September. However, the figure was higher than the average monthly addition of 0.65 million in 2019-20. The ESIC also saw a decline in net new additions in November, at 0.93 million, compared to 1.19 million added in October and 1.15 million added in September. In 2019-20, the corporation had added 1.2 million subscribers a month on average. However, the National Pen-

FDI up 13% in 2020; Global Inflow Sinks to 1990s Lows

New Delhi: Boosted by investments in the digital sector, foreign direct investment (FDI) in India grew 13% to \$57 billion in 2020, the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) said in its 'investment trends monitor' report even as the global inflows plummeted 42% compared to 2019. "India, another major emerging economy, also recorded positive growth (13%), boosted by investments in the digital sector," it said in its preliminary estimates for 2020. China was the world's largest FDI recipient, with flows to the Asian giant rising by 4% to \$163 billion, according to UNCTAD. As per official data, FDI equity inflows into India grew 21% to \$35.33 billion in the April-October period of fiscal 2021 from \$29.31 billion a year earlier. Global FDI collapsed in 2020 to an estimated \$859 billion from \$1.5 trillion in 2019. "Such a low level was last seen in the 1990s and is more than 30% below the investment trough that followed the 2008-2009 global financial crisis," UNCTAD said. As per the Geneva-based organisation, India and Turkey are attracting record numbers of deals in IT consulting and digital sectors, including e-commerce platforms, data processing services and digital payments. Indian IT companies have announced a 30% increase in acquisitions, targeting European and other markets for information technology services.
